ABOUT LAST NIGHT: [The Peoria Chiefs beat the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers 3-2 in ten innings at Dozer Park.](#) Wisconsin was held to two hits in the game but had a 2-1 lead after the top of the tenth. However, Peoria scored twice with two outs in the bottom of the tenth for the walkoff win. Wisconsin is 0-7 at Peoria this season. The Chiefs clinched the season series between the teams with the win.

A MAN OF QUALITY: Wisconsin starting pitcher Tyler Woessner allowed one run over seven innings for his seventh quality start of the season. Woessner walked none and struck out two as he set a new single-game high as a professional for innings pitched.

BREAKING THE SILENCE: Peoria starting pitcher Trent Baker pitched six no-hit innings. Reliever Joseph King carried the no-hitter into the eighth. Ernesto Martinez Jr broke up the no-hitter and the shutout with a one-out, solo homer to tie the game 1-1.

INTO THE LEAD: Ben Metzinger gave Wisconsin a 2-1 lead in the top of the tenth with an RBI double. The Rattlers had runners at second and third with one out but could not add to the lead.

MISSED IT BY THAT MUCH: Peoria had two outs in the bottom of the tenth with the placed runner still at second base. Then, Alex Iadisernia tied the game with a single to left. Iadisernia took second on the throw to the plate and third on a wild pitch. A walk, a stolen base, and an intentional walk loaded the bases. Jimmy Crooks was hit by a pitch to force in the winning run.

END OF THE LINE: Robert Moore had his 27-game on-base streak end last night. He was 0-for-4 in the game. Moore's streak is the tied with Christian Cairo of Lake County for the second-longest streak in the League this season. Dalton Rushing of Great Lakes had a 29-game on-base streak earlier this season.

ANOTHER STREAK IS OVER: Wisconsin had won the opening game of their last seven series. The loss last night ended the streak that started at Cedar Rapids on May 23.

ABOUT PEORIA: The Peoria Chiefs were in the Three-I League from 1953-1958 before the team folded. They were a St. Louis Cardinals affiliate from 1953-1957 and a New York Yankees affiliate in 1958. The Chiefs re-entered organized baseball when the Danville franchise moved to Peoria after the 1982 season. They were named the Peoria Suns and were affiliated with the California Angels for 1983 and 1984 with a change to the Chiefs nickname for 1984 followed by an affiliation switch to the Chicago Cubs for the 1985 season. Peoria became the Cardinals Midwest League affiliate for the first time in 1995, switched back to the Cubs in 2005, and went back to the Cardinals in 2013. The Chiefs won a Midwest League title in 2002. They made the Midwest League Championship Series in 2018 but lost to Bowling Green. Patrick Anderson is in his second year as Peoria's manager. Notable former Chiefs include Greg Maddux, Mark Grace, Albert Pujols, and Yadier Molina.

ABOUT THE CARDINALS: St. Louis had several different Midwest League affiliates before settling back in Peoria in 2013. They were in Cedar Rapids from 1965-1972 before leaving the league until returning to the league to affiliate with the Springfield, Illinois team from 1982 through 1993. St. Louis spent one year with the Madison Hatters before their first affiliation with Peoria from 1995 through 2004. The Cardinals left Peoria for Quad Cities from 2005 through 2012.

PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES: [MLB Pipeline](#) places five active Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Jacob Misiorowski (#4), Robert Moore (#8), Hendry Mendez (#13), Eduardo Garcia (#19), and Matthew Wood (#24). Eric Brown Jr (#6) and Joseph Hernandez (#25) are currently on Wisconsin's IL. [MLB Pipeline](#) has seven active Peoria players on their list of Top 30 Cardinals prospects: Jimmy Crooks (#13), Inohan Paniagua (#15), Max Rajcic (#16), Ian Bedell (#22), Dionys Rodriguez (#24), Zane Mills (#28), and Edwin Nunez (#29). Cooper Hjerpe (#4) and Austin Love (#17) are on Peoria's IL.

WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP JACOB MISIOROWSKI: Selected by Milwaukee in the second round of the 2022 draft out of Crowder (MO) Junior College.

THE UNDEFEATED: Misiorowski made fifteen starts in his only season at Crowder. He was 10-0 with a 2.72 ERA and 136 strikeouts over 76 innings as he helped the Roughriders to the NJCAA College World Series in Grand Junction, Colorado.

THAT SCHOOL SOUNDS FAMILIAR: Former Timber Rattler Aaron Ashby was drafted in the fourth round of the 2018 draft out of Crowder.

DID YOU KNOW? Misiorowski and current teammate Tyler Woessner were the opposing starting pitchers on [May 29, 2022](#) in a College World Series Game. Misiorowski allowed three runs on three hits with two walks and ten strikeouts over six innings for a no decision. Crowder won the game 5-4 in ten innings over Woessner's Central Arizona College in Misiorowski's final junior college appearance.

GOING TO CAROLINA: Misiorowski made two brief starts for Carolina in 2022 after signing with Milwaukee. He joined the Mudcats to start this season and was 1-1 with a 3.04 ERA in nine starts. Misiorowski walked twelve and struck out 46 in 26-2/3 innings pitched for the Mudcats before his promotion to Wisconsin on June 6.

LAST APPEARANCE: Misiorowski pitched one scoreless inning in the 2023 SiriusXM MLB Futures All-Star Game on [July 8](#) in Seattle. He allowed a hit and struck out three.

LAST START: Misiorowski had a no decision at Quad Cities on [July 2](#). He allowed two runs on two hits with two walks and two hit batsmen over four innings. Misiorowski struck out four in the game.

VS. PEORIA: Misiorowski has never faced the Chiefs before tonight. This evening is his first appearance against an affiliate of the St. Louis Cardinals.

PEORIA SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP ZANE MILLS: The St. Louis Cardinals drafted Mills out of Washington State University with their fourth-round selection in the 2021 draft.

LET'S GO COUGARS: Mills went 5-5 with a 4.15 ERA and 83 strikeouts in 80-1/3 innings pitched in thirteen starts in his final season at Washington State. He was named Pac-12 Pitcher of the Week twice in 2021.

IT'S COMPLEX: Mills made seven relief appearances for the Florida Complex League affiliate of the Cardinals after signing his professional contract. Mills allowed a run on four hits with no walks, two hit batsmen, and nine strikeouts over 7-2/3 innings pitched.

PALM READER: Mills started 2022 with the Palm Beach Cardinals in the Florida State League. He was 1-2 with a 3.48 ERA in seven starts with seven walks and 35 strikeouts over 41-1/3 innings before his promotion to Peoria on May 23. Mills was 4-6 with a 4.03 ERA in nineteen starts for the Chiefs after his promotion.

LAST START: Mills had a no decision at South Bend on [July 7](#). He allowed a run on four hits with a walk and four strikeouts in 3-2/3 innings.

VS. WISCONSIN: Mills was 0-2 in three starts – [May 31](#), [June 5](#), and [September 3](#) – against the Timber Rattlers last season. In 2023, Mills is 1-0 in three games – two starts – against Wisconsin. He had a no decision at Wisconsin on [April 12](#) as a starter, a win in Peoria on [May 5](#) as a starter, and a no decision as a reliever at Wisconsin on [June 4](#). Mills has allowed eleven runs on nineteen hits with two walks and nine strikeouts over 11-2/3 innings against the Timber Rattlers this season.
