**LAST ACTION:** The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers split a doubleheader on Sunday with the Quad Cities River Bandits at Modern Woodmen Park. The Rattlers won game one 5-3. The Bandits won game two 7-6. Wisconsin won four of the six games played in the series

**GAME ONE RECAP:** The Wisconsin offense rallied from an early 2-0 deficit with three runs in the top of the third. The Rattlers added runs in the fourth and fifth to take a 5-3 lead. Tayden Hall and David Garcia both hit solo homers in the game for Wisconsin. Garcia's home run was his first since August 18, 2023.

**GAME TWO RECAP:** The Rattlers had a 6-3 lead with two outs and none on in the bottom of the fifth inning only to see the River Bandits score twice in the frame to cut the lead to one run. In the bottom of the seventh, two straight singles and a wild pitch allowed Quad Cities to tie the game. Ramon Ramirez drove in the winning run with an RBI single. Wisconsin pitchers were charged with four wild pitches in the game with three of those allowing a run to score.

**BUSY AFTERNOON:** Luis Peña was 2-for-4 with two runs scored and a stolen base in game one of Sunday's twinbill. He was not in the starting lineup for game two but entered as a pinch runner in the top of the second. Peña was 3-for-3 with a double, a triple, and three RBI after coming into the nightcap. Peña is on a five-game hitting streak (10-for-19, .526).

**STREAKING:** Eric Bitonti was 1-for-3 with a double, a walk, and an RBI in game one. He was 0-for-1 with three walks in game two. Bitonti has extended his on-base streak to eight games and his 5-for-24, nine walks, and a .424 OBP.

**SAVINGS PLAN:** Yorman Galindez earned the save in game one for the Rattlers for his first professional save. Galindez pitched two innings and only allowed a two-out, solo home run to Trevor Werner in the bottom of the seventh to close out the game.

**ABOUT PEORIA:** The Peoria Chiefs were in the Three-I League from 1953-1958 before the team folded. They were a St. Louis Cardinals affiliate from 1953-1957 and a New York Yankees affiliate in 1958. The Chiefs re-entered organized baseball when the Danville franchise moved to Peoria after the 1982 season. They were named the Peoria Suns and were affiliated with the California Angels for 1983 and 1984 with a change to the Chiefs nickname for 1984 followed by an affiliation switch to the Chicago Cubs for the 1985 season. Peoria became the Cardinals Midwest League affiliate for the first time in 1995, switched back to the Cubs in 2005, and went back to the Cardinals in 2013. The Chiefs won a Midwest League title in 2002. They made the Midwest League Championship Series in 2018 but lost to Bowling Green. Notable former Chiefs include Greg Maddux, Mark Grace, Albert Pujols, Yadier Molina, Nolan Gorman, and Victor Scott II.

**ABOUT THE CARDINALS:** St. Louis had several different Midwest League affiliates before settling back in Peoria in 2013. They were in Cedar Rapids from 1965-1972 before leaving the league until returning to the league to affiliate with the Springfield, Illinois team from 1982 through 1993. St. Louis spent one year with the Madison Hatters before their first affiliation with Peoria from 1995 through 2004. The Cardinals left Peoria for Quad Cities from 2005 through 2012.

## WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER GAME ONE:

**RHP JASON WOODWARD:** The Milwaukee Brewers selected Woodward in the fourth round of the 2023 draft out of Florida Gulf Coast University.

**FROM THE COAST:** Woodward pitched three seasons at FGCU. He was 11-6 with a 3.68 ERA and 139 strikeouts over 127-1/3 innings in 34 games – twenty starts. His junior season ended after three starts due to an injury that required Tommy John Surgery before the draft.

**THAT SCHOOL SEEMS FAMILIAR:** Former Timber Rattlers who played at Florida Gulf Coast University are Jacob Barnes and Jordan Desguin.

**STARTING AND STOPPING:** Woodward made his professional debut in a start against the ACL Dodgers on June 27, 2024. He made four starts in the ACL before a promotion to Carolina in August where he made three more starts for the Mudcats before an injury that required a second Tommy John Surgery and missing the entire 2025 season.

**LAST START:** Woodward had a no decision at Quad Cities on [April 8](#) in his Midwest League debut. He allowed two hits, walked none, and struck out four over 2-2/3 scoreless innings.

