**LAST ACTION:** [The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers beat the Peoria Chiefs 15-8 at Dozer Park on Sunday.](#) Eric Bitonti was on base six times as he went 5-for-5 with a walk, two doubles, and a homer. Andrew Fischer was 4-for-6 with a triple, two homers, four runs, and five RBI. The Timber Rattlers scored five runs in the first inning and never looked back. Wisconsin had nineteen hits in the game for the most hits in a game since the team moved to the High-A classification in the 2021 season. The fifteen runs are the most scored by the Rattlers this season.

**IT'S A MAJOR AWARD:** Fischer, who was a double shy of the cycle on Sunday, was named the Midwest League Players of the Week on Monday. He had three homers, seven RBI, eight runs, and an OPS of 1.397 in five games during the series. Fischer and Braylon Payne have each won Midwest League Player of the Week awards this season for Wisconsin.

**EVERYTHING IS 5 BY 5:** Bitonti became the first Timber Rattler player to have five hits in a game since Sal Frelick had five hits against Quad Cities on April 20, 2022. Bitonti was a triple shy of the cycle on Sunday.

**THAT'S OFFENSIVE, TOO:** Blayberg Diaz drove in three runs, Luiyin Alastre added two hits, and Luis Castillo added two hits for the Timber Rattlers on Sunday. Diaz made the score 5-0 with a two-out, bases loaded double in the top of the first inning.

**ROAD WARRIORS:** The win on Sunday gave the Timber Rattlers a 4-2 series victory over the Chiefs. Wisconsin has won all three of their series away from home this season. The Timber Rattlers are 13-5 on the road this season. They are tied with the Dayton Dragons (13-8) for the most away wins in the Midwest League this season.

**A QUICK CHECK:** Wisconsin is in first place in the West Division. They are two games in front of second place Cedar Rapids and 2-1/2 games ahead of South Bend and Quad Cities.

**ABOUT SOUTH BEND:** The South Bend Cubs started as the South Bend White Sox when the Midwest League added them as an expansion team in 1988. They changed their name to the Silver Hawks for the 1994 season and became an affiliate of the Arizona Diamondbacks in 1997. South Bend became an affiliate of the Chicago Cubs in 2015. South Bend has won Midwest League titles in 1989, 1993, 2005, 2019, and 2022. Notable alumni for the South Bend franchise include Mike Cameron, Jose Valverde, Chris Capuano, Mark Reynolds, Justin Upton, Wade Miley, Chase Anderson, Keon Broxton, Gleyber Torres, Ian Happ, Carlos Gonzalez, Pete Crow-Armstrong, and current Timber Rattlers manager Victor Estevez. Terry Francona was the manager of the South Bend White Sox in 1992. Nick Lovullo, the son of Arizona Diamondbacks manager Torey Lovullo, is in his second year as South Bend's manager.

**ABOUT THE CUBS:** The Chicago Cubs had several different Midwest League affiliates before settling in South Bend in 2015. They were affiliated with Quincy from 1965 through 1973 before leaving the Midwest League. The Cubs returned to the MWL for an affiliation with Quad Cities from 1979 through 1984, Peoria from 1985 through 1994 and again from 2005 through 2012, Rockford from 1995 through 1998, Lansing from 1999 through 2004, and Kane County in 2013 and 2014.

# PITCHING MATCHUP

## WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

**LHP WANDE TORRES:** The Milwaukee Brewers signed Torres as an International Free Agent on June 3, 2022.

**ALL-STAR SEASON:** Torres made his professional debut with Milwaukee's #1 affiliate in the Dominican Summer League. He was 1-4 with a 3.79 ERA and struck out 45 over 40-1/3 innings in eleven starts. Torres was a midseason All-Star and retired the only batter he faced in the DSL All-Star Game that year.

**STARTING OVER:** Torres missed the entire 2023 season with an injury. He returned to the mound in 2024 and was 1-0 with 1.72 ERA in eight games – seven starts in the DSL. In his second stint in the DSL, Torres walked six and struck out 33 in 15-2/3 innings.

**CAROLINA:** Torres went 1-10 with the Carolina Mudcats last season. He had 85 strikeouts and an ERA of 4.81 in 86 innings. Torres tied for the Carolina League lead in starts with 23.

**LAST START:** Torres won at Peoria on [May 6](#) when he went 5-2/3 innings, allowed five runs on seven hits, walked two and struck out five. He set a single-game high as a professional for innings in that game at Dozer Park.

**VS. SOUTH BEND:** Torres has never pitched against the South Bend Cubs prior to this evening. In 2025, Torres made two brief starts – [April 9](#) and [April 29](#) – against the Myrtle Beach Pelicans, the Carolina League affiliate of the Chicago Cubs. In those games, he had no decision, walked two, struck out five, and allowed three runs – two earned – on five hits over five innings.

## SOUTH BEND STARTING PITCHER:

**RHP KOEN MORENO:** The Chicago Cubs selected Moreno in the fifth round of the 2020 draft out of Panther Creek High School in Cary, North Carolina.

**THE WAITING IS THE HARDEST PART:** Moreno did not pitch professionally in 2021 and didn't start his pro career until 2022 with the Arizona Complex League Cubs. He joined Myrtle Beach in the Carolina League in July, 2022 to finish the season with an 0-2 record with a 9.96 ERA in twelve games – ten starts. Moreno returned to Myrtle Beach for the entire 2023 season and was 7-2 with a 2.90 ERA in 26 games – six starts.

**SERVING TIME IN SOUTH BEND:** Moreno was on the opening day roster of the South Bend Cubs in 2024. He was 2-3 with a 6.17 ERA in twelve relief appearances before he was placed on their Injured List on June 4, 2024. He did not pitch again until August 16, 2025 and he finished that season 1-0 with a 2.25 ERA in four games – one start – with South Bend.

**LAST START:** Moreno had a no decision against Lansing on [May 6](#). He allowed two hits, walked two, and struck out five over four scoreless innings.

**VS. WISCONSIN:** Moreno has made three appearances – one start – without a decision against the Timber Rattlers in his career. He was a reliever on [April 12, 2024](#) and [May 25, 2024](#) with one hit, three walks and two strikeouts over six scoreless innings. Moreno made a start on [September 6, 2025](#) and allowed a run on three hits with three walks and four strikeouts in three innings. All three of his appearances against the Rattlers have been at Four Winds Field.
