ABOUT BELOIT: The Beloit Sky Carp changed their name from Snappers after the 2021 season. This is Beloit's third season as an affiliate of the Miami Marlins. Beloit started as the Beloit Brewers in 1982 as the Midwest League affiliate of Milwaukee. They changed their name to the Beloit Snappers for the 1995 season. The Snappers affiliation with Milwaukee ended after the 2004 season They were affiliated with the Minnesota Twins (2005-2012) and the Oakland Athletics (2013-2019) over their final seasons in the Midwest League. The Snappers said "Goodbye" to Pohlman Field on July 11, 2021 and moved into ABC Supply Stadium on August 3, 2021. Billy Gardner Jr is in his first season as the manager of the Sky

ABOUT THE MARLINS: The Florida/Miami Marlins have lots of history in the Midwest League. The Marlins' first Low-A affiliate was the Kane County Cougars from 1993 through 2002. Josh Beckett, Adrian Gonzalez, Dontrelle Willis, Miguel Cabrera, and former Timber Rattlers manager Matt Erickson all played for the Cougars in that timespan The Marlins returned to the Midwest League in in 2019 to affiliate with the Clinton LumberKings. WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP STIVEN CRUZ: Signed by Milwaukee as an International Free Agent out of Nicaragua on July 2, 2019.

DELAYED START: Cruz began his pro career with the Brewers-1 affiliate in the Dominican Summer League in 2021. He was 3-3 with a 1.37 ERA and 73 strikeouts over 52-2/3 innings pitched in twelve games – eleven starts.

MUDDY WATERS: Cruz started the 2022 season with the Carolina Mudcats in the Carolina League. He went 3-5 with a 4.60 ERA in fifteen starts for Carolina. Cruz walked 18 and struck out 89 over 72-1/3 innings pitched.

ON TO WISCONSIN: Cruz joined the Timber Rattlers on August 16, 2022. He made four starts with the Rattlers and allowed one run on six hits with six walks and twenty strikeouts over nineteen innings pitched for a 1-1 record with a 0.47ERA.

IT'S A MAJOR AWARD: Cruz beat Lansing at home on August 24. He allowed a hit with a walk and seven strikeouts over six scoreless innings in the game. Cruz was named the Midwest League Pitcher of the Week on August 29 for this game.

LAST START: Cruz had a <u>no decision at Peoria on September 4, 2022</u>. He allowed two hits, walked none, and struck out two over three scoreless innings.

VS. BELOIT: Cruz has never faced the Beloit prior to this afternoon. Today is also the first time he will pitch against an affiliate of the Miami Marlins.

BELOIT SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP EDGAR SANCHEZ: The Marlins signed Sanchez as an International Free Agent on February 10, 2017 out of the Dominican Republic.

TO THE GULF: Sanchez made his professional debut with the Marlins Gulf Coast League affiliate in 2019. He was 2-3 with a 3.13 in ten games – two starts. Sanchez walked 33 and struck out 31 in 31-2/3 innings pitched.

BACK AT IT: Sanchez started the 2021 season with Jupiter in the Florida State League and allowed nine runs – seven earned – in two innings over three relief appearances. He also was 1-1 with eight walks and 23 strikeouts over 19-2/3 innings in nine games – two starts – back in the Gulf Coast League in 2021.

HAMMER IT HOME: Sanchez started the 2022 season with the Jupiter Hammerheads and went 5-3 in fifteen games – thirteen starts – with a 4.24 ERA. Sanchez walked 26 and struck out 74 with Jupiter before he was promoted to Beloit on August 2.

SKY HIGH: Sanchez made six starts for Beloit and was 0-1 with a 4.07 ERA. He walked fourteen and struck out twenty over 24-1/3 innings pitched in the Midwest League last season.

LAST START: Sanchez had a <u>no decision at Wisconsin on September 7, 2022</u>. He allowed a run on five hits and a walk with six strikeouts over four innings in that game.

VS. WISCONSIN: Sanchez had never faced the Timber Rattlers prior to the game at Neuroscience Group Field on September 7, 2022. That was also his first appearance against an affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers.

Wathan dropped a tin of chewing tobacco while warming up an outfielder. Possession of tobacco on the field was an automatic ejection for the player and for the manager in Minor League Baseball.

April 9, 1998: The Rattlers won the season opener at home 3–2 over Rockford in eleven innings. Carlos Maldonado had the walk-off RBI single.

April 9, 2000: The Rattlers beat Beloit 8-7 in ten innings at home. Termel Sledge hit a walkoff, RBI triple in the tenth.

April 9, 2009: The Rattlers beat Quad Cities 2–1 at home in the season opener. This game is notable for two things. The first was the sellout crowd of 5,487. The second was that this was the first game the Rattlers played as an affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers!
