ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Toledo Mud Hens broke up a shutout bid with a pair of runs in each of the game's final two frames to defeat the Indianapolis Indians 4-3 on Friday night at Victory Field. A leadoff triple by Ji Hwan Bae and two-run homer by Billy Cook began the game for Indianapolis. Meanwhile, Drake Fellows tossed 4.0 shutout innings to extend his scoreless streak to 14.0 innings since July 12 vs. Gwinnett. Ryder Ryan then followed with a pair of perfect frames, holding the game scoreless before the Indians extended their lead to 3-0 in the bottom of the sixth on a Brett Sullivan RBI single. Toledo rallied late, bringing the score to one run on a two-run single by Andy Ibañez in the eighth against Kyle Nicolas. A run-scoring fielder's choice and bases-loaded walk in the ninth then gave the Mud Hens the advantage they needed for the win. Trevin Michael tossed 3.0 one-run innings before Matt Seelinger entered for the scoreless bottom of the ninth.

WINDIANAPOLIS: Despite last night's loss, the Indians are pacing full-season minor league teams in home wins (41) and winning percentage (.745, 41-14). The Indians' home win total matches or surpasses their full-season total in 22 of 27 full seasons in the Victory Field era (since 1996). They have won 13 of their last 16 games played at home since June 27 and 31 of their last 39 since May 11. Their home winning percentage is the highest for a Triple-A team to this point in the season since at least 2005 and is on pace to surpass San Antonio (.49-21, .700) for the highest home winning percentage by a Triple-A team in a full season in that span. They have not lost more than three consecutive games this season, joining Durham as the only Triple-A clubs to have not done so on the campaign. The Indians have not completed a season without losing three or more games in a row since 2006, when they dropped three straight games seven times that season, compared to two instances for the 2025 Indians.

JOLLY GOOD FELLOWS: Drake Fellows logged his third straight scoreless start since July 12 vs. Gwinnett, extending his scoreless-innings streak to 14.0 innings, the second longest on the team this season. Fellows is the first Indians pitcher to record three consecutive scoreless starts since Paul Skenes did not allow a run across his first four starts of 2024 (March 30-April 18). He is one of three Triple-A pitchers with at least 10.0 innings pitched in that span to record a 0.00 ERA, and he has tossed the most innings of the three. Additionally, he has held opponents to the sixth-lowest OPS (.505) in that span. In six second-half starts, Fellows has pitched to a 2-1 record with a 2.19 ERA (6er/24.2ip) and a .207 batting average against (18-for-87). Additionally, he lowered his ERA to 3.03 (12er/35.2ip) in 12 appearances (five starts) at Victory Field this season.

LET BILLY COOK: Billy Cook clobbered his fourth home run in his last five games since July 20 last night. Across this span, in which he has also recorded three multi-hit games, Cook ranks among International League hitters in RBI (1st, 9), hits (T-1st, 9), home runs (2nd, 4), slugging percentage (2nd, .955), total bases (2nd, 21), OPS (3rd, 1.390) and batting average (8th, .409, 9-for-22) Since his two-homer game against Gwinnett on July 12, he is tied for the second-most home runs among all Triple-A hitters with six. He is also tied for the seventh-most home runs in July with seven.

THREE-BAG BAE: Ji Hwan Bae led off the Indians half of the first inning with a triple, his fourth in 12 games since July 8, which leads all full-season minor league hitters in that span. He is the first Indians hitter to tally four or more triples in a month since Travis Swaggerty (four) in July 2022. On the campaign, he has reached base safely in 39 of 44 games, in 16 of his last 18 since June 28 and in each of his last seven since July 18. Since returning from the 7-day injured list on June 27, he has a .917 OPS and ranks among International League hitters in stolen bases (2nd, 11), walks (T-4th, 14), on-base percentage (7th, .438), hits (T-7th, 25), runs scored (T-7th, 18) and batting average (10th, .342, 25-for-73). Additionally, Bae has not made an error this season, converting on all 85 chances between the three outfield positions.

FLAVA FRAIZ: Matt Fraizer picked up two hits in last night's contest, extending his active hitting streak to seven games since July 4 vs. Louisville. Across his streak, he ranks third among International League hitters (min. 25 PA) in batting average (10-for-23) and is tied for fourth in on-base percentage (.500). Additionally, he has recorded a double in five of the seven games of his hitting streak. Since June 13, he has hit safely in 15 of 17 games with a plate appearance, hitting .345 (20-for-58) with seven doubles, and a .872 OPS in that span.

