ABOUT LAST NIGHT: [The Fort Wayne TinCaps beat the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers 4-3 in ten innings at Neuroscience Group Field.](#) Fort Wayne trailed 3-1 heading into the top of the ninth inning and scored twice to tie the game with a sacrifice fly by Lucas Dunn and an RBI double by Griffin Doerschling. Jay Beshears drove in the go-ahead run with a sacrifice fly in the top of the tenth. Wisconsin starting pitcher Logan Henderson allowed three hits, walked none, and struck out seven over four scoreless innings for a no decision.

FIRST TIME FOR EVERYTHING: Last night's loss with the first time Wisconsin has lost a game when leading after eight innings. It was also the first loss in extra innings for the Rattlers this season.

DOWN TO THE WIRE: The last five Wisconsin games have been decided in the final at bat. The Rattlers had won the previous four games, including two extra-inning wins and two walkoffs.

HE GETS ON BASE: Dylan O'Rae was hit by a pitch, singled, stole a base, and scored two runs for the Rattlers last night. O'Rae is on his second thirteen-game on base streak of the season. His previous streak was from April 28 through May 12. The current on base streak for O'Rae started on May 17. He is 13-for-44 (.295) with thirteen runs scored and ten walks during the current streak. Luis Lara has the longest on-base streak by a Rattler this season (16 games).

SPEAKING OF STREAKS: Ramón Rodríguez and Matt Wood both had hits last night to match their longest hitting streaks of the season. Rodríguez is 7-for-19 during his second five-game streak of the year. Wood is 6-for-17 in his fourth four-game streak in 2024.

STANDINGS CHECK: Wisconsin's lead in the West Division over the Cedar Rapids Kernels dropped to ½-game with the Kernels win Lake County last night.

ABOUT FORT WAYNE: The Fort Wayne TinCaps franchise started in Mattoon, Illinois for the 1947 season. That franchise moved to Keokuk, Iowa to become the Keokuk Cardinals from 1958 through 1962. The team moved again to Wisconsin Rapids, Wisconsin for 1963. They were affiliated with the Washington Senators in 1963 and became a Minnesota Twins affiliate after the Major League team moved to Minneapolis for the 1964 season. Wisconsin Rapids moved to Kenosha, Wisconsin for the 1984 season and remained an affiliate of the Twins. Fort Wayne joined the Midwest League after the Kenosha Twins were in 1992 and the franchise moved to Fort Wayne, Indiana for the 1993 season. The team renamed themselves as the Fort Wayne Wizards and stayed an affiliate of the Twins through the 1998 season. Fort Wayne affiliated with the San Diego Padres and has remained in that relationship to this day. There was one more move for the franchise. The team moved from Memorial Stadium to Parkview Field to start the 2009 season. They also changed their name to TinCaps for 2009. The TinCaps won the only MWL Pennant for the Fort Wayne entry of the franchise in 2009. Notable former Fort Wayne players include Torii Hunter, Jake Peavy, AJ Pierzynski, Josh Barfield, LaTroy Hawkins, Corey Kluber, David Freese, and Fernando Tatis Jr.

ABOUT THE PADRES: San Diego's relationship with Midwest League teams began in 1990 when they started an affiliation with the Waterloo Diamonds. That partnership moved to the Springfield Sultans with the Waterloo franchise for 1994. The Padres were the parent club of the Clinton LumberKings from 1995 through 1998 before joining with the Fort Wayne franchise for 1999.

PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

RHP YUJANYER HERRERA: The Milwaukee Brewers signed Herrera as an International Free Agent on August 17, 2019 out of Venezuela.

STARTING IN ARIZONA: Herrera made his professional debut in the Arizona Complex League in 2021 as he pitched for Milwaukee's Blue and Gold affiliates. He was 3-3 with a 9.00 ERA in eleven games – four starts – in 2021. Herrera walked 38 and struck out 37 over 35 innings. He also began the 2022 season in Arizona with a 2-3 record and a 5.36 ERA in eleven games – eight starts – before a move to Carolina in August of that year.

TIME IN CAROLINA: Herrera pitched for the Carolina Mudcats at the end of the 2022 season, the entire 2023 season, and the start of this season. He was 8-5 with a save and a 4.54 ERA in 30 games – thirteen starts – with 66 walks and 101 strikeouts over 111 innings pitched for the Mudcats.

PROMOTION TIME: Herrera made four relief appearances for the Mudcats in 2024 and was 3-0 with a 2.12 ERA. He walked six and struck out 27 in seventeen innings.

LAST START: Herrera lost at South Bend on [May 25](#). He allowed nine runs – seven earned – on nine hits with a walk and two strikeouts over three innings.

VS. FORT WAYNE: Herrera has never faced the TinCaps prior to this evening. Tonight is also the first time Herrera will pitch against an affiliate of the San Diego Padres.

FORT WAYNE STARTING PITCHER:

RHP DYLAN LESKO: The San Diego Padres selected Lesko in the first round of the 2022 draft out of Buford (GA) High School with the fifteenth pick.

FIRST TIME EVER: Lesko was the first high school junior to be named the Gatorade National Baseball Player of the Year when he won that award in 2021. However, Lesko underwent Tommy John surgery in April of 2022. The Padres still took him in the first round in 2022. He is currently the #3 prospect in the San Diego system as rated by MLB Pipeline.

LAST YEAR: Lesko made his pro debut in 2023 and pitched at three levels in the Padres system. He started in the Arizona Complex League and made four starts, moved to Lake Elsinore in the California League where he made five starts, and finished his season with Fort Wayne where he was 1-1 with a 4.50 ERA in three regular season starts. Lesko also made a playoff start for the TinCaps in their series with Great Lakes. He was 1-5 with a 5.45 ERA with 22 walks and 52 strikeouts over 33 innings pitched over his entire 2023 regular season.

LAST START: Lesko beat Lansing at home on [May 25](#). He allowed a run on two hits with three walks and six strikeouts over five innings.

VS. WISCONSIN: Lesko has never faced the Timber Rattlers prior to this evening. The only time he pitched against an affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers was on [July 4, 2023](#) against the Brewers affiliate in the Arizona Complex League. Lesko allowed two hits and struck out three over two scoreless innings for a no decision.
