JUNE 2024:

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers beat the West Michigan Whitecaps 5-2 at LMCU Ballpark. Eduarqui Fernández and Luke Adams each hit solo homers and Mark Manfredi allowed an unearned run over five innings for the Rattlers. Wisconsin added two runs without a hit in the top of the fifth. Adams tripled in the eighth inning and Matt Wood drove him home for the final tally. Stiven Cruz allowed a run over two innings with Will Childers working the final two innings without allowing a run for the save. The Rattlers are a season-high 16 games over .500. GOING DEEP: Fernández and Adams both led off innings with homers. They each have five homers this

GOING DEEP: Fernández and Adams both led off innings with homers. They each have five homers this season to lead the team in home runs. As a team, Wisconsin has hit 29 homers, the fewest by a Midwest League team this season.

HE GETS ON BASE: Dylan O'Rae went 1-for-3 with two walks last night to extend his current on base streak to 22 games. Since the streak started on May 17, O'Rae is 24-for-77 (.312) with 19 runs scored and 17 walks for an on base percentage of .470. O'Rae is tied with three other players for the second-longest on-base streak in the Midwest League this season. Yohendrick Pinango of South Bend owns the longest on-base streak in the league this season (25).

SPEAKING OF STREAKS: Both Adams and O'Rae are on six-game hitting streaks, their longest of the season. WELCOME BACK: Childers rejoined Wisconsin yesterday after a month with Biloxi. He walked two, struck out one, and didn't allow a hit or a run to earn his second save with the Rattlers this season as he closed out the Whitecaps.

STANDINGS CHECK: Wisconsin's lead in the West Division over the Cedar Rapids Kernels is 3-½ games. The Timber Rattlers Magic Number to clinch the division is five.

ABOUT WEST MICHIGAN: The West Michigan Whitecaps joined the Midwest League in 1994 when the Madison Muskies moved to Comstock Park, Michigan following the 1993 season. The Whitecaps started play in the league as an affiliate of the Oakland Athletics. They became Low-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers for the 1997 season. The Whitecaps have won six Midwest League Pennants - 1996, 1998, 2004, 2006, 2007, and 2015. Notable former Whitecaps include Nick Castellanos, Joel Zumaya, Fernando Rodney, Francisco Cordero, Brandon Inge, Cameron Maybin, Alex Avila, and Willy Adames. ABOUT THE TIGERS: Detroit has been affiliated with the Whitecaps since 1997. The Tigers had just one other stint in the Midwest League prior to their current partnership. They were with the Clinton Pilots from 1971 through 1975. PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

LHP TATE KUEHNER: The Milwaukee Brewers selected Kuehner in the seventh round of the 2023 draft out of the University of Louisville.

MARSHALLING THE PAST: Kuehner played high school baseball in Marshalltown, Iowa. Former Timber Rattlers catcher Jeff Clement, the #3 pick in the 2005 draft, also played his high school baseball at Marshalltown.

CARDINAL RULE: Kuehner pitched four seasons with Louisville. He was 15-13 with nine saves and a 3.69 ERA over 70 appearances – fourteen starts – for the Cardinals. Kuehner had 193 strikeouts over 165-2/3 innings. During the 2022 NCAA Regionals in Louisville, Kuehner earned two saves and a win over seven innings in three scoreless appearances for the Cardinals.

COLLEGE SUMMER LEAGUES: Kuehner made five appearances for Waterloo in the Northwoods League in 2020 and four appearances for Danbury in the New England Collegiate Baseball League in 2021.

DOWN IN THE DESERT: Kuehner made two appearances – one start – for the ACL Brewers in the regular season after signing with Milwaukee in 2023. He had no record with a walk and two strikeouts over three scoreless innings.

PLAYOFF CALL: Kuehner was the winning pitcher for the ACL Brewers in the ACL Semifinal Game against the ACL Rockies on <u>August 24, 2023</u>. He allowed a hit over two scoreless innings with no walks and two strikeouts. The Brewers won the game to advance to the ACL Championship Series.

LAST START: Kuehner had a no decision against Quad Cities on <u>June 5</u> at home. He allowed two runs on four hits with three walks and eight strikeouts over six innings.

VS. WEST MICHIGAN: Kuehner has never pitched against the Whitecaps before this evening. Tonight is also the first time he will face an affiliate of the Detroit Tigers.

WEST MICHIGAN STARTING PITCHER:

RHP COLIN FIELDS: The Detroit Tigers signed Fields as a non-drafted free agent out of Valparaiso on July 26, 2022.

FOUR YEARS ON CRUSADE: Fields pitched four seasons at Valparaiso and was 8-22 with a 6.24 ERA with a save 260 strikeouts over 199 innings pitched in 45 appearances – 41 starts.

LIVING THE DREAM: Fields made two appearances for Mahoning Valley in the MLB Draft League in 2022 before signing with Detroit. He did not pitch professionally in the Tigers system after joining the organization.

LAST SEASON: Fields made on brief start for the FCL Tigers on June 9, 2023 to make his pro debut. He was transferred to the Lakeland Flying Tigers, Detroit's Florida State League affiliate, on June 13, 2023. In fourteen games – eight starts – with Lakeland, Fields was 5-0 with a 3.38 ERA and 51 strikeouts over 45-1/3 innings pitched.

DOWNER ENDING: Fields was placed on the Lakeland Injured List on August 29, 2023 and did not pitch in the final stretch of games last season.

LAST START: Smith had a no decision at South Bend <u>June 6</u>. He allowed three runs on six hits with a walk and six strikeouts over five innings.

VS. WISCONSIN: Fields has never faced the Timber Rattlers prior to this evening. Tonight is also the first time he will pitch against an affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers.
