ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The game between the Wisconsin Timber Ratters and Peoria Chiefs was suspended by rain after four innings with Wisconsin leading 1-0. Enoli Paredes made the start for Wisconsin on a rehab assignment for the Milwaukee Brewers and pitched a perfect first inning. Hedbert Pérez tripled and scored on a sacrifice fly by Eduardo Garcia in the bottom of the third for the only run of the game. A seven-inning game will follow the conclusion of last night's suspended game.

ON ASSIGNMENT: Paredes and Trevor Megill will continue their rehab work with the Timber Rattlers on Sunday afternoon in the series finale with the Chiefs.

MULTI-BALL: Jadher Areinamo went 2-for-3 on Thursday for his 33rd multi-hit game of the season. Areinamo has 112 hits this season. Hector Rodriguez of Dayton leads the Midwest League with 116 hits.

HE'S BACK: Pérez went 2-for-4 with two RBI on Thursday. Those were his first hits and RBI since July 18, 2023 when he was injured in a game.

EARLY BIRDS: Wisconsin is 48-19 when scoring first. They have outscored opponents 75-37 in the first inning this season

ABOUT PEORIA: The Peoria Chiefs were in the Three-I League from 1953-1958 before the team folded. They were a St. Louis Cardinals affiliate from 1953-1957 and a New York Yankees affiliate in 1958. The Chiefs re-entered organized baseball when the Danville franchise moved to Peoria after the 1982 season. They were named the Peoria Suns and were affiliated with the California Angels for 1983 and 1984 with a change to the Chiefs nickname for 1984 followed by an affiliation switch to the Chicago Cubs for the 1985 season. Peoria became the Cardinals Midwest League affiliate for the first time in 1995, switched back to the Cubs in 2005, and went back to the Cardinals in 2013. The Chiefs won a Midwest League title in 2002. They made the Midwest League Championship Series in 2018 but lost to Bowling Green. Patrick Anderson is in his third year as Peoria's manager. Notable former Chiefs include Greg Maddux, Mark Grace, Albert Pujols, Yadier Molina, Nolan Gorman, and Victor Scott II.

ABOUT THE CARDINALS: St. Louis had several different Midwest League affiliates before settling back in Peoria in 2013. They were in Cedar Rapids from 1965-1972 before leaving the league until returning to the league to affiliate with the Springfield, Illinois team from 1982 through 1993. St. Louis spent one year with the Madison Hatters before their first affiliation with Peoria from 1995 through 2004. The Cardinals left Peoria for Quad Cities from 2005 through 2012.

PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES: MLB Pipeline places six active Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Cooper Pratt (#4), Luis Lara (#8), Luke Adams (#15), Jadher Areinamo (#21), Patricio Aquino (#28), Ryan Birchard (#30). MLB Pipeline has six Peoria players on their list of Top 30 Cardinals prospects: Chase Davis (#6), Leonardo Bernal (#8), Won-Bin Cho (#10), Brycen Mautz (#20), Zach Levenson (#21), and Pete Hansen (#25).

SECOND HALF CHIEFS: Peoria is 22-23 in the second half. They are 1-1/2 games behind Quad Cities for the second half West Division playoff spot. The Chiefs are coming off a series split with Cedar Rapids at home. They will start a home series with Fort Wayne after this series at Wisconsin. In 2023, Peoria won the second half West Division playoff spot but lost to Cedar Rapids in the first round.

PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

RHP STIVEN CRUZ: Signed by Milwaukee as an International Free Agent out of Nicaragua on July 2, 2019.

DELAYED START: Cruz began his pro career with the Brewers-1 affiliate in the Dominican Summer League in 2021. He was 3-3 with a 1.37 ERA and 73 strikeouts over 52-2/3 innings pitched in twelve games – eleven starts.

MUDDY WATERS: Cruz started the 2022 season with the Carolina Mudcats in the Carolina League. He went 3-5 with a 4.60 ERA in fifteen starts for Carolina. Cruz walked 18 and struck out 89 over 72-1/3 innings pitched.

ON TO WISCONSIN: Cruz joined the Timber Rattlers on August 16, 2022. He made four starts with the Rattlers and allowed one run on six hits with six walks and twenty strikeouts over nineteen innings pitched for a 1-1 record with a 0.47ERA. In 2023, Cruz spent the entire season with the Rattlers and was 7-6 with a 6.90 ERA in 24 games – 19 starts.

IT'S A MAJOR AWARD: Cruz beat Lansing at home on August 24, 2022. He allowed a hit with a walk and seven strikeouts over six scoreless innings in the game. Cruz was named the Midwest League Pitcher of the Week on August 29 for this game.

LAST APPEARANCE: Cruz pitched 3-1/3 innings of relief at Quad Cities on <u>August 11</u>. He allowed a run on three hits with two walks and three strikeouts for a no decision.

LAST START: Cruz had a no decision at Cedar Rapids on <u>July 19</u>. He allowed two hits over three scoreless innings with no walks.

VS. PEORIA (2024): Cruz has made two relief appearances with no decisions against the Chiefs this season. He has allowed three runs on three hits with two walks and three strikeouts over 2-2/3 innings.

PEORIA STARTING PITCHER:

LHP PETE HANSEN: The St. Louis Cardinals selected Hansen in the third round of the 2022 draft out of the University of Texas.

THE EYES OF TEXAS: Hansen went 22-4 with a 2.67 ERA and 218 strikeouts over 215-2/3 innings in his career with the Longhorns. He was 11-3 with 120 strikeouts over 107-2/3 innings in his final season at Texas

SHUTDOWN MODE: Hansen signed with St. Louis on July 23, 2022 and did not pitch professionally until the 2023 season.

GET IT STARTED: Hansen began his career with the Palm Beach Cardinals in the Florida State League in 2023. He went 11-3 with a 3.09 ERA and 126 strikeouts over 112-2/3 innings pitched over 23 starts last season.

MEMPHIS IN THE MEANTIME: Hansen made a relief appearance for the Memphis Redbirds, the Triple-A Affiliate of the Cardinals on <u>September 24, 2023</u>. He pitched a scoreless, hitless innings with no walks and no strikeouts for a no decision.

STACKING AWARDS: Hansen was the Florida State League Pitcher of the Week on August 13, 2023, a Florida State League Post-Season All-Star, and an MiLB.com St. Louis Cardinals Organizational All Star last year.

HOW DOES HE RATE? Hansen is rated as the #30 prospect in the St. Louis system by MLB Pipeline.

LAST START: Hansen lost to Cedar Rapids at home on <u>August 10</u>. He allowed five runs – four earned – on five hits with four walks and five strikeouts over 5-1/3 innings.

VS. WISCONSIN: Hansen is 0-1 in two starts – <u>April 7</u> and <u>April 27</u> – against the Rattlers this season. He has allowed eight runs on fifteen hits with four walks and nine strikeouts over ten innings.
