LAST ACTION: [The Cedar Rapids Kernels beat the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers 9-6 at PG Cares Field on Sunday afternoon.](#) The Timber Rattlers had a 5-1 lead after the top of the third inning, but the Kernels outscored Wisconsin 8-1 after that point. Joe Gray Jr homered twice, doubled once, and drove in all six runs for the Timber Rattlers on Sunday. The Rattlers won the first three games of the series with the first-place Kernels, but Cedar Rapids won the final three games to get a split.

BIG BANGS: Sunday was Gray's third two-homer game of his career. He also had two homers in games against Quad Cities on August 25, 2021 and June 25, 2022. had runners on first and second with one out in the top of the first inning. Gray also had a six-RBI game on May 25, 2021 with the Carolina Mudcats against Kannapolis.

MAKE IT TEN: Gray added a double on Sunday for three hits and ten total bases.

THAT'S WEIRD: Gray and Darrien Miller drove in Wisconsin's last eleven runs in the series. Gray hit a three-run homer in the tenth inning on Wednesday in Wisconsin's 4-2 win. Miller drove in Wisconsin's lone runs on Thursday and Friday.

THE ONE THAT GOT AWAY: Wisconsin had a 5-1 lead after the top of the third inning. The Kernels scored twice in the third and a run in the fourth. Gray's RBI double in the top of the fifth gave the Rattlers a 6-4 lead. The Kernels scored twice in the fifth to tie the game and three times in the sixth to take the lead. The Timber Rattlers didn't have a hit after Gray's single in the fifth. Eduarqui Fernández walked with one out in the sixth, but he was thrown out trying to steal second to end the inning, and Wisconsin went down in order over the final three innings.

SUNDAY NO FUN DAY: The Timber Rattlers are 1-6 on Sunday's this season. They have lost their last five Sunday games. Wisconsin's last Sunday win was on April 16 over Peoria.

ABOUT PEORIA: The Peoria Chiefs were in the Three-I League from 1953-1958 before the team folded. They were a St. Louis Cardinals affiliate from 1953-1957 and a New York Yankees affiliate in 1958. The Chiefs re-entered organized baseball when the Danville franchise moved to Peoria after the 1982 season. They were named the Peoria Suns and were affiliated with the California Angels for 1983 and 1984 with a change to the Chiefs nickname for 1984 followed by an affiliation switch to the Chicago Cubs for the 1985 season. Peoria became the Cardinals Midwest League affiliate for the first time in 1995, switched back to the Cubs in 2005, and went back to the Cardinals in 2013. The Chiefs won a Midwest League title in 2002. They made the Midwest League Championship Series in 2018 but lost to Bowling Green. Patrick Anderson is in his second year as Peoria's manager. Notable former Chiefs include Greg Maddux, Mark Grace, Albert Pujols, and Yadier Molina.

ABOUT THE CARDINALS: St. Louis had several different Midwest League affiliates before settling back in Peoria in 2013. They were in Cedar Rapids from 1965-1972 before leaving the league until returning to the league to affiliate with the Springfield, Illinois team from 1982 through 1993. St. Louis spent one year with the Madison Hatters before their first affiliation with Peoria from 1995 through 2004. The Cardinals left Peoria for Quad Cities from 2005 through 2012.

PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES: [MLB Pipeline](#) places five active Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Eric Brown Jr (#6), Robert Moore (#8), Eduardo Garcia (#19), Matthew Wood (#24), and Joseph Hernandez (#25). Hendry Mendez (#13) is currently on Wisconsin's IL. [MLB Pipeline](#) has five active Peoria players on their list of Top 30 Cardinals prospects: Tink Hence (#3), Jimmy Crooks (#15), Ian Bedell (#24), Dionys Rodriguez (#26), and Victor Scott II (#27). Cooper Hjerpe (#6), Inohan Paniagua (#17), Austin Love (#19), and Zane Mills (#30) are on Peoria's IL.

PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP ALEXANDER CORNIELLE: Milwaukee signed Cornielle as an International Free Agent out of the Dominican Republic on June 15, 2019.

FAST DEBUT: Cornielle made his professional debut with one inning of relief against the Cubs #2 affiliate in the Dominican Summer League on August 2, 2019. He allowed one run on no hits with two walks in one inning. Cornielle made three appearances in the DSL in 2019 with no record and one run allowed over four innings.

HIT PLAY: Cornielle started the 2021 season with the Brewers Blue affiliate in the Arizona Complex League and was 4-2 in nine games – four starts – with a 4.64 ERA and 50 strikeouts over 33 innings pitched. He was called up to Carolina at the end of the season and was 0-1 in two starts with ten strikeouts in eight innings.

WEEKLY AWARD: Cornielle was named the ACL's Pitcher of the Week on September 6, 2021 after his performance against the White Sox on August 31, 2021. He allowed one run on one hit and two walks with six strikeouts over five innings in the game.

FEELING 2022: Cornielle was 9-7 in 22 games – 19 starts – with a 3.19 ERA and 124 strikeouts over 101-2/3 innings pitched for the Carolina Mudcats this season before joining the Timber Rattlers on August 23. He was second in the Carolina League in strikeouts and third in the Carolina League in ERA before his promotion to Wisconsin. Cornielle was 1-0 in three starts with Wisconsin and allowed four runs with six walks and 21 strikeouts over 17-1/3 innings pitched.

LAST START: Cornielle had a [no decision at Cedar Rapids on May 24](#). He allowed one run on two hits with two walks and three strikeouts over 5-1/3 innings. Misael Urbina hit a lead-off homer in the second inning for the only run Cornielle allowed in the game.

VS. PEORIA (2023): Cornielle is 0-1 in two starts against the Chiefs this season. He had a no decision at home on [April 12](#) and a loss at Peoria on [May 6](#). Cornielle has allowed seven runs on twelve hits with two walks and eight strikeouts over 7-2/3 innings in his two starts against the Chiefs.

PEORIA SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP TINK HENCE: The St. Louis Cardinals selected Hence in Competitive Balance Round-B with the 63rd pick of the 2020 draft out of Watson Chapel (AR) High School.

TURNING PRO: Hence signed with the Cardinals over a commitment to the University of Arkansas.

STARTING OUT: Hence made eight appearances – one start – for the Cardinals Florida Complex League affiliate in 2021. He was 0-1 with a save and allowed eight earned runs on eleven hits with three walks and fourteen strikeouts over eight innings.

STAYING IN FLORIDA: Hence made sixteen starts for the Palm Beach Cardinals in 2022. He was 0-1 with a 1.38 ERA and recorded 81 strikeouts with just 15 walks in 52-1/3 innings pitched.

HOW DOES HE RATE? MLB Pipeline places Hence as the #3 prospect in the Cardinals organization and #71 in their Top 100 for all minor league baseball. *Baseball America* puts him at #2 in the St. Louis System and #45 in their Top 100 for all minor league baseball.

LAST START: Hence had a [no decision against Great Lakes at home on May 24](#). He allowed three runs on three hits with two walks and five strikeouts over three innings. Damon Keith hit a three-run home run in the top of the first inning against Hence in that game.

VS. WISCONSIN: Hence made the [start against the Timber Rattlers on April 13, 2023](#) for a no decision. He allowed four hits with a walk and two strikeouts over 3-2/3 scoreless innings.
