ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Peoria Chiefs beat the
Wisconsin Timber Rattlers 7-0 at Dozer Park. Three
Peoria pitchers held Wisconsin to two hits. Josh Kross
went 3-for-4 with a walk, a triple, a homer, and two RBI
while Zach Levenson added a home run for the Chiefs.
HITS: Luis Peña doubled with one out in the top of the
sixth inning for Wisconsin's first hit. Jesús Made had a
one-out single in the top of the ninth for the other hit.
UNEARNED: An error opened on a force play at
second base opened the door for the Chiefs to score
three unearned runs in the bottom of the second inning.
The error left the bases loaded with one out. Wisconsin
starting pitcher Sam Garcia recorded a strikeout for the
second out of the inning. However, a passed ball and a
two-run double by Brayden Jobert gave Peoria the lead.
OTHER: Wisconsin drew nine walks in the game last
night. Braden Davis, the Peoria starting pitcher walked

STREAKING: Peña has one hit in his first four games as a Rattler, including three extra-base hits.

KEEP RUNNING UP THAT HILL: Wisconsin missed on a chance to win consecutive games for the second time in the second half of the season. The only other two-game winning streak for the Rattlers in this half was when they swept a doubleheader from the Beloit Sky Carp at home on July 6 at home. The last time the Rattlers won two straight road games was on June 15 at Great Lakes and June 17 at West Michigan.

ABOUT PEORIA: The Peoria Chiefs were in the Three-I League from 1953-1958 before the team folded. They were a St. Louis Cardinals affiliate from 1953-1957 and a New York Yankees affiliate in 1958. The Chiefs re-entered organized baseball when the Danville franchise moved to Peoria after the 1982 season. They were named the Peoria Suns and were affiliated with the California Angels for 1983 and 1984 with a change to the Chiefs nickname for 1984 followed by an affiliation switch to the Chicago Cubs for the 1985 season. Peoria became the Cardinals Midwest League affiliate for the first time in 1995, switched back to the Cubs in 2005, and went back to the Cardinals in 2013. The Chiefs won a Midwest League title in 2002. They made the Midwest League Championship Series in 2018 but lost to Bowling Green. Notable former Chiefs include Greg Maddux, Mark Grace, Albert Pujols, Yadier Molina, Nolan Gorman, and Victor Scott II.

ABOUT THE CARDINALS: St. Louis had several different Midwest League affiliates before settling back in Peoria in 2013. They were in Cedar Rapids from 1965-1972 before leaving the league until returning to the league to affiliate with the Springfield, Illinois team from 1982 through 1993. St. Louis spent one year with the Madison Hatters before their first affiliation with Peoria from 1995 through 2004. The Cardinals left Peoria for Quad Cities from 2005 through 2012.

PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES: MLB Pipeline places six Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Jesús Made (#1), Luis Pena (#2), Bishop Letson (#6), Marco Dinges (#9), Robert Gasser (#12), and Manuel Rodriguez (#30). MLB Pipeline has seven Peoria players on their list of Top 30 Cardinals prospects: Jesus Baez (#6), Chen-Wei-Lin (#14), Nate Dohm (#15), Travis Honeyman (#23), Braden Davis (#25), Mason Molina (#26), and Darlin Saladin (#30).

■ PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

RHP RYAN BIRCHARD: The Milwaukee Brewers selected Birchard in the 5th round of the 2023 draft out of the Niagara County Community College.

PLAYER OF THE YEAR: Birchard was named the Western New York Athletic Conference Player of the Year in 2023. He was 8-0 in ten games – nine starts – with a 1.08 ERA and 95 strikeouts over fifty innings pitched. Birchard was also named a First Team All-NJCAA Division III All-American in 2023.

QUICK TRIP TO TRENTON: Birchard made four appearances – two starts – for Trenton in the MLB Draft League after the end of his college season. He allowed one run, walked one, and struck out sixteen over nine innings before signing with Milwaukee.

DELAYED START: Birchard did not pitch professionally in 2023. He made a start for the Carolina Mudcats on April 6, 2024 (4.0IP, H, R, 0ER, 2BB, 6K) but was placed on the IL after that game. He next pitched with the ACL Brewers on July 16 and July 22. Birchard rejoined Carolina for appearances on July 28 and August 3 before being sent to Wisconsin on August 13.

AS A RATTLER (2024): Birchard made five regular season starts for Wisconsin last season. He was 0-3 with an 8.71 ERA. He walked fourteen and struck out thirteen in 10-1/3 innings with the Timber Rattlers.

LAST APPEARANCE: Birchard worked two innings as a reliever against Lake County at home on <u>August 3</u>. He allowed two hits, walked three, and struck out four without allowing a run.

LAST START: Birchard had a no decision at Quad Cities on July 23. He allowed a run on three hits with three walks and six strikeouts over four innings.

VS. PEORIA: Birchard is 0-1 in two appearances – one start – against the Chiefs this season. He has allowed six runs on four hits and six walks with four strikeouts over 4-1/3 innings.

PEORIA STARTING PITCHER:

RHP FRANK ELISSALT: The St. Louis Cardinals acquired Elissalt in a trade with the New York Mets on July 30, 2025. The Cardinals sent Ryan Helsley to New York for Jesus Baez, Nate Dohm, and Elissalt.

ORIGIN STORY: The New York Mets selected Elissalt in the nineteenth round of the 2024 draft out of Nova Southeastern University.

FINDING A HOME IN A SUPERNOVA: Elissalt started his collegiate career with La Salle in the Atlantic 10 during the 2021 season and he was 6-4 in thirteen starts. He transferred to Florida Southwestern State for 2022 and was 4-3 with a 3.92 ERA before pitching for Mahoning Valley in the MLB Draft League that summer. Elissalt enrolled at Nova Southeastern and was 3-8 with 122 strikeouts in 118-1/3 innings pitched over two seasons there before he was drafted by the Mets.

SAINTLY: Elissalt made his pro debut as a St. Lucie Mets in the Florida State League with one relief appearance in 2024. He returned to St. Lucie this year and was 3-4 with a 3.02 ERA and 57 strikeouts in 50-2/3 innings over 18 games – seven starts – before a promotion to Brooklyn in the South Atlantic League where he was 1-1 in two relief appearances before the trade to the Cardinals system.

LAST APPEARANCE: Elissalt made his Peoria debut with a relief outing at Beloit on <u>August 3</u>. He pitched three scoreless innings, walked three, and struck out two in a no decision.

LAST START: Elissalt had a no decision at Bradenton on <u>July 13</u> in his final appearance with St. Lucie. He pitched four scoreless, hitless innings with a walk and four strikeouts.

VS. WISCONSIN: Elissalt has never pitched against the Timber Rattlers before this evening. Tonight is also the first time he will face an affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers.
