SOMERSET PATRIOTS NOTES

- The Somerset Patriots split their first double header of the season, winning the first game by a final score of 5-0 and losing the second game by a final score of 3-0.
 - Secured first series win of 2023 (2-1), as well as first shutout win of the season, after winning nine games via shutouts during the 2022 regular season.
 - o Dating back to their last meeting in 2021, improved to 11-4 vs. Harrisburg all-time.
 - o Improved to 2-1 (.667) in 3 home games this season.
- RHP Will Warren (5.2 IP, 0 R, 2 H, 2 BB, 8 K) started Game 1 and earned the win in the 5-0 victory.
 - o Dating back to 2022, including the postseason, the performance marked Warren's third straight with 7+ strikeouts.
- RHP Clayton Beeter (4.1 IP. 1 R. 4 H. 1 BB. 7 K) started Game 2 and was tagged with the loss in the 3-0 shutout.
 - Beeter's seven strikeouts carried a streak of three straight games with 7+ strikeouts for Somerset's starting pitching (Fitts, Warren).
- **OF Everson Pereira** (2-for-3, HR, 1 RBI, 1 R, K) was the lone Patriot with two hits in Game 1, tacking on his first home run of the season in the fifth inning to cap Somerset's 5-0 lead.
- **1B T.J. Rumfield** (1-for-3, 2 RBI) collected his first Double-A hit with a third inning two-run single that extended Somerset's lead to 4-0
- **OF Brandon Lockridge** (combined 3-for-5, RBI, 2 SB) was responsible for two of Somerset's three hits in Game 2 (2-for-3) and was the only Patriot to collect hits in both ends of the double header.
 - o Lockridge stole two bases in Game 1, after only stealing 2+ bases in 3/108 games in 2022.
