WEDNESDAY AFTERNOON: The South Bend Cubs beat the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers 8-2 at Neuroscience Group Field. Three Cubs pitchers held Wisconsin to two hits and retired the Rattlers in order in eight of nine innings. Jordan Nwogu drove in three runs for South Bend and the Cubs stole four bases on Tuesday.

FOUR PART HARMONY: Wisconsin's defense turned four double plays yesterday. The Rattlers doubled a runner off second in the first inning on a popup back to the mound in the first inning and turned a 6-4-3 double play in the third. Wisconsin also converted a 7-6-4 double play in the fourth and fifth innings on run scoring sacrifice flies. The Rattlers defense had fifteen double plays in their first 34 games of the season

HELPING HANDS: Left fielder Carlos Rodríguez had two outfield assists on the 7-6-4 double plays. The Rattlers have eight outfield assists this season.

TWO FROM THREE: Wisconsin's only base runners on Wednesday were in the fifth inning. Tristan Peters walked, and Darrien Miller singled to start the inning. Ashton McGee drove both runners in with a two-out

QUIET AFTERNOON: South Bend pitchers retired the first twelve Wisconsin batters of the game. They retired the final thirteen Rattlers of the game after the two-run double by McGee.

A RARE EVENT: Yesterday's loss was just the fourth home loss of the season for the Rattlers. Wisconsin is 13-4 in home games this season.

TIME: Wednesday's game was played in a fast-paced two hours and twelve minutes. Wisconsin's twelve nine-inning games at home this season have averaged 2:28 which is under the league average of 2:31. The Rattlers average game time includes a nine-inning game that was played without the pitch clock rules in effect. The 2021 Timber Rattlers played 47 nine-inning games at home and averaged a game time of 3:12. The league average game time in 2021 was 3:07.

ABOUT SOUTH BEND: The South Bend Cubs started as the South Bend White Sox when the Midwest League added them as an expansion team in 1988. They changed their name to the Silver Hawks for the 1994 season and became an affiliate of the Arizona Diamondbacks in 1997. South Bend became an affiliate of the Chicago Cubs. South Bend won Midwest League pennants in 1989, 1993, 2005, and 2019. Notable alumni for the South Bend franchise include Mike Cameron, Jose Valverde, Chris Capuano, Mark Reynolds, Justin Upton, Wade Miley, Chase Anderson, Keon Broxton, Gleyber Torres, Ian Happ, and Carlos Gonzalez. Terry Francona was the manager of the South Bend White Sox in 1982.

ABOUT THE CUBS: The Chicago Cubs had several different Midwest League affiliates before settling in South Bend in 2015. They were affiliated with Quincy from 1965 through 1973 before leaving the Midwest League. The Cubs returned to the MWL with an affiliation with Quad Cities from 1979 through 1984, Peoria from 1985 through 1994 and again from 2005 through 2012, Rockford from 1995 through 1998, Lansing from 1999 through 2004, Kane County in 2013 and 2014.

WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP JUSTIN JARVIS: Selected by Milwaukee in the 5th round of the 2018 draft out of Lake Norman High School in Mooresville, North Carolina

THE SENIOR SEASON: In his final season of high school, Jarvis was 8-2 with a 1.60ERA, and 95 strikeouts. Former Major Leaguer Ty Wigginton was his head coach.

A PERFECT DAY: Jarvis pitched a perfect game with 18 strikeouts in a game against East Rowan High School early in his senior season of high

NOT ON CAMPUS: Jarvis signed with the Brewers over a commitment to UNC-Wilmington.

YEAR ONE: Jarvis was 1-2 with a 6.63ERA in ten games - three starts for Milwaukee's Arizona League affiliate after signing with Milwaukee. He walked four and struck out 18 over 19 innings pitched in the Arizona League.

2019: Jarvis was 4-1 with a 3.50 ERA in 18 games - eleven starts - for the Timber Rattlers in 2019. He had 52 strikeouts over 74-2/3 innings.

2021: Jarvis was 1-7 with a 5.40 ERA in seventeen starts for the Timber Rattlers in 2021. He had 62 strikeouts over 63-1/3 innings

LAST START: Jarvis won at Quad Cities on May 12. He allowed two runs on six hits, including two solo homers, with two walks and six strikeouts over

SOUTH BEND STARTING PITCHER:

LHP JORDAN WICKS: The Chicago Cubs picked Wicks in the first round -21st overall – in the 2021 draft out of Kansas State. MLB Pipeline ranks Wicks as the #5 prospect in the Cubs system. Baseball America rates Wicks at #6 in their mid-season update of Cubs prospects.

WILD, CAT: Wicks pitched at Kansas State from 2019 through 2021. He was 15-6 with a 3.24ERA in 34 starts at Kansas State. He walked 58 and struck out 230 in 203 innings pitched over his career. Wicks was named First Team All-Big Twelve and a Third Team All-American. He was the first Kansas State player to be named an All-American since 2013.

NORTH WOODS: Wicks pitched for the Rockford Rivets during the 2020 Northwoods League season. He made four starts and had 29 strikeouts over 20 innings pitched.

SOUTH BEND: Wicks joined the South Bend Cubs in September of 2021 after signing with Chicago. He had no record in four starts and allowed four runs on seven hits with three walks and five strikeouts over seven innings pitched with South Bend last season.

LAST START: Wicks had a no decision against the Fort Wayne TinCaps at home on May 13. He allowed two runs on three hits with two walks and five strikeouts over 4-2/3 innings.

VS. WISCONSIN: Wicks has never faced the Timber Rattlers prior to this evening. Today will be the first time Wicks will pitch against an affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers.
