LAST ACTION: [The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers beat the Beloit Sky Carp 5-3 in ten innings at ABC Supply Stadium on Sunday.](#) Wisconsin trailed 2-0 until Matt Wood knocked in a run with a fielder's choice in the eighth inning. Eduarqui Fernández tied the game with an RBI single in the ninth. Eduardo Garcia gave Wisconsin a 3-2 lead with an RBI double in the tenth. Felix Valerio added a two-run single later in the inning. Bayden Root, who pitched a scoreless eighth and ninth inning, gave up the placed runner in the tenth and got one out before Chase Costello closed out the game for his fourth save of the season.

IT GOES TO ELEVEN: Garcia was 2-for-5 on Sunday to extend his hitting streak to eleven games. He has the longest current streak on the team.

LOOK OUT! Luke Adams was hit by pitches twice on Sunday. Adams has been hit by pitches 30 times this season. He leads Minor League Baseball in that category. Two other players have been hit 26 times and are tied for second place.

WHAT A SEASON...SO FAR: Wisconsin has the best Winning Percentage for full season teams in affiliated baseball through Monday. They are 62-33 (.653). The Omaha Storm Chasers of the International League are 64-36 (.640) for the second-best winning percentage.

WHAT A SEASON...SO FAR (Part II): Only one Timber Rattlers team since the franchise started in 1995 has finished a season with a winning percentage over .600. The 2001 Rattlers were 84-52 (.618).

MAKING A RUN: The Timber Rattlers have 195 stolen bases this season. Wisconsin needs to average 1.42 stolen bases per game over the final 36 games of this season to set a new club record.

ABOUT SOUTH BEND: The South Bend Cubs started as the South Bend White Sox when the Midwest League added them as an expansion team in 1988. They changed their name to the Silver Hawks for the 1994 season and became an affiliate of the Arizona Diamondbacks in 1997. South Bend became an affiliate of the Chicago Cubs in 2015. South Bend has won Midwest League titles in 1989, 1993, 2005, 2019, and 2022. Notable alumni for the South Bend franchise include Mike Cameron, Jose Valverde, Chris Capuano, Mark Reynolds, Justin Upton, Wade Miley, Chase Anderson, Keon Broxton, Gleyber Torres, Ian Happ, Carlos Gonzalez, and current Timber Rattlers manager Victor Estevez. Terry Francona was the manager of the South Bend White Sox in 1982. Nick Lovullo, the son of Arizona Diamondbacks manager Torey Lovullo, is in his first year as South Bend's manager.

ABOUT THE CUBS: The Chicago Cubs had several different Midwest League affiliates before settling in South Bend in 2015. They were affiliated with Quincy from 1965 through 1973 before leaving the Midwest League. The Cubs returned to the MWL with an affiliation with Quad Cities from 1979 through 1984, Peoria from 1985 through 1994 and again from 2005 through 2012, Rockford from 1995 through 1998, Lansing from 1999 through 2004, and Kane County in 2013 and 2014.

PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES: [MLB Pipeline](#) places four active Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Cooper Pratt (#4), Luis Lara (#8), Luke Adams (#15), and Patricio Aquino (#28). Jadhav Areinamo (#21) is on the Wisconsin IL. [MLB Pipeline](#) has six South Bend players on their list of Cubs prospects: Jefferson Rojas (#7), Drew Gray (#10), Pedro Ramirez (#12), Jaxon Wiggins (#19), Will Sanders (#25), and Brett Bateman (#27).

PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

RHP ALEXANDER CORNIELLE: Milwaukee signed Cornielle as an International Free Agent out of the Dominican Republic on June 15, 2019.

FAST DEBUT: Cornielle made his professional debut with one inning of relief against the Cubs #2 affiliate in the Dominican Summer League on August 2, 2019. He allowed one run on no hits with two walks in one inning. Cornielle made three appearances in the DSL in 2019 with no record and one run allowed over four innings.

HIT PLAY: Cornielle started the 2021 season with the Brewers Blue affiliate in the Arizona Complex League and was 4-2 in nine games – four starts – with a 4.64 ERA and 50 strikeouts over 33 innings pitched. He was called up to Carolina at the end of the season and was 0-1 in two starts with ten strikeouts in eight innings.

WEEKLY AWARDS: Cornielle was named the ACL's Pitcher of the Week on September 6, 2021. He also won the Midwest League Pitcher of the Week Award on September 11, 2023.

BACK IN 2022: Cornielle was 9-7 in 22 games – 19 starts – with a 3.19 ERA and 124 strikeouts over 101-2/3 innings pitched for the Carolina Mudcats this season before joining the Timber Rattlers on August 23. He was second in the Carolina League in strikeouts and third in the Carolina League in ERA before his promotion to Wisconsin. Cornielle was 1-0 in three starts with 21 strikeouts over 17-1/3 innings pitched.

LAST SEASON: Cornielle was 1-3 in twenty games – eighteen starts – for Wisconsin. He walked 34, struck out 92, and compiled a 4.55 ERA in 89 innings pitched for the Rattlers.

LAST START: Cornielle had a no decision at Beloit on [July 23](#). He allowed four hits, walked one, and struck out four over five scoreless innings.

VS. SOUTH BEND (2024): Cornielle is 1-1 in three starts – April 13, May 26, and June 30 – against the Cubs this season. He has allowed six runs on thirteen hits with five walks and fourteen strikeouts in 16-2/3 innings versus South Bend this season.

SOUTH BEND STARTING PITCHER:

RHP NICK DEAN: The Chicago Cubs selected Dean in the 19th round of the 2023 draft out of the University of Maryland.

TURTLE TIME: Dean pitched for Maryland from 2020 through 2023. He was 13-6 with a 4.44 ERA and 219 strikeouts over 231 innings in 43 starts during his collegiate career.

LAST YEAR: Dean went 3-2 with a 5.54 ERA in fifteen starts for the Terrapins. He walked 32 and struck out 77 over 74-2/3 innings pitched. Dean did not pitch professionally after signing with the Cubs.

STARTING OUT IN THE SOUTH: Dean began his pro career with the Myrtle Beach Pelicans in the Carolina League this season. He was 2-0 with a 2.33 ERA in seven games – three starts – for the Pelicans. Dean had walked nine and struck out 36 over 27 innings pitched before his promotion to South Bend on May 22, 2024

LAST START: Dean had a no decision against Peoria at home on [July 23](#). He allowed two runs on four hits with no walks and eight strikeouts over five innings.

VS. WISCONSIN: Dean made his South Bend debut in a start against Wisconsin on [May 23](#) at Four Winds Field and another start at Wisconsin on [June 27](#). Dean is 1-0 against the Rattlers and has allowed one run on five hits with two walks and seven strikeouts over nine innings.
