ABOUT LAST NIGHT: [The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers beat the West Michigan Whitecaps 4-2 in game one of the series at LMCU Ballpark.](#) Darrien Miller broke a 2-2 tie with a two-out, two-run single in the top of the eighth. Karlos Morales struck out Jace Jung with runners at the corners and two outs in the bottom of the ninth to close out the game. Morales has inherited thirteen runners this season and none have scored. Luis Amaya tossed three scoreless innings in relief for the win.

THE MILLER'S TALE: Miller drove in three runs last night. He had a sacrifice fly with the bases loaded in the top of the first inning to give Wisconsin a 2-0 lead. West Michigan tied the game with single runs in the fourth and fifth innings. Miller put the Rattlers ahead to stay with his bases-loaded, two run single in the eighth. Miller is 2-for-3 with five RBI with the sacks full in 2023.

YOU CAN GO HOME AGAIN: Willy Adames went 0-for-2 with two walks and two runs scored in his second rehabilitation start for the Timber Rattlers. He played 98 games for West Michigan during the 2014 season.

MOORE, MOORE, MOORE: Robert Moore had three with a double and two runs scored last night. Moore has two three-hit games and nine multi-hit games this season.

HELPING HAND: Joe Gray Jr picked up his fourth outfield assist of the season when he doubled Danny Serretti off first base in the fourth inning. Wisconsin has fourteen outfield assists this season.

FACING A TIGER: Beau Brieske has been named as the starting pitcher for the Whitecaps on an MLB Rehab. Brieske, who beat the Timber Rattlers in Wisconsin on [May 20, 2021](#), has not pitched in a game since [July 12, 2022](#) when he picked up the win over Kansas City. He was 3-6 with a 4.19 ERA in fifteen starts for the Tigers last season.

RUBY TUESDAY: Wisconsin has won three straight Tuesday games. They had lost five straight Tuesday prior to the start of this streak. Wisconsin is 4-5 on Tuesdays this season.

ABOUT WEST MICHIGAN: The West Michigan Whitecaps joined the Midwest League in 1994 when the Madison Muskies moved to Grand Rapids, Michigan following the 1993 season. The Whitecaps started play in the league as an affiliate of the Oakland Athletics. They became Low-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers for the 1997 season. The Whitecaps won six Midwest League Pennants (1996, 1998, 2004, 2006, 2007, and 2015) before getting the bump up to the High-A Affiliate of the Tigers going into the 2021 season. Notable former Whitecaps include Nick Castellanos, Joel Zumaya, Fernando Rodney, Brandon Inge, Cameron Maybin, and Willy Adames.

ABOUT THE TIGERS: Detroit has been affiliated with the Whitecaps since 1997. The Tigers had just one other stint in the Midwest League prior to their current partnership. They were with the Clinton Pilots from 1971 through 1975.

PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES: [MLB Pipeline](#) places six active Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Jacob Misiorowski (#4), Eric Brown Jr (#6), Robert Moore (#8), Eduardo Garcia (#19), Matthew Wood (#24), and Joseph Hernandez (#25). Hendry Mendez (#13) is currently on Wisconsin's IL. [MLB Pipeline](#) has six West Michigan players on their list of Top 30 Tigers prospects: Jace Jung (#2), Izaac Pacheco (#12), Robert Brooks (#13), Troy Melton (#17), Josh Crouch (#24), and Danny Serretti (#29). Jackson Jobe (#3) and Tyler Mattison (#25) are on West Michigan's IL.

WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP CAMERON WAGONER: Selected by Milwaukee in the eleventh round of the 2022 draft out of Eastern Michigan University.

EASTERN NOTES: Wagoner did not pitch collegiately in 2022. He made six relief appearances during the abbreviated 2020 season and 18 appearances – three starts – in 2021. He was 2-4 with a 4.42 ERA and 67 strikeouts over 57 innings during his two college seasons.

HOW DID YOU SPEND YOUR SUMMERS? Wagoner played for Greeneville in the Appalachian League in 2021 and was with both Wareham and Cotuit in the Cape Cod League in 2022. He was 2-3 with a 4.97 ERA in nineteen games – two starts – and 57 strikeouts over 38 innings pitched in those summer leagues.

AS A PRO: Wagoner made four appearances – two starts – for the ACL Brewers Gold after signing with Milwaukee. He was 1-0 and had eight strikeouts in eight innings in the ACL.

DOWN UNDER: Wagoner pitched for the Brisbane Bandits of the Australian Baseball League during the Winter of 2022-23. He made ten starts during the regular season of the ABL and was 3-1 with a 3.26 ERA and 43 strikeouts in 47 innings pitched.

LAST START: Wagoner had a [no decision against Peoria at home on June 1](#). He allowed two runs on five hits with a walk and two strikeouts over five innings.

VS. WEST MICHIGAN: Wagoner has never faced the Whitecaps prior to this evening. Tonight is also the first time he will pitch against an affiliate of the Detroit Tigers.

WEST MICHIGAN SCHEDULED RELIEVER:

RHP TROY MELTON: The Detroit Tigers selected Melton in the fourth round of the 2022 draft out of San Diego State University.

SDSU: Melton pitched four seasons for the Aztecs. He was 12-8 with a 4.12 ERA and 181 strikeouts over 163-2/3 innings in 34 appearances – 30 starts. Melton was the Co-Pitcher of the Year in the WAC after he was 5-2 with a 2.07 ERA in eleven starts during his senior season. Melton had 67 strikeouts over 65-1/3 innings in his last year at San Diego State.

HOW DOES HE RATE? MLB Pipeline has Melton as the #17 prospect in the Tigers organization.

LAND OF LAKES: Melton made his pro debut with the Lakeland Flying Tigers with two brief starts in 2022. He had no record and pitched five scoreless innings with five strikeouts as a pro in 2022. Melton started this season with Lakeland in the Florida State League and made seven starts with no record, six walks, and 33 strikeouts over 26-2/3 innings.

MICHIGANDER: Melton was promoted to West Michigan on May 19, 2023. He has made two starts for the Whitecaps and has no record and has allowed two runs on five hits over 5-2/3 innings.

LAST START: Melton had a [no decision at Dayton on June 1](#). He allowed a run on four hits with no walks and three strikeouts in four innings.

VS. WISCONSIN: Melton has never faced the Timber Rattlers prior to this evening. Tonight is also the first time he will pitch against an affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers.
