LAST ACTION: The Beloit Sky Carp beat the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers 10-9 at Neuroscience Group Field at Fox Cities Stadium on Friday. Dalvy Rosario had six RBI for the Sky Carp. Wisconsin trailed 9-2 before rallying for six runs in the bottom of the sixth inning to get to within a run. The teams traded runs in the eighth inning and Wisconsin's rally fell just short. Beloit ended a six-game losing streak with the win. Wisconsin's losing streak has reached five games. DOUBLING UP: Wisconsin had six doubles, including

four doubles in the bottom of the sixth inning, on Friday. The Rattlers matched their single-game high for doubles this season. Wisconsin also had six doubles at Beloit on June 11. The last three times Wisconsin has had six doubles in a game, they have had them against Beloit. The Rattlers also had six doubles at Beloit on July 4, 2021.

STREAKS SNAPPED: The Rattlers had their errorless streak end at 31 innings when Davis Bradshaw reached on an error in the third inning on Friday. Wisconsin committed three errors in the game and two of those errors led to three unearned runs. The Timber Rattlers also saw their five-game home winning streak end with last night's loss.

STOP THIEVES! Beloit stole five bases on Friday. They are 22-for-22 in stolen bases attempts over twelve games against the Timber Rattlers this season.

ON THE COMEBACK TRAIL: Wisconsin trailed 9-2 with one out in the sixth inning when Ethan Murray had a two-run double, and Ashton McGee followed with an RBI double. Beloit got the second out of the inning. Then, Jose Acosta had an RBI single before Darrien Miller and Joe Gray Jr. had back-to-back RBI doubles. MULTI-BALL: Gray, Murray, Tristan Peters, and Wes Clarke each had two hits. McGee had a three-hit game.

CLOSE SHAVES: Friday was the 29th Timber Rattlers game of the 2022 season to be decided by one run. Wisconsin is tied with Quad Cities for the most one-run games in the Midwest League this season.

ABOUT BELOIT: The Beloit Sky Carp are in their first season as the Sky Carp and their second season as an affiliate of the Miami Marlins. Beloit started as the Beloit Brewers in 1982 as the Midwest League affiliate of Milwaukee. They changed their name to the Beloit Snappers for the 1995 season. The Snappers affiliation with Milwaukee ended after the 2004 season. They were affiliated with the Minnesota Twins (2005-2012) and the Oakland Athletics (2013-2019) over their final seasons in the Midwest League. The Snappers said "Goodbye" to Pohlman Field on July 11, 2021 and moved into Al Supply Stadium on August 3. Jorge Hernandez is in his first season as the manager of the Sky Carp.

ABOUT THE MARLINS: The Florida/Miami Marlins have a history in the Midwest League. The Marlins' first Low-A affiliate was the Kane County Cougars from 1993 through 2002. Josh Beckett, Adrian Gonzalez, Dontrelle Willis, Miguel Cabrera, and former Timber Rattlers manager Matt Erickson all played for the Cougars in that timespan The Marlins returned to the Midwest League in in 2019 to affiliate with the Clinton LumberKings. The Marlins landed in Beloit after MLB reset the affiliations for 2021.

THE SEASON SO FAR: Beloit started this season with seven straight losses but finished the first half with a 31-34. The Sky Carp were 8-7 to start the second half. Then, they were swept in a six-game series at home by Cedar Rapids before starting this series with Wisconsin.

PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES: MLB Pipeline puts five active Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Joe Gray Jr. (#13), Antoine Kelly (#14), Russell Smith (#16), Zavier Warren (#17), and Taylor Floyd (#23). T Black (#7) and Carlos Rodríguez (#21) are on the Wisconsin injured list. MLB Pipeline has seven current Sky Carp on their Top 30 list of Miami Marlins prospects: Jose Salas (#7), Dax Fulton (#8), Victor Mesa Jr. (#13), Nasim Nunez (#17), Evan Fitterer (#18), Osiris Johnson (#22), and MD Johnson (#28). Cody Morissette (#15) is on the Beloit Injured List.

PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER GAME ONE:

LHP ANTOINE KELLY: Selected by the Brewers in the second round of the 2019 draft out of Wabash Valley College in Mt. Carmel, Illinois. He is rated as the #14 prospect in the Brewers system by MLB Pipeline. *Baseball America* places Kelly at #10 for their in-season update of Milwaukee prospects.

WARRIORS...COME OUT TO PLAY: Kelly was 9-0 with 112 strikeouts in thirteen starts for the Warriors prior to the draft. He allowed 21 hits, 19 earned runs, and 31 walks over 52-2/3 innings pitched at Wabash Valley College

SAYING NO TO SAN DIEGO: The San Diego Padres selected Kelly in the thirteenth round of the 2018 draft after his senior season at Maine East High School in Park Ridge, Illinois. Kelly chose junior college over signing with the Padres.

THE BOYHOOD DREAM COMES TRUE: Kelly has been a Milwaukee Brewers fan since he was young.

WHAT'S BREWING? Kelly made his pro debut in the AZL with the Brewers Blue and made one start for the Rattlers in 2019. He spent 2020 with the Brewers Alternate Training Site. He underwent surgery for Thoracic Outlet Syndrome on November 5, 2020 and has worked his way back to Wisconsin after a relief appearance in Arizona and seven starts with Carolina before joining the Rattlers near the end of the 2021 season.

