### LAST ACTION: [The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers beat the Great Lakes Loons 11-4 at Dow Diamond on Saturday, May 23.](#)

Sunday's series finale with the Loons was rained out, the eighth time a Rattlers game has been game rained out this season. On Saturday, the Rattlers scored four times in the top of the second on a two-run triple by Luiyin Alastre, an RBI single by Josiah Ragsdale, and a run-scoring wild pitch for a 4-1 lead. The score was 6-4 in favor of the Rattlers heading into the top of the ninth when Wisconsin scored five times to put away the game.

**FIRST!** Jason Woodward earned his first professional victory on Saturday. He allowed two runs – one earned – on three hits with four walks and four strikeouts.

**SAVINGS PLAN:** Bjorn Johnson entered the game with the Rattlers leading 6-3 with two on and two out in the bottom of the seventh inning. Johnson struck out Victor Rodrigues on three pitches to end the threat. In the eighth, the Loons pulled to within 6-4 and two on and two outs when Johnson escaped the jam by striking out Emil Morales and pitched a scoreless ninth for the save.

**THREE IS A MAGIC NUMBER:** Ragsdale was 3-for-5 on Saturday for his second straight three-hit game. He went 9-for-20 with seven runs scored in the series.

**FORE!** Josh Adamczewski drew four walks on Saturday. Adamczewski has an OBP of .456 and an OPS of 1.037 on the season.

**ABOUT PEORIA:** The Peoria Chiefs were in the Three-I League from 1953-1958 before the team folded. They were a St. Louis Cardinals affiliate from 1953-1957 and a New York Yankees affiliate in 1958. The Chiefs re-entered organized baseball when the Danville franchise moved to Peoria after the 1982 season. They were named the Peoria Suns and were affiliated with the California Angels for 1983 and 1984 with a change to the Chiefs nickname for 1984 followed by an affiliation switch to the Chicago Cubs for the 1985 season. Peoria became the Cardinals Midwest League affiliate for the first time in 1995, switched back to the Cubs in 2005, and went back to the Cardinals in 2013. The Chiefs won a Midwest League title in 2002. They made the Midwest League Championship Series in 2018 but lost to Bowling Green. Notable former Chiefs include Greg Maddux, Mark Grace, Albert Pujols, Yadier Molina, Nolan Gorman, and Victor Scott II.

**ABOUT THE CARDINALS:** St. Louis had several different Midwest League affiliates before settling back in Peoria in 2013. They were in Cedar Rapids from 1965-1972 before leaving the league until returning to the league to affiliate with the Springfield, Illinois team from 1982 through 1993. St. Louis spent one year with the Madison Hatters before their first affiliation with Peoria from 1995 through 2004. The Cardinals left Peoria for Quad Cities from 2005 through 2012.

# PITCHING MATCHUP

## WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

**LHP WANDE TORRES:** The Milwaukee Brewers signed Torres as an International Free Agent on June 3, 2022.

**ALL-STAR SEASON:** Torres made his professional debut with Milwaukee's #1 affiliate in the Dominican Summer League in 2022. He was 1-4 with a 3.79 ERA and struck out 45 over 40-1/3 innings in eleven starts. Torres was a midseason All-Star and retired the only batter he faced in the DSL All-Star Game that year.

**STARTING OVER:** Torres missed the entire 2023 season with an injury. He returned to the mound in 2024 and was 1-0 with 1.72 ERA in eight games – seven starts in the DSL. In his second stint in the DSL, Torres walked six and struck out 33 in 15-2/3 innings.

**CAROLINA:** Torres went 1-10 with the Carolina Mudcats last season. He had 85 strikeouts and an ERA of 4.81 in 86 innings. Torres tied for the Carolina League lead in starts with 23.

**LAST START:** Torres beat the Great Lakes Loons at Dow Diamond on [May 19](#). He pitched six scoreless innings, allowed two hits, walked one, and struck out six. Torres became the first Wisconsin pitcher to record a quality start this season with that performance.

**VS. PEORIA:** Torres is 1-0 in two starts – [April 18](#) and [May 6](#) – against the Chiefs this season. He has allowed eight runs on nine hits with seven walks and ten strikeouts over 8-2/3 innings in the games against Peoria.

## PEORIA STARTING PITCHER:

**RHP YHOIKER FAJARDO:** The St. Louis Cardinals acquired Yhoiker Fajardo in a trade with the Boston Red Sox on December 22, 2025. St. Louis sent Willson Contreras to Boston for Blake Aita, Fajardo, and Hunter Dobbins. Fajardo is MLB Pipeline's #12 prospect in the Cardinals organization.

**ORIGIN STORY:** The Chicago White Sox signed Fajardo as an International Free Agent out of Venezuela on February 20, 2024. He pitched for Chicago's Dominican Summer League affiliate and was named to the All-Star team. The White Sox traded Fajardo to Boston for Cam Booser on December 21, 2024.

**CHANGING SOX:** Fajardo started 2025 with Boston's affiliate in the Florida Complex League. He was promoted to the Salem Red Sox on June 17, 2025. He combined to go 1-4 with a 2.25 ERA in nineteen games – seventeen starts – last season. Fajardo struck out 83 over 72 innings pitched between the FCL and the Carolina League.

**LAST START:** Fajardo lost to Cedar Rapids at home on [May 19](#). He allowed five runs – three earned – on four hits with two hit batsmen, no walks, and five strikeouts over four innings. Fajardo allowed two homers in that start.

**VS. WISCONSIN:** Fajardo beat Wisconsin at Neuroscience Group Field on [April 19](#) in relief and had a no decision at Dozer Park in a start on [May 7](#). In his two starts against the Timber Rattlers, Fajardo has allowed one run on six hits with no walks and twelve strikeouts over ten innings
