LAST ACTION: [The Beloit Sky Carp beat the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers 8-6 at Neuroscience Group Field on Sunday afternoon.](#)

Wisconsin had a 5-0 lead after five innings, but the Sky Carp scored a run in the sixth, twice in the seventh, and twice in the ninth to tie the game. Both teams scored in the tenth. Beloit scored twice in the top of the eleventh for the win.

THE SEARCHERS: Wisconsin has not won a series yet this season. A win on Sunday would have given them a split. The loss also dropped Wisconsin's home record to 7-14.

FEELING 22: Blake Burke went 3-for-5 on Sunday to extend his on-base streak to 22 games (30-for-86, eleven walks, .423 OBP, .946 OPS). He is tied with Kyle DeBarge of Cedar Rapids for the longest on-base streak in the league this season.

NICE DEBUT: Tanner Gillis made his Wisconsin Timber Rattlers debut on Sunday as the starting pitcher. He pitched six innings, allowed one run on three hits with two walks and three strikeouts.

NIPPED AT THE LINE: Wisconsin appeared to have won the game in the top of the ninth inning when Eric Rataczak fouled out to Eduardo Garcia with the tying run at second for the final out of the game. However, catcher's interference was called and Rataczak reached base. The tying run scored moments later on a passed ball.

CLUTCH: Garcia tied the game with a lead-off double in the bottom of the tenth to score the placed runner on second. Garcia was left stranded as the potential winning run and the game continued to the eleventh. Wisconsin is 1-2 in extra innings this season..

ABOUT SOUTH BEND: The South Bend Cubs started as the South Bend White Sox when the Midwest League added them as an expansion team in 1988. They changed their name to the Silver Hawks for the 1994 season and became an affiliate of the Arizona Diamondbacks in 1997. South Bend became an affiliate of the Chicago Cubs in 2015. South Bend has won Midwest League titles in 1989, 1993, 2005, 2019, and 2022. Notable alumni for the South Bend franchise include Mike Cameron, Jose Valverde, Chris Capuano, Mark Reynolds, Justin Upton, Wade Miley, Chase Anderson, Keon Broxton, Gleyber Torres, Ian Happ, Carlos Gonzalez, Pete Crow-Armstrong, and current Timber Rattlers manager Victor Estevez. Terry Francona was the manager of the South Bend White Sox in 1982. Nick Lovullo, the son of Arizona Diamondbacks manager Torey Lovullo, is in his second year as South Bend's manager.

ABOUT THE CUBS: The Chicago Cubs had several different Midwest League affiliates before settling in South Bend in 2015. They were affiliated with Quincy from 1965 through 1973 before leaving the Midwest League. The Cubs returned to the MWL for an affiliation with Quad Cities from 1979 through 1984, Peoria from 1985 through 1994 and again from 2005 through 2012, Rockford from 1995 through 1998, Lansing from 1999 through 2004, and Kane County in 2013 and 2014.

PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

RHP PATRICIO AQUINO: The Milwaukee Brewers signed Aquino as an International Free Agent out of Venezuela on January 15, 2021.

LET'S GET IT STARTED: Aquino made his professional debut with the Brewers #1 affiliate in the Dominican Summer League in 2021. He made eleven starts and was 1-2 with a 2.66 ERA and 54 strikeouts in 44 innings pitched.

LET'S GO TO ARIZONA: Aquino was 2-1 with a 4.72 ERA in eight games – seven starts – for the Brewers Gold affiliate in the Arizona Complex League during the 2022 season. He had 49 strikeouts over 34-1/3 innings pitched.

ON TO CAROLINA: Aquino was 5-3 with a 2.75 ERA in 21 games – 19 starts – with 86 strikeouts over 88-1/3 innings pitched during the 2023 regular season. He also pitched six scoreless innings in Game Two of the First Round of the 2023 Carolina League Playoffs for the Mudcats,

2024: Aquino made twenty appearances – ten starts – for Wisconsin last season. He was 3-4 with two saves and a 3.65 ERA. Aquino had 57 strikeouts and 23 walks in 79 innings as a Rattler last year.

LAST START: Aquino lost to Beloit at home on [May 14](#). He allowed five runs on four hits with a walk and no strikeouts over 2/3 of an inning.

VS. SOUTH BEND (2024): Aquino had no record in four games – two starts – against the Cubs last season. He allowed three runs on thirteen hits with three walks and eight strikeouts over seventeen innings.

SOUTH BEND STARTING PITCHER:

RHP TYLER SCHLAFFER: The Chicago Cubs selected Schlaffer in the ninth round of the 2019 draft out of Homewood-Flossmoor Community High School in Flossmoor, Illinois.

SIGNING OVER SCHOOL: Schlaffer had committed to pitch for the University of Illinois-Chicago prior to the draft. He signed with the Cubs on August 6, 2019 and was assigned to the Arizona League. Schlaffer made three brief relief appearances in the AZL and had five strikeouts over 5-1/3 innings pitched before the end of that season.

THE WAITING IS THE HARDEST PART: Schlaffer did not pitch during the COVID-19 shutdown.

BACK AT IT: Schlaffer was on the mound for the Arizona Complex League Cubs when the 2021 season started. He went 2-1 in three starts before a promotion to Myrtle Beach in the Carolina League on July 19. Schlaffer finished the 2021 season with Myrtle Beach and was 2-5 in nine starts with 40 strikeouts over 40-2/3 innings.

ON THE SHELF: Schlaffer started his 2022 season with Myrtle Beach and was 4-3 with a 3.82 ERA in eighteen starts before he was promoted to South Bend. Schlaffer made a start for the Cubs on July 27 against Lake County but went on the injured list. He needed Tommy John Surgery and missed all of 2023.

LAST START: Schlaffer had a no decision at Lansing on [May 13](#). He allowed three runs on four hits with two walks and no strikeouts in five innings.

VS. WISCONSIN (2024): Schlaffer had a no record in three games – two starts against Wisconsin last season. He allowed twelve runs on fourteen hits with eight walks and six strikeouts over 8-2/3 innings.
