INDY BITS

ABOUT THURSDAY: The Indianapolis Indians overcame an early deficit with a three-run first inning and staved off a comeback attempt by the Louisville Bats en route to a 7-4 win on Thursday afternoon at Victory Field. After the Bats knotted the game at three in the top of the fifth, Spencer Horwitz led off the bottom of the frame with a single and advanced to second on a Nick Solak groundout. Liover Peguero followed with an RBI to push the Indians ahead. After a two-run top of the first from the Bats, the Indians immediately responded as Billy Cook drove in a run with a single and DJ Stewart added two more with an RBI single of his own one batter later. Indy added some insurance in the later innings as Nick Solak came around to score after a leadoff double in the seventh and Fraizer and Spencer Horwitz each added a run on the board with solo homers in the eighth.

HUNTER BARCO: Left-hander Hunter Barco exited in the first inning on Thursday due to injury, tossing just 23 pitches and recording one out. He posted one hit, two runs, three walks and one strikeout. Barco departed the contest mid at-bat against Ivan Johnson, replaced by Carson Fulmer in relief.

MORE BUCCOS ABOARD: The Pittsburgh Pirates announced yesterday that second baseman Nick Gonzales began a major league rehab assignment with the Indianapolis Indians. Gonzales was placed on the 10-day injured list on March 28 with a non-displaced left ankle fracture. He sustained the injury during Opening Day on March 27 at Miami after hitting a two-run home run in the sixth inning. He excelled in 94 games with Pittsburgh last season, hitting .270 (97-for-359) with 19 doubles, three triples, seven home runs and 49 RBI. Across in 130 career games with Pittsburgh since debuting in 2023, he owns a .256 batting average (122-for-477) with 27 doubles, four triples, 10 home runs and 64 RBI. On Wednesday, catcher/first baseman Endy Rodriguez also began a rehab assignment with Indy. Rodriguez and Gonzales are the fifth and sixth rehabber assigned to Indy this season, following infielder Jared Triolo, right-handed pitcher Colin Holderman, first baseman Spencer Horwitz and right-handed pitcher Dauri Moreta. Rodriguez was placed on the 10-day injured list on April 15 with a right-hand laceration, sustaining the injury when struck by a pitch in the dirt on April 14 vs. Washington. He went 0-for-4 on Wednesday, starting at catcher.

PAIR O' PIRATES: First baseman Spencer Horwitz and right-handed pitcher Dauri Moreta had their rehab assignments transferred to Indianapolis on Tuesday last week. Horwitz was placed on the 10-day injured list on March 27, retroactive to March 24, after undergoing right wrist surgery on Feb. 12. Moreta was placed on the 60-day injured list on Feb. 16 after undergoing Tommy John surgery and being sidelined for the entire 2024 season. Nearly 14 months after his last professional appearance, the right-hander began a rehab assignment with High-A Bradenton on April 29 and tossed 2.0 scoreless innings in two games. Horwitz went 2-for-5 with a solo home run and two runs on Thursday, posting the fourth multi-hit game of his rehab assignment and second in a row. He plated the Indians seventh run of the game with a 372-foot blast to right field in the eighth inning. In eight games on the rehab stint, Horwitz hit .323 (10-for-31) with two doubles, one home run, two RBI, one walk and five runs. Moreta made his fourth appearance of his rehab stint on Thursday, earning his third hold with a scoreless fourth inning on one hit, one walk and one strikeout. Moreta threw 0.2 innings in Tuesday's series opener, allowing one run in the seventh inning on one hit and one walk. He tossed 1.1 innings on Friday night last week, allowing one run with one hit, one walk and two strikeouts. He tossed a scoreless sixth inning on Tuesday last week with one walk, striking out the side.

SOLAKECLIPSE: Nick Solak lit fire to the International League before being selected by Pittsburgh yesterday, ranking among International League leaders at the time of his promotion in batting average (.393, 44-for-112, 1st), OBP (.452, 2nd), OPS (1.077, 3rd) and SLG (.625, 4th). He went 3-for-5 with two doubles and two runs on Thursday, tallying his team-leading fifth three-hit contest on the campaign and extending his hitting streak to eight games. He has reached base safely in 29 of 32 games this season and has one-plus hit in 28 of those, including a team best 13-game hitting streak from April 3-23.

HOME COOKIN': The Indians improved to 14-6 at Victory Field this season and 7-2 in the current 12-game homestand, capturing 12 of their last 14 games at the venue. They have outscored opponents 89-79 at home this season for a +10 run differential. In their past 14 games at home since April 16, they are outscoring their opponents 68-46 in this span for a +22 run differential. Additionally, Indy earned their 11th comeback win of the season yesterday.

