CIRCLE CITY ROUNDUP

ABOUT SUNDAY: Alikia Williams' RBI double in the seventh inning carried the Indianapolis Indians to a 6-5 win over the Toledo Mud Hens on Sunday afternoon at Victory Field. Indy won the season series against the Mud Hens, 11-7, capturing 10 of 12 games at the Vic. Jared Triolo doubled with one out in the seventh frame and Williams brought him home with two down to give Indy its winning advantage. The Mud Hens opened the scoring with a pair of home runs in the first and second innings, respectively. Hao-Yu Lee homered in back-to-back games with a first-inning solo blast and Trei Cruz hit a solo shot of his own in the second frame for a 2-0 advantage. The Indians rallied to take the lead with a three-run fourth inning. Matt Fraizer doubled to get the rally started, advanced to third on a wild pitch by Mud Hens starter Wilkel Hernandez and scored on an RBI single by Nick Yorke. Following a walk to Triolo, Brett Sullivan doubled home Yorke to tie the game. Williams then put Indy up, 3-2, with a bloop single to score Triolo. Toledo put up three runs of their own in the next half-inning, taking a 5-3 lead. Indianapolis battled right back with a pair of runs in the bottom of the fifth. Cam Devaney singled, advanced to second base on a Fraizer groundout and scored on Yorke's second run-scoring single of the contest. Yorke was thrown out at second base attempting to stretch a double. Triolo singled and then Jordan Balazovic relieved Hernandez. Sullivan singled, Alikia Williams walked to load the bases, and a wild pitch scored Triolo to knot the game, 5-5. Sean Sullivan earned his first Triple-A win with 2.0 scoreless frames in relief. Kyle Nicolas tossed a perfect ninth inning.

MAYBE THIS IS HEAVEN: The Indianapolis Indians have won seven straight games at Principal Park, home of the Iowa Cubs, since May 26, 2024, and are 15-8 overall against Iowa since the beginning of the 2024 season, good for their second-best winning percentage against an opponent (min. 7 games) in that span. In that time frame, the Indians pace I-Cubs opponents at Principal Park with a .310 batting average and a .922 OPS. The Indians also have the second-best batting average (.282) and OPS (.823) against the I-Cubs since the beginning of 2024, regardless of the setting. Their pitching staff has logged a 3.87 ERA (88er/204.2ip) in the 23 matchups against Iowa, which is the lowest against an opponent the Indians have played seven or more times since beginning of the last campaign.

CARDIAC KIDS: The Indians picked up their 27th comeback win of the season on Sunday and improved to 23-8 in one-run games. Indy has compiled its most comeback wins to this point in the season since 2014, when they also had 27 comebacks through July 28. They have had more comeback wins to this point in the season since 2005, when they earned 31 comeback wins through July 28, 2005. The Indians' win total and winning percentage in one-run games (.742) are their best since at least 2016, surpassing 2019 (21-16, .568) in both regards. When Indy is trailing or tied this season, they lead International League clubs with a .282 batting average. Additionally, they pace International League clubs with a .402 batting average (97-for-241) when they are trailing in games they have come back to win.

RING THAT BELL: Sunday's win improved the Indians to 21 games above .500, their highest mark since 2015, when they peaked at 24 games above .500 on Aug. 24. Indy has done a lot of their heavy lifting at home this season, where they own a .754 winning percentage (43-14), the best of any full-season minor league team this season and their best to this point in the season since at least 2005. They have not lost more than three consecutive games this season, joining Durham as the only Triple-A clubs to have not done so on the campaign. The Indians have not completed a season without losing three or more games in a row since 2006, when they dropped three straight games seven times that season, compared to two instances for the 2025 Indians.

SOLAK ECLIPSE: Nick Solak returns to the lineup tonight after missing three games over the weekend on the temporarily inactive list. In his last game, on July 24, he extended his on-base streak to 31 games since June 10, which is the second-longest active streak and is tied for the sixth-longest overall in the International League this season. Solak's run is the longest for an Indians hitter in a single season since Keon Broxton reached in 34 straight from July 3-Aug. 11, 2015. During his streak, Solak ranks among qualified International League hitters in on-base percentage (2nd, .453), batting average (3rd, .359, 42-for-117) and hits (T-7th, 42) while racking up seven doubles, three homers, 21 RBI and 17 walks to 15 strikeouts. On the season, Solak leads full-season minor league hitters in batting average (.370, 90-for-243), ranks third in on-base percentage (.444) and fourth in OPS (1.004). Solak's batting average is the highest by a qualified International League hitter to this point in the season since at least 2005, surpassing Chris Colabello's .354 average (114-for-322) through July 28, 2013. It is the highest by any Triple-A hitter through July 28 since 2019, when Corban Joseph hit .385 (125-for-325) for Las Vegas in 2019.

HE GETS ON (BAE)SE: Ji Hwan Bae extended his on-base streak to nine games with a hit on Sunday. On the campaign, he has reached base safely in 41 of 46 games and in 18 of his last 20 since June 28. Since returning from the 7-day injured list on June 27, he is hitting .342 (27-for-79) with a .911 OPS and ranks among International League hitters in triples (1st, 4), stolen bases (T-1st, 12), on-base percentage (6th, .443), walks (T-7th, 14), runs scored (T-10th, 18), and hits (T-10th, 27). Additionally, Bae has not made an error this season, converting on all 89 chances between the three outfield positions.

