## ABOUT LAST NIGHT: [The West Michigan Whitecaps beat the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers 5-2 at LMCU Ballpark.](#)

Wisconsin took a 2-0 lead on a two-run home run in the first inning by Marco Dinges. The Whitecaps tied the game with two runs in the second. Kevin McGonigle hit a two-run homer in the bottom of the third to give West Michigan a 4-2 lead. Whitecaps pitchers retired the final seventeen Rattlers they faced in the game after Dinges singled with two outs in the top of the third.

**A RARE THING:** Last night was just the ninth time Wisconsin has lost a game in which they scored first. The Rattlers are 23-9 in 32 games where they scored first.

**END OF THE LINE:** Eduardo Garcia's 27-game on-base streak ended last night as he was 0-for-3 and did not reach base. His 27-game on-base streak is tied with Robert Moore for the longest on-base streak by a Rattler since the team moved to the High-A classification in 2021. Garcia also holds the longest on-base streak in the Midwest League this season.

**SPEAKING OF STREAKS:** Jader Areinamo singled and scored in the first inning last night. Areinamo is 15-for-33 during his current eight-game hitting streak.

**WALK THE LINE:** Tayden Hall drew a walk in the third inning last night. Hall has walked 40 times in 49 games with the Rattlers this season to lead the team in that category. He is tied for fifth in the Midwest League in walks. Max Clark of West Michigan, who also walked last night, leads the MWL in walks. The walks to Hall and Clark last night were the only two free passes handed out by the pitchers in the game.

**IT'S A NEW DAY! YES, IT IS!** The first half of the Midwest League season ended last night. West Michigan was the champion of the East Division after they clinched at Lansing last Friday. The Cedar Rapids Kernels clinched the West last night with a doubleheader sweep of the Beloit Sky Carp on the road. The records reset for everyone tonight.

**ABOUT WEST MICHIGAN:** The West Michigan Whitecaps joined the Midwest League in 1994 when the Madison Muskies moved to Comstock Park, Michigan following the 1993 season. The Whitecaps started play in the league as an affiliate of the Oakland Athletics. They became Low-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers for the 1997 season. The Whitecaps have won six Midwest League Pennants – 1996, 1998, 2004, 2006, 2007, and 2015. Notable former Whitecaps include Nick Castellanos, Joel Zumaya, Fernando Rodney, Francisco Cordero, Brandon Inge, Cameron Maybin, Alex Avila, and Willy Adames. The Whitecaps clinched the first half East Division Championship on June 13 and are in the Midwest League playoffs for the first time since 2018.

**ABOUT THE TIGERS:** Detroit has been affiliated with the Whitecaps since 1997. The Tigers had just one other stint in the Midwest League prior to their current partnership. They were with the Clinton Pilots from 1971 through 1975.

# PITCHING MATCHUP

## WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

**LHP SAM GARCIA:** The Milwaukee Brewers selected Garcia in the eighth round of the 2024 draft out of Oklahoma State.

**HITTING THE HIGH POINT:** Garcia pitched three seasons at High Point University from 2021 through 2023. He was a First Team All-Big South selection after his sophomore season when he was 5-4 with a save and a 1.94 ERA in sixteen games – eight starts.

**STILLWATER:** Garcia pitched for Brewster of the Cape Cod League in 2023 and transferred to Oklahoma State University for his final season of collegiate baseball. As a Cowboy, Garcia was 7-3 with a 3.64 ERA in sixteen starts. He had 115 strikeouts over 89 innings.

**STARTING OUT:** Garcia did not pitch professionally last year. He made his pro debut with the Carolina Mudcats this season and was 5-1 with a save and a 2.08 ERA in ten appearances – two starts. Garcia walked nineteen and struck out 44 in 34-2/3 innings with Carolina before his promotion to Wisconsin on June 3.

**LAST START:** Garcia lost a start at Great Lakes on [June 14](#). He allowed seven runs – six earned – on eight hits with three walks and six strikeouts over four innings.

**VS. WEST MICHIGAN:** Garcia has never faced the Whitecaps before tonight. This evening is also the first time he will pitch against an affiliate of the Detroit Tigers.

## WEST MICHIGAN STARTING PITCHER:

**RHP RAYNER CASTILLO:** The Detroit Tigers signed Castillo as an International Free Agent out of Venezuela on January 15, 2021.

**DOMINICAN SUMMER:** Castillo made his professional debut with Detroit's affiliate in the Dominican Summer League in 2021 with fourteen starts. He was 4-2 with a 2.88 ERA, fifteen walks, and 55 strikeouts over 59-1/3 innings.

**FLORIDA, MAN:** Castillo spent 2022, 2023, and a part of 2024 with the Florida Complex League Tigers. He finished the 2024 season with the Lakeland Flying Tigers in the Florida State League.

**LAST SEASON:** Castillo was 0-1 with a 2.79 ERA in three starts for the FCL Tigers. As a Lakeland Flying Tiger, Castillo made thirteen starts and was 4-1 with a 2.52 ERA. He struck out 56 and walked 23 in 70-1/3 innings over his entire 2024 season in the Tigers system.

**LAST START:** Castillo had a no decision at Lansing on [May 13](#). He allowed three runs on five hits with two walks and two strikeouts over four innings.

**VS. WISCONSIN:** Castillo lost to the Timber Rattlers in a start at Neuroscience Group Field on [May 2](#). He allowed four runs – three earned – on three hits and two walks with two strikeouts in one inning.