YEAN SHORTS: Eddy Yean tallied his eighth-straight scoreless appearance since June 27 on Thursday, only trailing his own nine-game streak from April 11-May 11 for the longest on the team this season. He is the only Triple-A pitcher (min. 10.0ip) across his streak with no runs allowed and the only pitcher to hold a 0.00 ERA During this span, Yean has gone 2-0, picked up a save and has allowed just four hits, good for a .133 batting average against (4-for-30). He has not allowed an earned run in 13 of 15 appearances (one start) since June 5, good for a 0.84 ERA (2er/21.1ip) that leads Triple-A pitchers in that span (min. 20.0ip).

BUCCO BORUCKI: LHP Ryan Borucki had his rehab assignment transferred from Low-A Bradenton to Indianapolis on Friday last week. He made one rehab appearance with Bradenton on July 8, tossing a scoreless inning with one strikeout before being transferred to Indianapolis. Borucki has made 81 appearances with Pittsburgh since signing as a minor league free agent on May 9, 2023. In those appearances, he is 5-3 with a 4.09 ERA (35er/77.0ip) and a 1.04 WHIP. In 2023, the southpaw set the record for the lowest WHIP (0.74) of any Pirates pitcher with at least 40.0 innings pitched in a season. With the Pirates in 2025, he has held left-handed hitters to the lowest batting average (.087, 4-for-46) of any major league pitcher (min. 40 AB against lefties), before hitting the 15-day IL on June 21 with low back inflammation. In 25 appearances with Indy, he has logged a 2.52 ERA (7er/25.0ip) with 33 strikeouts. 21 of his appearances have been scoreless, including four of the five on his current rehab stint.

TONIGHT'S MATCHUP: The Indianapolis Indians look to clinch their fourth-straight six-game series win since June 24-29 vs. Omaha in tonight's matchup against the Toledo Mud Hens at 7:05 PM from Victory Field. Since the beginning of the 2023 season, the Indians are 23-11 against Toledo at Victory Field, tied for the third-most wins against an opponent of any Triple-A team. Southpaw Hunter Barco is set to make his 12th Triple-A start of the season and his ninth at Victory Field, where the Indians are 6-2 in his starts. This will be Barco's first-career start against the Mud Hens. He will face off against RHP Woo-Suk Go, who is making his third start in his 65th career appearance. He has made two appearances against the Indians, both in relief, and has allowed two runs across 2.2 innings of work.

ALL THE DOGS ARE BARC'ING: Hunter Barco, MiLB's No. 72 prospect according to MLB Pipeline, is looking to pick up his third-straight win in tonight's contest. At Victory Field this season, Barco has pitched to a 2-0 record with a 2.00 ERA (8er/36.0ip), 40 strikeouts and has held opponents to a .146 batting average (18-for-123). Additionally, he has a 2.77 ERA (8er/26.0ip) with a 0.96 WHIP in five second-half starts. The 6-foot-4 lefty has held opposing right-handed hitters to a .132 batting average (14-for-106) in Triple-A this season, which is the second-lowest mark for a lefty pitcher against right-handed hitters this season (min. 100 ABs).

ON THIS DATE IN 1967: Trailing 5-2 in the middle of the eighth at old Victory Field, the Indians plated one run in the eighth and two in the ninth to force extra innings, where they won in 11 frames, 6-5. Slugging first baseman Jim Hicks clubbed his 15th home run as part of a four-hit game, and Charles Nash belted his 13th homer while driving in three.

TONIGHT'S PITCHER

Hunter Barco: The southpaw ranks as Pittsburgh's No. 3 prospect and Minor League Baseball's No. 72 overall prospect according to MLB Pipeline.

Historic Zeroes: Barco did not allow a run in his six starts with Double-A Altoona, totaling 25.2 consecutive scoreless innings to begin the season, marking the longest scoreless streak in Curve history.

Last Outing: Barco allowed four runs on four hits and two walks while striking out two on July 19 at Nashville.

Against the Mud Hens: Tonight will mark Barco's first-career start against Toledo.

EAS Pitcher of the Month: Barco was awarded the 2025 Eastern League April Pitcher of the Month Award after leading the league (min. 20ip) in ERA (0.00, 20.2ip) and batting average against (.132, 9-for-68), while ranking second in WHIP (0.63) and tied for fourth in strikeouts (30).

Mowing Them Down: Barco finished his award-winning April with back-to-back eight-strikeout starts, the last of which came in just 3.0 innings of work on April 27 at Double-A Chesapeake. He became the first Pirates full-season farmhand to strike out eight or more batters in 3.0 innings or less since Osvaldo Bido also struck out eight in 3.0 innings vs. Triple-A Louisville on Aug. 4th, 2022.

Miscellaneous: Barco was selected by the Pirates in the second round (44th overall) of the 2022 First-Year Player Draft out of the University of Florida (Gainesville).
