2023: This year at Yankees MLB Spring Training, Warren threw two scoreless IP vs. Atlanta, allowing one hit.

2022: Began his rookie season in 2022 by pitching to a 3.60 ERA with 42 strikeouts in 35 IP over eight starts in High-A Hudson Valley, before being promoted to Somerset on 5/29/22. Awarded his first career Pitcher of the Week honors on 7/10/22 with Somerset, after earning the win on 7/6 vs. Bowie, when he went a career-high 7.0 IP, 0 R, 3 H and 5 K. Warren began the season ranked by Baseball America as Yankees No. 27 prospect, before jumping to No. 8 in the publications's mid-season rankings. After being unranked on MLB Pipeline's list of top 30 Yankees prospects pre-season, Warren was ranked No. 25 in their first mid-season update and in the publication's August update, he jumped to their No. 8 ranked Yankees prospect.

2021: Did not pitch in 2021 season after being drafted--instead worked with the Yankees strength and conditioning department to gain 15 lbs. of muscle, also worked to add a slider and two-seam fastball to his repertoire.

College: Attended Southeastern Louisiana University, where he was named to the 2021 Southland All-Conference Team his senior year, going 7-2 with a 2.57 ERA and 95 strikeouts in 91 innings over 14 starts. Warren led the Southeastern staff in wins (7), innings pitched (91.0), strikeouts (95) and opponent batting average (.214). He ranked third, second, fourth and fifth in the conference in those same categories, respectively, while also finishing fourth in ERA (2.57). Threw a career-high 116 pitches in final collegiate start vs. Northwestern State. Finished his Southeastern Louisiana career with a 13-10 career record, four saves and a 3.90 ERA. He allowed only 178 hits in 205.0 career innings pitched, striking out 193 batters.

Personal Notes: No. 4 ranked RHP in Mississippi class of 2017 by Perfect Game, was state champion at Jackson Prep as a senior, when he went 7-0 with a 1.39 ERA.

Career Notes: Selected by the Yankees in the 8th round of the 2021 MLB Draft.

2022: Spent the beginning of his second season with the Dodgers in Double-A Tulsa making 18 appearances (16 GS), continuing to serve primarily as an opener, working no more than 4 IP in any of his starts, posting an 0-3 record with a 5.75 ERA and 15.33 K/9 IP. Beeter was acquired by the Yankees from the Dodgers hours before the 2022 MLB trade deadline on August 2 as the lone piece received in exchange for outfielder Joey Gallo. At the time of the trade, Beeter was ranked the Dodgers' No. 21 prospect by Baseball America, which credited him with having the Best Curveball in the Dodgers MiLB system. Beeter made his Yankees organizational debut with Double-A Somerset on 8/10/22, pitching three scoreless innings in which he posted six strikeouts and allowed only one baserunner (BB). In seven starts to end the season with Somerset, he posted a 2.13 ERA over 25.1 IP with 41 K and 11 BB (14.57 K/9 IP). Across his 7 GS with Somerset to end 2022, Beeter set and matched a new career-high 9 K on 8/27/22 vs. NH and 9/3/22 @BNG. Over this stretch, he also set a new career high in IP three different times, including his last start of the regular season on 9/16/22 vs. POR, when he threw five scoreless innings and posted 7 K, with 2 H and 2 BB. Beeter matched this career-high mark of 5 IP in his lone postseason start on 9/22/22 vs. POR. He allowed 2 R (1 ER) with 6 K, getting credit for a no-decision in Somerset's first home playoff win as the Yankees' Double-A affiliate.

2021: Made his pro debut in 2021 and posted a 3.44 ERA between High-A Great Lakes and Double-A Tulsa, working mostly as an opener, going no more than 3.1 IP in any outing.

College: Beeter was drafted out of Texas Tech University, where he redshirted his freshman year. In his redshirt freshman year as the Red Raiders' closer in 2019, Beeter led Texas Tech to the 2019 College World Series semifinals behind 21 appearances with an 0-3 record, 3.48 ERA, 8 SV and 40 K, compared to 20 BB in 20.2 IP. During the Covid-shortened 2020 season, his redshirt sophomore year, Beeter became Texas Tech's Friday night starter. In 4 GS, he went 2-1 with a 2.14 ERA and 33 K, compared to 4 BB in 21.0 IP, before the remainder of the season was cancelled due to the COVID-19 pandemic. **Personal Notes:** Attended Birdville High School in Colleyville, TX. Beeter had Tommy John surgery in high school during December of 2017, as well as a follow-up arthroscopic elbow procedure seven months later. As a senior in high school, he earned first-team All-District honors with a 0.81 ERA and 106 K over 55 IP. At the plate, he had a .417 AVG with 2 HR. A two-sport athlete, Beeter also lettered in football three years during high school.

Career Notes: Initially drafted by the Los Angeles Dodgers in Competitive Balance Round-B of the 2020 MLB Draft (pick 66 overall), Beeter signed for an over-slot amount of \$1,196,500. Born and raised in Fort Worth, TX, Beeter was a Texas Rangers fan, who grew up watching Joey Gallo: the player he was eventually traded for on 8/2/22 from the Dodgers to the New York Yankees.







Just hours prior to this year's Futures Game, Dominguez was surprised by his Single-A Tampa teammate OF Grant Richardson that he had been promoted to High-A in a viral video that took place in manager Rachel Balkovec's office. In his final week with Hudson Valley, Dominguez earned his first career Player of the Week honors. On 9/12/22, he was named the SAL Player of the Week, for having gone 8-for-20 with 6 RBI, 5 R, 3 HR, 3B, 4 BB, 5 K, SB (.400/.500/.950). In his final High-A game, Dominguez homered from both sides of the plate for the Renegades, the first multi-HR game of his professional career, coming in his 171st career game. After spending his final week of the regular season in Somerset, slashing .105/.227/.368 over five games, Dominguez broke out in the postseason to help lead the Patriots to their first ever Eastern League Championship. In Somerset's Championship-clinching game on 9/28/22, Dominguez went 3-for-4 with 6 RBI and 2 HR, one from each side of the plate. Across five postseason games Dominguez led the Patriots in the following offensive categories: BA (.450), OBP (.560), SLG (.950), OPS (1.510), RBI (10), R (7), BB (5), HR (3).

Entering the 2021 season, Dominguez was recognized by Baseball America being the "Best Power Hitter," "Fastest Baserunner," "Best Athlete," "Best Defensive Outfielder" and as having the "Best Outfield Arm" among all Yankees farmhands.

Personal Notes: Jasson was nicknamed "The Martian" as a teenager growing up in the Dominican Republic, when someone called him "El Marciano" because of the other-wordly tools and abilities he possesses for a player his age. 