TONIGHT'S MATCHUP: The Indianapolis Indians continue their 12-game homestand and six-game series against the Louisville Bats with a seven-inning doubleheader today after yesterday's rain postponement. Game 1 is scheduled for 5:30 PM and Game 2 is set to take place about 30 minutes after the first game ends. The Indians can capture the series with a win, which would mark their third-straight home series win. It would be their first series win over Louisville since taking seven of eight games last season from Aug. 27-Sept. 1. Taking the mound for the Indians in Game 1 is right-hander Thomas Harrington who is set to make his seventh appearance and sixth start of the season. In his last outing, Harrington took his second consecutive loss on May 10 vs. Columbus, tossing 4.1 innings of one-run ball, posting season highs in hits (seven), walks (three) and strikeouts (seven). Harrington made one career appearance against the Bats, tossing 2.0 shutout innings out of the bullpen on May 13 at Louisville this season with two hits, no walks and three strikeouts. Opposite Harrington is Reds major league rehabber Rhett Lowder. He was placed on the 15-day injured list on March 26, retroactive to March 24, with a right forearm strain. Tonight marks the third stop on his rehab assignments, tossing 3.0 innings for the FCL Reds on May 6 and 3.0 innings for the Dayton Dragons on May 11. Lowder is set to make his first career appearance against Indianapolis. He made six starts with Cincinnati last season, going 2-2 with a 1.17 ERA (4er/30.2ip), 25 hits, 14 walks and 22 strikeouts.

G2: Right-hander Mike Burrows takes the mound following a stellar start in Sunday's series finale in which Burrows struck out a career-high 11 batters across 4.2 shutout innings with four hits and two walks, propelling Indianapolis to a 2-0 shutout win. He became the first Indians pitcher in the Victory Field era to post 11 strikeouts in 4.2 innings or fewer. In four career starts against the Bats, Burrows is 0-2 with a 4.20 ERA (7er/15.0ip), 14 hits, four walks, one hit batter and 12 strikeouts. Opposite Burrows is Bats right-hander Adam Plutko. In nine career games (eight starts) against Indy, he is 2-4 with a 5.72 ERA (32er/50.1ip), 59 hits, 21 walks and 40 strikeouts.

ON THIS DATE IN 1946: Paul "Duke" Derringer tossed a four-hit shutout vs. Kansas City as Indianapolis earned a 7-0 win in seven innings. He also led the offense with two singles and two RBI. Derringer's 15-year major league career ended in 1945 as a 223-game winner with the Cardinals, Reds and Cubs.

Thomas Harrington: The Campbell University alum is currently the Pirates' No. 3 prospect and Minor League Baseball's No. 84 overall prospect according to MLB Pipeline.

Major League Debut: Harrington had his contract first selected by Pittsburgh on April 1, 2025 and debuted with a 4.0 inning start the same night at Tampa Bay. Picked up his first career save in his next appearance on April 7 vs. St. Louis.

TONIGHT'S PITCHER

Mike Burrows: Right-hander Mike Burrows is set to make his eighth appearance and seventh start of the season, marking his sixth start at home.

Last Outing: In Sunday's series finale, Burrows struck out a career-high 11 batters across 4.2 shutout innings with four hits and two walks, propelling Indianapolis to a 2-0 shutout win.

Victory Field History: On May 11 vs. Columbus, Mike Burrows became the first Indians pitcher in the Victory Field era to post 11 strikeouts in 4.2 innings or fewer.

Against the Bats: In four career starts against the Bats, Burrows is 0-2 with a 4.20 ERA (7er/15.0ip), 14 hits, four walks, one hit batter and 12 strikeouts.

September Callup: Following his 10-strikeout performance in the Indians 2024 season finale, Burrows was recalled by Pittsburgh for his major league debut on Sept. 28 at New York (AL). He earned the win out of the bullpen, allowing two runs (one earned) over 3.1 innings. He struck out Oswaldo Cabrera swinging as his second batter faced for his first MLB punchout.

Prospectus: Burrows is currently rated as Pittsburgh's No. 13 prospect by *Baseball America* and No. 15 by MLB Pipeline.

Miscellaneous: Selected by Pittsburgh in the 11th round (324th overall) of the 2018 First-Year Player Draft out of Waterford (Conn.) High School... Had his contract first selected by Pittsburgh on Nov. 15, 2022.