**VS. PEORIA:** Woodward has never faced the Chiefs prior to this afternoon. Today will also be the first time he will face an affiliate of the St. Louis Cardinals.

## WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER GAME TWO:

**RHP TRAVIS SMITH:** The Milwaukee Brewers selected Smith in the fifteenth round of the 2024 draft out of the University of Kentucky.

**WILDCAT:** Smith pitched two seasons at Kentucky and was 7-7 with a 5.44 ERA and 76 strikeouts over 86 innings in 26 games – nineteen starts.

**CAROLINA ON MY MIND:** Smith made his pro debut with the Carolina Mudcats in the Carolina League in 2025. He was 4-4 with a 3.20 ERA in nineteen starts. Smith walked twenty and struck out 57 over 76 innings with the Mudcats before his promotion to Wisconsin.

**FINISHING UP THE SEASON:** Smith made six starts at the end of 2025 with Wisconsin. He was 1-2 with a 4.10 ERA.

**LAST APPEARANCE:** Smith earned the win as the reliever at Quad Cities on [April 8](#) for his 2026 debut. He gave up a run on four hits with a walk and four strikeouts over five innings.

**LAST START:** Smith had a no decision at South Bend on [September 5, 2025](#). He allowed two runs on four hits with a walk and five strikeouts over 4-1/3 innings.

**VS. PEORIA:** Smith made his Timber Rattlers debut at Peoria on [August 5, 2025](#). He allowed two runs on three hits with two walks and three strikeouts over four innings for a no decision as the starter in that game.

## PEORIA STARTING PITCHER GAME ONE:

**RHP NOLAN SPARKS:** The St. Louis Cardinals selected Sparks in the thirteenth round of the 2024 draft out of the University of Rochester (NY).

**THE YELLOWJACKET:** Sparks was 19-5 in four seasons at Rochester. He made 43 appearances – 38 starts – as he compiled a career ERA of 3.06 and struck out 248 in 209 innings pitched.

**WELL-TRAVELED:** Sparks pitched for four teams in four different summer baseball leagues. Spartanburg (Coastal Plain League – 2021), Batavia (Perfect Game Collegiate League – 2022), Vermont (New England Collegiate League – 2023), and Bourne (Cape Cod League – 2022 & 2024).

**ON THE BEACH:** Sparks began his professional career with the Palm Beach Cardinals of the Florida State League in 2024 with ten relief appearances and a 3-0 record. He returned to Palm Beach last season and was 4-6 in eighteen games – twelve starts. In his 28 games with the Cardinals, Sparks had a career ERA of 4.41 and 96 strikeouts in 87-2/3 innings.

**LAST START:** Sparks lost to South Bend at home on [April 8](#). He allowed three runs – two earned on six hits with no walks and seven strikeouts over 3-1/3 innings.

**VS. WISCONSIN:** Sparks has never pitched against Wisconsin prior to this afternoon. Today is also the first time he is facing an affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers.

## PEORIA STARTING PITCHER GAME TWO:

**RHP TANNER FRANKLIN:** The St. Louis Cardinals selected Franklin in Competitive Balance Round B with the 72<sup>nd</sup> pick of the 2025 draft out of Tennessee.

**I VOLUNTEER:** Franklin pitched two seasons (2023-2024) at Kennesaw State University before transferring to Tennessee for his final season of college baseball. He was 1-2 in 27 games – one start – with a pair of saves and a 5.12 ERA at Tennessee.

**SUMMER BALL:** Franklin pitched for Kingsport in the Appalachian League in 2023 and Chatham in the Cape Cod League in 2024.

**MADE THE LISTS:** Baseball America rated Franklin as the #7 prospect in the Cardinals system in their pre-season rankings. MLB Pipeline placed him at #11.

**DIVING IN:** Franklin signed with the Cardinals after the draft and began his professional career with the Palm Beach Cardinals of the Florida State League in 2025 by making a two-inning, scoreless start on August 23. Then, he moved to the Midwest League and made a pair of brief starts for the Peoria Chiefs before the end of the season.

**LAST START:** Franklin had a no decision against South Bend at home on [April 9](#). He pitched three scoreless innings, allowed two hits, walked one, and struck out seven.

**VS. WISCONSIN:** Franklin has never pitched against Wisconsin prior to this afternoon. Today is also the first time he is facing an affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers.