INTO THE FUTURE: Kelly participated in the 2022 SiriusXM Futures Game in Los Angeles on July 17. He retired both batters he faced in the game

LAST START: Kelly had a <u>no decision at West Michigan on July 12</u>. He pitched three hitless, scoreless innings with a walk and two strikeouts.

VS. BELOIT (2022): Kelly is 0-1 in three starts against the Sky Carp this season. He had no decisions at Beloit on April 12 and April 17 with a loss at Beloit on June 8. Kelly has allowed five runs on nine hits with eight walks and seventeen strikeouts over 14-2/3 innings against the Sky Carp this season.

WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER GAME TWO:

RHP JUSTIN JARVIS: Selected by Milwaukee in the 5th round of the 2018 draft out of Lake Norman High School in Mooresville, North Carolina.

THE SENIOR SEASON: In his final season of high school, Jarvis was 8-2 with a 1.60ERA, and 95 strikeouts. Former Major Leaguer Ty Wigginton was his head coach.

A PERFECT DAY: Jarvis pitched a perfect game with 18 strikeouts in a game against East Rowan High School early in his senior season of high school.

NOT ON CAMPUS: Jarvis signed with the Brewers over a commitment to UNC-Wilmington.

YEAR ONE: Jarvis was 1-2 with a 6.63ERA in ten games – three starts – for Milwaukee's Arizona League affiliate after signing with Milwaukee. He walked four and struck out 18 over 19 innings pitched in the Arizona League.

2019: Jarvis was 4-1 with a 3.50 ERA in 18 games – eleven starts – for the Timber Rattlers in 2019. He had 52 strikeouts over 74-2/3 innings.

2021: Jarvis was 1-7 with a 5.40 ERA in seventeen starts for the Timber Rattlers in 2021. He had 62 strikeouts over 63-1/3 innings.

LAST START: Jarvis <u>lost at West Michigan on July 16</u>. He allowed three runs on three hits with four walks and five strikeouts over seven innings. The Whitecaps scored all their runs in the first inning.

VS. BELOIT (2022): Jarvis is 1-0 in two starts against the Sky Carp at Beloit this season. He had a no decision in the second game of a doubleheader on April 14 and won on June 11. Jarvis has allowed seven runs – five earned – on nine hits with two walks and fourteen strikeouts over 11-1/3 innings against Beloit this season.

LHP DAX FULTON: The Marlins selected Fulton in the $2^{\rm nd}$ round of the 2020 draft out of Mustang High School in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma.

SOONER GO PRO: Fulton signed with the Marlins over a commitment to the University of Oklahoma. MLB Pipeline rates Fulton as the #9 prospect in the Marlins organization.

KING OF PLANETS: Fulton was 2-4 in fifteen games – fourteen starts – with the Jupiter Hammerheads, the Low-A Southeast affiliate of the Marlins before his promotion to Beloit. Fulton had 66 strikeouts and 30 walks in 58-2/3 innings with a 4.30 ERA with Jupiter.

WELCOME TO WISCONSIN: Fulton made his Beloit debut on August 18, 2021 with <u>a loss in a start against Peoria at home</u>. He allowed four runs – three earned – on six hits with a walk and a strikeout over five innings.

LAST START: Fulton had a <u>no decision against Cedar Rapids at home on July 15</u>. He allowed two runs – one earned – on three hits with two walks and five strikeouts over 5-1/3 innings.

VS. WISCONSIN (2022): Fulton is 0-2 in two starts against the Timber Rattlers at Beloit this season. He has lost to the Rattlers on April 15 and on June 9. Fulton has allowed four runs on six hits with four walks and nine strikeouts over 9-1/3 innings in his starts against Wisconsin this season.

BELOIT SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER GAME TWO:

LHP PATRICK MONTEVERDE: The Marlins selected Monteverde in the 8^{th} round of the 2021 draft out of Texas Tech.

RED RAIDER: Monteverde was 7-4 with a 3.75 ERA in sixteen starts at Texas Tech. He walked 21 and struck out 101 in 86-1/3 innings pitched.

BEFORE TEXAS: Monteverde pitched for Virginia Wesleyan University in 2017 as went 7-2 with a 1.96 ERA to be named Rookie of the Year in the Old Dominion Athletic Conference. He transferred to Seton Hill University in Greensburg, PA for 2018 and suffered a UCL injury in 2019. Transferred to Texas Tech for 2021.

TO THE PROS: Monteverde went to the Marlins affiliate in the Florida Complex League after signing with Miami. He was 2-for-2 in save opportunities in six relief appearances last season. Monteverde also made one start. He had a 3.07 ERA, walked four, and struck out sixteen over 14-2/3 innings pitched as a pro last season.

DID YOU KNOW: Monteverde faced Timber Rattlers pitcher Russell Smith in a Big XII game between <u>Texas Tech and TCU on May 28, 2021.</u> TCU won the game 7-2. Smith allowed two runs on three hits and struck out ten for the win. Monteverde allowed four runs – two earned – on six hits with six strikeouts over six innings to take the loss.

LAST START: Monteverde <u>lost to Cedar Rapids at home on July 14</u>. He allowed two runs – one earned – on three hits with two walks and six strikeouts over six innings.

VS. WISCONSIN (2022): Monteverde in 1-0 in two starts against the Timber Rattlers this season. He had a no decision against the Timber Rattlers in game one of a doubleheader on April 14 at home and a win on June 8 at home. Monteverde has allowed four hits with six walks and twelve strikeouts over 10-2/3 innings without allowing a run in his two starts against Wisconsin this season.