YEAN SHORTS: Eddy Yean tossed 0.2 scoreless innings on Sunday, extending his scoreless appearances streak to 10 since June 27, surpassing his own nine-game streak from April 11-May 11 for the longest on the team this season. Yean's scoreless stretch is also the fourth-longest active streak in the International League. It is the first time the Indians have had two streaks of nine-or-more scoreless appearances in a single season since 2019, when Montana DuRapau tallied an 11 and 10-game streak. Yean is the only Triple-A pitcher (min. 10.0ip) across his streak with no runs allowed and the only pitcher to hold a 0.00 ERA. During this span, Yean has gone 2-0, picked up two saves and allowed just four hits, good for a .118 batting average against (4-for-34) that is tied for the third lowest among Triple-A pitchers. He has not allowed an earned run in 15 of 17 appearances (one start) since June 5, earning a 0.78 ERA (2er/23.0ip) that leads Triple-A pitchers in that span (min. 20.0ip).

JOHAN ON THE MEND: RHP Johan Oviedo had his rehab assignment transferred from Double-A Altoona to Indianapolis today and will be making his first start tonight with Indianapolis since Aug. 27, 2022. Oviedo missed the entire 2024 season after undergoing Tommy John surgery and made his first rehab appearance with the FCL Pirates on June 30. After allowing two runs in his first and only rehab start in the FCL, he has pitched to a 2.31 ERA (3er/11.2ip) with 15 strikeouts and a 1.11 WHIP in four starts between Low-A Bradenton and Altoona. In 39 starts with the Pirates since being acquired on Aug. 1, 2022, Oviedo is 11-16 with a 4.15 ERA (96er/208.1ip) and 186 strikeouts. He has made five appearances (four starts) with Indianapolis, all in 2022, and logged a 0.79 ERA (1er/11.1ip) with 13 strikeouts and a 0.97 WHIP. Oviedo is one of nine rehabbers assigned to Indy this season on 10 separate stints.

TONIGHT'S MATCHUP: The Indianapolis Indians and Iowa Cubs begin their second of three six-game series this season at 7:38 PM from Principal Park. Rehabber Johan Oviedo will make his first Triple-A start of the season. Oviedo has made three starts against Iowa, all in 2022, and has pitched to a 5.40 ERA (6er/10.0ip) with 16 strikeouts. Between his last two starts against the I-Cubs, on Aug. 16 and 21, he allowed one run across 4.2 innings while fanning eight batters. He will be opposed by RHP Kenta Maeda, fresh off a 6.0 inning one-hit effort on July 23 at Louisville. In one career start against Indy, on May 19, 2024, at Victory Field while with Toledo, Maeda struck out six Indians while allowing three hits and one run in 3.0 innings of work.

ON THIS DATE IN 2018: Indians right-handers Damien Magnifico and Jesus Liranzo combined for a 7.0-inning one-hitter while playing as the away team in Game 2 of a doubleheader against Buffalo at Victory Field. Each team was held to just one hit through six scoreless frames before back-to-back RBI singles by Erich Weiss and Kevin Newman put Indianapolis on the board in the top of the seventh. It was the Indians' ninth one-hitter in the Victory Field era and fourth at home, despite being designated as the away team.

TONIGHT'S PITCHER

Johan Oviedo: Oviedo is making his first start with Indianapolis since Aug. 27, 2022.

Bucco Aboard: Oviedo joins the Indians as their ninth rehabber this season. He has not pitched since Sept. 27, 2023 with Pittsburgh after undergoing Tommy John surgery during the 2024 offseason. He has pitched to a 4.15 ERA (96er/208.1ip) with 186 strikeouts in 39 starts with Pittsburgh.

Indianapolis: In five appearances (four starts) with Indianapolis, all in 2022, Oviedo has pitched to a 0.79 ERA (1er/11.1ip) with 13 strikeouts and a 0.97 WHIP.

Against the I-Cubs: Oviedo has made three starts against Iowa and has earned a 5.40 ERA (6er/10.0ip) with 16 strikeouts. Between his last two appearances against the I-Cubs, on Aug. 16 and 21, 2022, he allowed one run on four hits while striking out eight in 4.2 innings of work.

Going the Distance: Oviedo tossed his first career complete-game shutout on Aug. 28, 2023 at Kansas City, surrendering two hits and two walks while striking out five. It was the first complete-game shutout in which there were two or fewer hits allowed by a Pirates pitcher since April 8, 2018, when Jameson Taillon allowed one hit across 9.0 scoreless innings vs. Cincinnati. Oviedo's shutout was his second start of a six-start span from Aug. 22-Sept. 21, 2023 in which he earned a 3-1 record with a 2.23 ERA (8er/32.1ip) and 28 strikeouts.

Miscellaneous: Oviedo was acquired by Pittsburgh from St. Louis with 3B Malcom Nuñez in exchange for RHP Chris Stratton and LHP Jose Qunitana on Aug. 1, 2022.
