ABOUT LAST NIGHT: <u>The Cedar Rapids Kernels beat</u> the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers 6-5 at Rise 2 Greatness Field. The Timber Rattlers rallied from a 5-1 deficit with a run in the eighth and three runs in the ninth to tie the game. Jorel Ortega won the game with a two-out, single off the wall in left field to score Emmanuel Rodriguez from first with the winning run. **GETTING DINGED:** The Kernels hit two solo homers

last night: Ben Ross in the first and Kyler Fedko in the third. Cedar Rapids lead the Midwest League in homers with 114. They have hit seven home runs in this series and eighteen homers in the season series with Wisconsin.

MAKE THEM SWEAT: The Timber Rattlers put together a two-out rally in the top of the eighth inning on a double by Luis Lara, a walk to Ben Metzinger, and an RBI single by Brock Wilken. The first four Rattlers to bat in the top of the ninth reached on back-to-back doubles by Hendry Mendez and Darrien Miller, a walk to Jose Acosta, and an RBI single by Jheremy Vargas to pull to within 5-4. Terence Doston grounded into a 4-6-3 double play to score Acosta with the tying run. **STREAKING:** Mike Boeve singled in the sixth inning to extend his hitting streak to six-games and his on-base streak to ten games. Lara's double means he has at least one hit in each of his first four games with Wisconsin.

ON ASSIGNMENT: Jesse Winker went 1-for-3 last night. In four games on his rehabilitation assignment from Milwaukee, Winker was 5-for-13 with two walks, two runs, and two RBI.

ABOUT CEDAR RAPIDS: The current franchise began its existence as the Cedar Rapids Braves, an affiliate of the Milwaukee Braves in the Three-I League, in 1958. That was the same year and league the current Timber Rattlers franchise joined the Three-I League as the Fox Cities Foxes. Both teams moved to the Midwest League when the Three-I League ended after the 1961 season. Cedar Rapids has been called the Braves, Red Raiders, Cardinals, Astros, Giants, and Reds until they became the Kernels in 1993. That was the same year the California Angels became the parent club of the Kernels. That affiliation remained through the 2012 season. Cedar Rapids has been affiliated with the Minnesota Twins since 2013. The Kernels have made the Midwest League playoffs every year they have been affiliated with the Twins, including this year. Notable alumni include Mike Trout, Byron Buxton, Trevor Hoffman, Brewers Pitching Coach Chris Hook, and Ted Simmons.

ABOUT THE TWINS: Minnesota has a long history of in the Midwest League. They started out with Wisconsin Rapids (1964-1983) and moved to Kenosha (1984-1992) and to Fort Wayne (1993-1998) as the franchise moved. Minnesota has also been with Quad Cities (1999-2004) and Beloit (2005-2012) before their current affiliation with Cedar Rapids Kernels started in 2013.

PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES: <u>MLB Pipeline</u> places seven active Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Brock Wilken (#8), Luis Lara (#9), Robert Moore (#17), Mike Boeve (#18), Bradley Blalock (#19), Matthew Wood (#25), and Hendry Mendez (#29). Eric Brown Jr (#12) is currently on Wisconsin's IL. <u>MLB</u> <u>Pipeline</u> has ten active Kernels on their list of Minnesota prospects: Emmanuel Rodriguez (#3), Cory Lewis (#13), CJ Culpepper (#14), Jose Salas (#17), Kala'i Rosario (#19), Noah Miller (#24), Zebby Matthews (#25), Ben Ross (#26), Alejandro Hidalgo (#28), and Noah Cardenas (#30). PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP EDWIN JIMENEZ: Milwaukee signed Jimenez as an International Free Agent out of Venezuela on October 11, 2018.

HEADING TO THE CO-OP: Jimenez was assigned to the Dominican Summer League Co-op team shared between Milwaukee and Cleveland for the 2019 season. Jimenez was 1-5 with a 3.05 ERA in twelve games – eight starts. He walked 26 and struck out 32 over 41-1/3 innings in his first professional season.

FROM THE ISLAND TO THE DESERT: Jimenez started the 2021 season with Milwaukee's number two affiliate in the Dominican Summer League. He was assigned to the Brewers Blue affiliate in the Arizona Complex League on August 7, 2021. Jimenez went 1-1 with a 1.72 ERA in five games – four starts – in the DSL and 0-4 with a save and a 5.25 ERA in the ACL. He walked twelve and struck out 48 over 39-2/3 innings combined between his two stops in the system that season.

CAROLINA ON MY MIND: Jimenez was 4-7 in 25 games – seventeen starts – with the Carolina Mudcats in 2022. He had a 4.75 ERA, walked 41, and struck out 104 over 113-2/3 innings pitched in the Carolina League last season. Jimenez started the 2023 season with Carolina and went 2-0 in four games – one start – with five walks and 23 strikeouts over eighteen innings before his promotion to Wisconsin on May 2.

PITCHER OF THE WEEK! Jimenez was named the Midwest League Pitcher of the Week on July 31. He earned the award by striking out ten Cedar Rapids batters over 7-1/3 scoreless innings on July 30. He walked three and didn't allow a hit until there was one out in the eighth inning.

LAST START: Jimenez beat Dayton at home on <u>August 13</u>. He allowed one run on four hits over 7-1/3 innings. Jimenez walked one and struck out five.

VS. CEDAR RAPIDS: Jimenez is 2-0 in two starts – May 25 and July 30 – against the Kernels this season. He has allowed two runs on five hits with four walks and fifteen strikeouts over 12-1/3 innings against the Kernels in 2023

CEDAR RAPIDS SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP ZEBBY MATTHEWS: The Minnesota Twins selected Matthews in the eighth round of the 2022 draft out of Western Carolina University.

PARAMOUNT CATAMOUNT: Matthews was 13-9 with a 3.58 ERA in 36 games – 24 starts – during his career at Western Carolina. He had 211 strikeouts over 183-1/3 innings pitched with just 30 walks during his three-year career. In his final season at WCU, Matthews was 4-6 with four saves in 22 games – ten starts – with 122 strikeouts over 95-2/3 innings.

MOVING ON UP: Matthews made two relief appearances as a professional in 2022 after signing with the Twins. He pitched one scoreless inning with two strikeouts for Minnesota's Florida Complex League team before working two scoreless innings with four strikeouts for the Fort Myers Mighty Mussels in the Florida State League.

BACK IN FLORIDA: Matthews made eight appearances – seven starts – with Fort Myers to start the 2023 season. He was 3-1 with a 2.56 ERA. Matthews walked five and struck out 53 in 38-2/3 innings in the Florida State League before his promotion to Cedar Rapids on May 28.

LAST START: Matthews lost at Quad Cities on <u>August 8</u>. He allowed five runs – four earned – on six hits with two walks and six strikeouts over 4-1/3 innings.

VS. WISCONSIN: Matthews had a no decision at Wisconsin on <u>July</u> <u>27</u>. He allowed two runs on five hits with no walks and seven strikeouts over six innings. Robert Moore hit a solo homer against Matthews. The game was tied 2-2 when Matthews left the game. The Rattlers would win 4-3 in ten innings.
