**WEDNESDAY AFTERNOON:** The Great Lakes Loons beat the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers 7-3 at Neuroscience Group Field. Jake Gelof hit a pair of two-run home runs for the Loons. Great Lakes was 6-for-6 in stolen bases on Wednesday with Kendall George, the Midwest League leader, stealing three bases to run his season total to 72.

**DOWN EARLY:** Great Lakes scored four runs in the first inning on an RBI single by Eduardo Quintero, an RBI double by Logan Wagner, and Gelof's first two-run home run.

**ON THE COMEBACK TRAIL:** Marco Dinges hit a two-run home run in the bottom of the first inning for the Rattlers. Jesús Made tripled home a run in the bottom of the second to get Wisconsin to within a run.

**LIGHTNING STRIKES AGAIN:** Gelof added his second two-run home run in the top of the third.

**A DRY SPELL:** The Rattlers had runners at second and third with two outs in the bottom of the fourth when Payton Martin got the final out of the inning to maintain the 6-3 lead for the Loons. That started a streak of thirteen straight batters retired. Daniel Guilarte broke up that streak with a lead-off single in the ninth. The next three hitters struck out.

**MADE FOR THIS:** Made was 2-for-5 on Wednesday for his third multi-hit game as a Rattler. He is also on a five-game hitting streak (8-for-20).

**BACK WITH A BLAST:** Dinges's home run was his first for the Rattlers after his return from the injured list. It was his first Midwest League homer since June 20 a West Michigan. Dinges has seven homers in 35 games with the Rattlers.

**MAKE IT A DOZEN:** Yerlin Rodriguez allowed an unearned run in the ninth inning yesterday. However, he has not allowed an earned run in his last twelve outings.

**WEDNESDAY BLUES:** Wisconsin is 5-12 on when they play on Wednesday this season. The Rattlers are 3-7 at home on Wednesday.

**ABOUT GREAT LAKES:** The Great Lakes Loons came into existence in 2007 after the Midwest League team left Battle Creek, Michigan at the end of the 2006 season. The team in Battle Creek had been known as the Michigan Battle Cats, Battle Creek Yankees, and the Southwest Michigan Devil Rays. The Loons have been affiliated with the Los Angeles Dodgers since 2007. They have made the Midwest League playoffs nine times since 2007. The Loons won the Midwest League title in 2016 and lost to Cedar Rapids in the Midwest League Championship Series in 2023. Notable Great Lakes alumni include Clayton Kershaw, Kenley Jansen, Nathan Eovaldi, Joc Peterson, Julio Urias, Walker Buehler, and Gavin Lux. Jair Fernandez, who played in 52 games with the Timber Rattlers in 2007, is in his second season as the manager of the Loons.

**ABOUT THE DODGERS:** The Los Angeles Dodgers were only in the Midwest League for a few seasons prior to affiliating with the Loons. They were in Dubuque in 1967 and in Clinton from 1977 to 1979. Orel Hershiser and Steve Sax were notable Dodgers to play in Clinton.

## PITCHING MATCHUP

### WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

**RHP TANNER GILLIS:** The Milwaukee Brewers signed Gillis as a non-drafted free agent on September 3, 2024.

**ON THE HORIZON:** Gillis was a First Team All-Horizon League selection in his one season at Northern Kentucky in 2024. He was 8-3 with a 5.00 ERA in fourteen starts. Gillis had pitched four seasons for Cedarville University, an NCAA Division II school from 2019-2023.

**HOW GREEN WAS THE VALLEY?** Gillis made five appearances – four starts – for Mahoning Valley in the MLB Draft League in 2024. He was 2-1 with a 1.80 ERA, struck out 24, and walked seven over 25 innings.

**CAROLINA ON MY MIND:** Gillis started the 2025 season with the Carolina Mudcats. He was 1-1 with a save in seven relief appearances. Gillis had a 1.32 ERA and 28 strikeouts in 27-1/3 innings for the Mudcats before he was assigned to Wisconsin on May 15.

**IT'S A MAJOR AWARD:** Gillis was named the Midwest League Pitcher of the Week on August 11. He set a new professional single-game high for strikeouts with seven over 6-1/3 scoreless innings at Peoria on August 7.

**LAST START:** Gillis won at Peoria on [August 7](#). He pitched 6-1/3 scoreless innings, allowed two hits, walked none and struck out seven.

**VS. GREAT LAKES:** Gillis has never pitched against the Loons prior to this evening. Tonight is the first time he will face an affiliate of the Los Angeles Dodgers.

### GREAT LAKES STARTING PITCHER:

**RHP BROOKS AUGER:** The Los Angeles Dodgers selected Auger in the sixth round of the 2024 draft out of Mississippi State University.

**HAIL STATE:** Auger pitched two seasons (2022 and 2024) for the Bulldogs. He missed the 2023 season after surgery to repair a tear in the UCL of his right elbow. In his career at MSU, Auger was 3-2 with two saves and a 3.26 ERA in 36 games – five starts. Auger walked 29 and struck out 77 in his two collegiate seasons.

**NO PRO BALL IN 2024:** Auger did not pitch professionally. He made his professional debut with the Loons as the starting pitcher on [April 5, 2025](#) against Lake County.

**LAST START:** Auger had a no decision against Lansing at home on [August 8](#). He allowed four runs – two earned – on five hits with two walks and four strikeouts over five innings.

**VS. WISCONSIN:** Auger lost to the Timber Rattlers at Dow Diamond on [June 15](#). He gave up four runs on five hits with two walks and no strikeouts over 3-2/3 innings.
