### SUNDAY NIGHT BASEBALL: [The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers lost 4-3 to the Peoria Chiefs at Dozer Park.](#)

Jeferson Quero gave Wisconsin a 1-0 lead in the first inning on an RBI double. The Chiefs tied the game with a run in the fourth and took the lead with three runs in the seventh. Ethan Murray hit a two-run home run in the top of the ninth, but that was a close as the Rattlers would get. Wisconsin won the series at Peoria 4-2, but the Chiefs won the season series 11-10.

### WE HOLD THESE TRUTHS TO BE SELF-EVIDENT:

Quero had a great week in Peoria. He was 10-for-22 with a homer, a triple, and two doubles for an OPS of 1.296. Quero also drove in seven runs during the series.

**CLOSE SHAVES:** Sunday's one-run loss dropped Wisconsin to 19-20 in one-run games this season. The Timber Rattlers have lost the last seven games decided by one run.

**ANOTHER AWARD ON THE SHELF:** Pitcher Carlos Rodríguez was named the Midwest League Pitcher of the Week on Monday for his perfect performance at Peoria last week. Rodríguez struck out nine over six perfect innings on September 3. He became the sixth Timber Rattler to win a weekly award this season. Brandon Knarr, Justin Jarvis, Stiven Cruz, and Rodríguez have been MWL Pitchers of the Week this season. Carlos D. Rodríguez and Xavier Warren were Players of the Week. Additionally, Tristan Peters was named the Player of the Month in May.

**MAKING MOVES:** The Milwaukee Brewers have announced that Ethan Murray has been transferred from Wisconsin to Biloxi. Additionally, pitcher Jeison Peña has been transferred from Wisconsin to Carolina.

**REHABBING UPDATE:** Brewers infielder Mike Brosseau is back for his second rehabilitation assignment with the Timber Rattlers this season. Brosseau is working his way back from a right oblique strain.

**ABOUT БЕЛОIT:** The Beloit Sky Carp are in their first season as the Sky Carp and their second season as an affiliate of the Miami Marlins. Beloit started as the Beloit Brewers in 1982 as the Midwest League affiliate of Milwaukee. They changed their name to the Beloit Snappers for the 1995 season. The Snappers affiliation with Milwaukee ended after the 2004 season. They were affiliated with the Minnesota Twins (2005-2012) and the Oakland Athletics (2013-2019) over their final seasons in the Midwest League. The Snappers said "Goodbye" to Pohlman Field on July 11, 2021 and [moved into ABC Supply Stadium on August 3](#). Jorge Hernandez is in his first season as the manager of the Sky Carp.

**ABOUT THE MARLINS:** The Florida/Miami Marlins have a history in the Midwest League. The Marlins' first Low-A affiliate was the Kane County Cougars from 1993 through 2002. Josh Beckett, Adrian Gonzalez, Dontrelle Willis, Miguel Cabrera, and former Timber Rattlers manager Matt Erickson all played for the Cougars in that timespan. The Marlins returned to the Midwest League in 2019 to affiliate with the Clinton LumberKings. The Marlins landed in Beloit after MLB reset the affiliations for 2021.

**PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES:** [MLB Pipeline](#) puts four active Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Jackson Chourio (#1), Jeferson Quero (#7), Carlos F. Rodríguez (#19), and Eduardo García (#21). Tyler Black (#6), Russell Smith (#20), and Carlos D. Rodríguez (#22) are on the Wisconsin injured list. [MLB Pipeline](#) has three Beloit players on their list of Marlins prospects: Jose Salas (#5), Victor Mesa Jr (#16), and MD Johnson (#28). Cody Morissette (#23) is on the Sky Carp's IL.

# PITCHING MATCHUP

## WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

**RHP BRADY SCHANUEL:** Selected by Milwaukee in the 27<sup>th</sup> Round of the 2018 draft out of the University of Iowa.

**BEFORE THE PROS:** Schanuel pitched two seasons at Parkland Community College in Champaign, Illinois and was a two-time NJCAA All-American as he helped the Cobras to the NJCAA College World series during his sophomore season when he went 10-1 with 130 strikeouts over 80-1/3 innings. Schanuel pitched one season at Iowa and was 5-7 with a 5.94 ERA in fourteen games – thirteen starts.

**DRAFT DAYS:** Schanuel was drafted two times before he was taken by Milwaukee. Oakland took him in the 36<sup>th</sup> round of the 2016 draft and Philadelphia took him in the 20<sup>th</sup> round of the 2017 draft.

**AT UNIVERSITY:** Schanuel pitched for Team USA at the 2017 World University Games. He made two starts with no record and ten strikeouts over 8-1/3 innings. He pitched 5-1/3 hitless innings against Team Mexico on August 20, 2017.

**IN THE PROS:** Schanuel made 99 relief appearances as a professional prior to the start against South Bend on August 13. He pitched for the AZL Brewers and Helena Brewers in 2018 and for Rocky Mountain in 2019. Schanuel was 6-0 with a 5.37 ERA in 37 relief appearances with 40 walks and 76 strikeouts over 57 innings pitched for the Rattlers in 2021.

**LAST START:** Schanuel had a [no decision at Peoria on August 31](#). He allowed an unearned run on two hits with a walk and three strikeouts over four innings. Schanuel set a new professional single-game high in the game.

**VS. БЕЛОИТ (2022):** Schanuel has faced the Sky Carp three times as a reliever this season. He has allowed four runs on three hits with seven walks and two strikeouts over three innings with no record.

## BELOIT SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

**RHP MD JOHNSON:** The Marlins selected Johnson in the 6<sup>th</sup> round of the 2019 draft out of Dallas Baptist University.

**PATRIOT GAMES:** Johnson pitched four seasons at Dallas Baptist. He was 29-9 with a 4.27 ERA and 274 strikeouts in 297 innings over 68 games – 57 starts – in his career.

**SENIOR MOMENTS:** Johnson was 10-2 in sixteen starts in his final season at DBU. He had an ERA of 2.76 and had 110 strikeouts with 29 walks over 98 innings pitched as a senior.

**TO THE PROS:** Johnson made pitched for the Batavia Muckdogs in the New York-Penn League in 2019 after signing with the Marlins. He made fifteen relief appearances and was 1-0 while allowing nine earned runs and striking out 22 in 19 innings pitched.

**FLORIDA MAN:** Johnson went 3-4 with the Jupiter Hammerheads to start his 2021 season. He had a 3.19 ERA in ten games – seven starts – before his promotion to Beloit on July 6.

**CENTRALLY LOCATED:** Johnson was 3-4 in eleven starts with Beloit in 2021. He had a 2.58ERA with 59 strikeouts over 59.1 innings pitched.

**LAST START:** Johnson [lost to Quad Cities at home on August 30](#) at home. He allowed five runs on nine hits – including two homers – with three walks and six strikeouts over five innings.

**VS. WISCONSIN (2022):** Johnson is 0-1 in two starts against the Timber Rattlers this season. He took the [loss against the Timber Rattlers at Beloit on April 12](#) when he allowed four runs on six hits with no walks and eight strikeouts over three innings. Johnson had a [no decision at Neuroscience Group Field on June 7](#) when he gave up three runs – two earned – on five hits with a walk and eight strikeouts over five innings. Last year, Johnson was 1-0 in two starts for Beloit against Wisconsin as he pitched eleven shutout innings and allowed three hits.
