INDY BITS

RAIN DANCE: Yesterday's regularly scheduled game between the Indianapolis Indians and Iowa Cubs was canceled due to inclement weather. On Friday, game four was suspended in the top of the 10th inning due to inclement weather with the score tied, 3-3. That contest resumes today at 12:15 PM with today's regularly scheduled game to follow 45 minutes after the conclusion of the resumed game.

REGULARLY SCHEDULED PROGRAM: Following the conclusion of the suspended game, Indians right-hander Mike Burrows is set to make his second start of the season. On Tuesday, Burrows tossed 3.2 shutout innings against the I-Cubs, allowing three hits and no walks with four strikeouts. Burrows has made four starts against the Cubs in his career, going 0-1 with a 3.24 ERA (6er, 16.2ip), 19 hits, just one walk and 18 strikeouts. Opposite Burrows is Iowa right-hander Connor Noland. Noland makes his second start of the season after tossing 4.0 innings of one-run ball with six strikeouts on March 28 vs. Omaha. He made one career start opposite Indianapolis on July 27, 2024, in Iowa, allowing four earned runs across 5.2 innings.

HAVE YOU TRIED TURNING IT OFF AND ON AGAIN?: Right-hander Carson Fulmer shined in his Indians debut on Friday, tossing 5.0 shutout innings on five hits, no walks and six strikeouts. The Indians jumped ahead early with a three-run third inning. A chaotic play played two runs to open the scoring. With runners on the corners, Matt Gorski grounded an RBI single into right field and was then caught in a rundown after rounding first base. As Llover Peguero broke home, Cubs first baseman Jonathon Long threw the ball away, resulting in a 2-0 lead and Gorski on third base. Malcom Nuñez then doubled to right field to put the Indians up 3-0. Iowa knotted the game, 3-3, in the seventh inning, stringing together three hits and two walks to even the score. After completing nine innings, the game was delayed due to inclement weather and later suspended for resumption today.

IT'S HIGH NOON: With Thursday's game-winning fielders' choice in Game 1, Malcom Nuñez has secured the Indians past two walk-off wins, with the previous game-clincher on August, 30, 2024 vs. Louisville. It was the Indians first pinch-hit walk-off plate appearance since Christian Bethancourt's decisive RBI single in the 10th inning on June 30, 2021 vs. Iowa. With a victory in today's resumed game, it would mark the Indians first set of back-to-back walk-off wins since August 2 and the first game on August 3, 2022.

THURSDAY'S GAME 1: The Indianapolis Indians split Thursday's doubleheader against the Iowa Cubs, earning their first victory of the season in Game 1, 7-6, and dropping Game 2 by a score of 6-1. In the first game, the Indians jumped out to a 6-0 lead with three home runs in the first three innings. Nick Solak swatted the Indians first home run of the season in the second inning, poking the ball over the right field wall to opposite field. DJ Stewart and Matt Gorski hit back-to-back homers in the third inning, marking the first pair of Indians batters to do so since Matt Gorski and Seth Beer in the fifth inning on September 22, 2024 at St. Paul. Five of the Indians six hits in the opening game went for extra bases, with Nick Yorke adding a pair of doubles to the trio of long balls. In the seven-inning contest, the Cubs stormed back with a five-run sixth inning and tied the game in the seventh. After blanking the I-Cubs in the top of the eighth, pinch hitter Malcom Nuñez rocketed a grounder to third base to deliver a walk-off fielders' choice.

THURSDAY'S GAME 2: The Indians lost, 6-1, in seven innings in Game 2 of Thursday's doubleheader. Starting pitcher Braxton Ashcraft took his second loss in as many starts, tossing 5.0 innings of two-run ball and allowing a career-high tying eight hits (MR: 5/2/24 (1) with Altoona at Harrisburg). The rain-riddled contest was scoreless until the Cubs posted a two-run fifth inning. An RBI double by Nick Yorke in the bottom half of the frame cut the deficit in half before Iowa posted four unanswered runs to finish the night.

TWO YORKE CITY: Nick Yorke posted three doubles across Thursday's doubleheader, going 3-for-7 with one walk, one run and one RBI on the day. Through four games this season, Yorke is hitting .333 (5-for-15) with a .412 OBP. He has a hit in four consecutive games and has reached base safely two-plus times in three straight contests.

GONDOLA GORSKI: Matt Gorski launched his first home run of the season in Game 1 on Thursday, following DJ Stewart's three-run bomb for a set of back-to-back blasts in the third inning. Gorski has reached base safely in all four games this season, batting .273 (3-for-11) with one double, one homer, two RBI, three walks, one stolen base and a 1.065 OPS. He went 2-for-6 yesterday with one double, homer, RBI and run.

YOUNG BUCS: Six prospects ranked among the Pirates top 30 according to MLB Pipeline began the season in Triple-A, led by right-hander Bubba Chandler as the organization's No. 1 (MLB's No. 15) overall farmhand. It marks the second consecutive year that the Pirates top prospect will begin the season with the Indians, following right-hander and 2024 MLB Rookie of the Year Paul Skenes. Other prospects on the 2025 Opening Day roster include utilityman Nick Yorke (No. 5), Opening Day starter and right-hander Braxton Ashcraft (No. 6), right-hander Mike Burrows (No. 15), infielder Tsung-Che Cheng (No. 17) and outfielder Billy Cook (No. 18). Last season, the Indians featured six of the Pirates top 30 prospects (according to *Baseball America*).

ON THIS DATE IN 2014: Indy finished off a four-game sweep at Columbus to begin the season, just its second four-game sweep of the Clippers (also: May 31-June 3, 2013) since rejoining the International League in 1998. Right fielder Gregory Polanco went 3-for-5 with a home run, two RBI and two runs scored in the 8-3 triumph and batted .400 (6-for-15) in the series. The sweep sparked Indy to its second 5-0 start to a season in the Victory Field era, as well.

Mike Burrows: Right-hander Mike Burrows is set to make his second start of the season after tossing 3.2 shutout innings against the Iowa Cubs in Tuesday's series opener.

Against the Cubs: Burrows has made four starts against the Cubs in his career, going 0-1 with a 3.24 ERA (6er, 16.2ip), 19 hits, just one walk and 18 strikeouts.

September Callup: Following his 10-strikeout performance in the Indians 2024 season finale, Burrows was recalled by Pittsburgh for his major league debut on Sept. 28 at New York (AL). He earned the win out of the bullpen, allowing two runs (one earned) over 3.1 innings. He struck out Oswaldo Cabrera swinging as his second batter faced for his first MLB punchout.

Prospectus: Burrows is currently rated as Pittsburgh's No. 13 prospect by *Baseball America* and No. 15 by MLB Pipeline.

2024 Highlights

» Was named Indianapolis' May Player of the Month after hitting nine home runs in 23 games, good for a .720 slugging percentage and 1.050 OPS; His nine home runs in the month were the third-most by an Indians batter in a single month since 2005 and the most since Michael Ryan launched 10 in July 2007.
