SUNDAY AT DOZER PARK: The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers beat the Peoria Chiefs 14-6 at Dozer Park

Dylan O'Rae went 3-for-4 with a triple, a walk, a hit batsman, two RBI, and five runs scored. Wisconsin rallied from deficits of 3-1 and 5-3 as they scored in seven of the nine innings and cracked fourteen hits.

PAYBACK: The Timber Rattlers went 5-1 in the series at Peoria with wins in the final five games. Wisconsin had won just six games at Dozer Park in the 2022 and 2023 seasons.

THE LAST TIME IT HAPPENED: O'Rae became the first Timber Rattler to score five runs in a game since TJ Mittelstaedt scored five in a game against the Kane County Cougars on August 26, 2011.

WHAT A WEEK: Eduarqui Fernández went 11-for-21 with four doubles, two homers, five RBI, and seven runs scored with at least one hit in every game in the six-game series at Peoria. He capped his week by being named the Midwest League Player of the Week by MiLB on Monday afternoon.

SIX PACK: Fernández wasn't the only Rattler to extend his hitting streak to six games on Sunday. Luis Lara was 3-for-5 with three runs scored. Lara is 9-for-25 during his second six-game hitting streak of the season.

A WEEK OF SUNDAYS: Wisconsin is 4-0 on Sunday this season. Dating back to last season, the Rattlers have won seven straight Sunday games. Edwin Jimenez has been the winning pitcher in all seven of those Sunday games.

ABOUT GREAT LAKES: The Great Lakes Loons came into existence in 2007 after the Midwest League team left Battle Creek, Michigan at the end of the 2006 season. The team in Battle Creek had been known as the Michigan Battle Cats, Battle Creek Yankees, and the Southwest Michigan Devil Rays. The Loons have been affiliated with the Los Angeles Dodgers since 2007. They have made the Midwest League playoffs nine times since 2007. The Loons won the Midwest League title in 2016 and lost to Cedar Rapids in the Midwest League Championship Series in 2023. Notable Great Lakes alumni include Clayton Kershaw, Kenley Jansen, Nathan Eovaldi, Joc Peterson, Julio Urias, Walker Buehler, and Gavin Lux. Jair Fernandez, who played in 52 games with the Timber Rattlers in 2007, is the manager of the Loons in 2024.

ABOUT THE DODGERS: The Los Angeles Dodgers were only in the Midwest League for a few seasons prior to affiliating with the Loons. They were in Dubuque in 1967 and in Clinton from 1977 to 1979. Orel Hershiser and Steve Sax were notable Dodgers to play in Clinton.

PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES: MLB Pipeline places five active Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Luis Lara (#8), Luke Adams (#15), Dylan O'Rae (#20), Jader Areinamo (#22), and Patricio Aquino (#28). MLB Pipeline has five Great Lakes players on their list of Top 30 Dodgers prospects: Jackson Ferris (#7), Thayron Liranzo (#9), Maddux Bruns (#14), Noah Miller (#26), and Peter Heubeck (#30).

THE SEASON SO FAR: The Loons completed a six-game sweep at Fort Wayne on April 28. They are 14-7 and are the top team in the East Division. Great Lakes had not faced a team from the West before this series.

PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

LHP TATE KUEHNER: The Milwaukee Brewers selected Kuehner in the seventh round of the 2023 draft out of the University of Louisville.

MARSHALLING THE PAST: Kuehner played high school baseball in Marshalltown, Iowa. Former Timber Rattlers catcher Jeff Clement, the #3 pick in the 2005 draft, also played his high school baseball at Marshalltown.

CARDINAL RULE: Kuehner pitched four seasons with Louisville. He was 15-13 with nine saves and a 3.69 ERA over 70 appearances – fourteen starts – for the Cardinals. Kuehner had 193 strikeouts over 165-2/3 innings. During the 2022 NCAA Regionals in Louisville, Kuehner earned two saves and a win over seven innings in three scoreless appearances for the Cardinals.

COLLEGE SUMMER LEAGUES: Kuehner made five appearances for Waterloo in the Northwoods League in 2020 and four appearances for Danbury in the New England Collegiate Baseball League in 2021.

DOWN IN THE DESERT: Kuehner made two appearances – one start – for the ACL Brewers in the regular season after signing with Milwaukee in 2023. He had no record with a walk and two strikeouts over three scoreless innings.

PLAYOFF CALL: Kuehner was the winning pitcher for the ACL Brewers in the ACL Semifinal Game against the ACL Rockies on [August 24, 2023](#). He allowed a hit over two scoreless innings with no walks and two strikeouts. The Brewers won the game to advance to the ACL Championship Series.

LAST APPEARANCE: Kuehner allowed an unearned run in three innings as a reliever at Peoria on [April 24](#). He gave up three hits, walked one, and struck out four. Kuehner was charged with a blown save in the game.

LAST START: Kuehner made his first start as a Timber Rattler on [April 17](#) at home against Cedar Rapids in game two of a doubleheader. He allowed three runs on six hits with a walk and three strikeouts over two innings.

VS. GREAT LAKES: Kuehner has never faced the Great Lakes Loons prior to this evening. He has also never pitched against an affiliate of the Los Angeles Dodgers before tonight.

GREAT LAKES STARTING PITCHER:

LHP JACKSON FERRIS: The Los Angeles Dodgers acquired Ferris along with Zyhvir Hope from the Chicago Cubs in exchange for Michael Busch and Yency Almonte in a trade on January 11, 2024.

ORIGIN STORY: The Cubs selected Ferris in the second round of the 2022 draft out of IMG Academy in Bradenton, Florida. In his senior season, Ferris was 8-0 with a 1.33 ERA in ten games at IMG Academy. Ferris signed with the Cubs over a commitment to Mississippi.

A YEAR ON THE BEACH: Ferris did not pitch professionally in 2022. He began his career with the Myrtle Beach Pelicans in the Carolina League in 2023. Ferris was 2-3 with a 3.38 ERA in eighteen starts. Ferris walked 33 and struck out 77 over 56 innings pitched for the Pelicans.

YOU JUST MADE THE LISTS: MLB Pipeline ranks Ferris as the #7 prospect in the Dodgers system. The *2024 Baseball America Prospect Handbook*, which went to press before the trade, had Ferris as the #10 prospect in the Cubs system. The online update at Baseball America's website puts Ferris at #9 in the Dodgers system.

LAST START: Ferris beat Fort Wayne in game two of a doubleheader at Parkview Field on [April 24](#). He allowed one run on three hits with a walk and five strikeouts over five innings.

VS. WISCONSIN: Ferris has never pitched against the Timber Rattlers prior to this evening. This is also the first time he will pitch against an affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers.
