ABOUT LAST NIGHT: [The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers beat the Cedar Rapids Kernels 12-9 at Neuroscience Group Field.](#)

Ashton McGee drove in six runs and Darrien Miller drove in five runs as the Rattlers built a 12-2 lead and held on for the win.

STARTING FAST: The Timber Rattlers scored eight runs in the bottom of the first inning. The first eight hitters reached base and all eight scored. Tristan Peters drove in the first run with an RBI single. Miller followed with a grand slam. The next two batters singled before McGee cracked a three-run homer.

SPEAKING OF EIGHT: Zavier Warren went 1-for-3 last night to extend his hitting streak to eight games. He has matched Peters for the longest hitting streak by a Rattler this season.

SLAMTOWN: Miller has hit three grand slams in his pro career. He had two last year with the Carolina Mudcats.

BEND BUT DON'T BREAK: Wisconsin starting pitcher Antoine Kelly walked seven and hit four batters over 4-1/3 innings but struck out seven without allowing a hit and only allowed four runs.

THE FIRST CENTURY: Kelly's seven strikeouts moved him to 100 Ks on the season. He leads the Midwest League in strikeouts and is ninth in Minor League baseball in that category. Additionally, opposing hitters are hitting .173 against Kelly. That is the lowest average against qualified pitchers in the league.

DELIVERY FROM THE BAKER: The Kernels pulled to within 12-7 and had the bases loaded with one out in the top of the ninth. Robbie Baker was called into the game from the Wisconsin bullpen and got a strikeout, allowed a two-run single, and a strikeout to earn his first save in affiliate baseball since August 20, 2018 with the Gulf Coast League Red Sox.

CLOSE SHAVES: Wisconsin has a save in each of their last eleven wins. The last Rattlers win that didn't need a save was a 5-1 win over Peoria on June 5.

ABOUT CEDAR RAPIDS: The current franchise began its existence as the Cedar Rapids Braves, an affiliate of the Milwaukee Braves in the Three-I League, in 1958. That was the same year and league the current Timber Rattlers franchise joined the Three-I League as the Fox Cities Foxes. Both teams moved to the Midwest League when the Three-I League ended after the 1961 season. Cedar Rapids has been called the Braves, Red Raiders, Cardinals, Astros, Giants, and Reds until they became the Kernels in 1993. That was the same year the California Angels became the parent club of the Kernels. That affiliation remained through the 2012 season. Cedar Rapids has been affiliated with the Minnesota Twins since 2013. The Kernels have made the Midwest League playoffs every year they have been affiliated with the Twins. Notable alumni include Mike Trout, Byron Buxton, Trevor Hoffman, Brewers Pitching Coach Chris Hook, and Ted Simmons.

ABOUT THE TWINS: Minnesota has a long history of in the Midwest League. They started out with Wisconsin Rapids (1964-1983) and moved to Kenosha (1984-1992) and to Fort Wayne (1993-1998) as the franchise moved. Minnesota has also been with Quad Cities (1999-2004) and Beloit (2005-2012) before their current affiliation with Cedar Rapids Kernels started in 2013.

PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES: [MLB Pipeline](#) puts six active Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Tyler Black (#7), Joe Gray Jr. (#13), Antoine Kelly (#14), Russell Smith (#16), Zavier Warren (#17), and Cam Robinson (#26). Carlos Rodríguez (#21) is on the Wisconsin injured list. [MLB Pipeline](#) has five current Cedar Rapids players on their Top 30 list of Twins prospects: Aaron Sabato (#14), Alerick Soularie (#21), Cade Povich (#23), Christian Encarnacion-Strand (#25), and David Festa (#30).

PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

LHP RUSSELL SMITH: Selected by the Brewers in the second round (51st overall selection) of the 2021 draft out of Texas Christian University. He is rated as the #16 prospect in the Brewers system by MLB Pipeline.

AREA CODE: Smith was picked as the Most Outstanding Player at the Area Code Games in 2016. He was also a four-year letter winner at Midlothian (TX) High School.

NO, CUBS, NO: The Chicago Cubs picked Smith in the 38th round of the 2017 draft. He elected to honor a commitment to TCU.

HORNED FROGS: Smith was 7-3 with a 3.83 ERA in fifteen starts during his final season at TCU. He had 101 strikeouts in 82-1/3 innings pitched that season.

MISSING TIME: Smith missed the 2019 season due to Tommy John Surgery and most of the 2020 season due to the pandemic shutdown.

LAST START: Smith had a [no decision against Quad Cities at home on June 26](#). He gave up two runs on two hits with no walks and two strikeouts over three innings.

VS. CEDAR RAPIDS (2022): Smith [lost at Cedar Rapids on May 26](#). He allowed four runs on four hits with two walks and three strikeouts over 3-2/3 innings.

INNINGS PITCHED: 6.0 – 6/1/2022 v. Peoria

STRIKEOUTS: 8 – 6/7/2022 @ Beloit

CEDAR RAPIDS SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP JOHN STANKIEWICZ: The Twins signed Stankiewicz as a non-drafted free agent on July 6, 2020 out of Fordham University.

RAMMING SPEED: Stankiewicz was 11-5 in 36 games – nineteen starts – in his college career at Fordham. He had an ERA of 2.00 with 37 walks and 145 strikeouts in college.

MAN OF THE YEAR: Stankiewicz was named the Atlantic 10 Pitcher of the Year as a sophomore. He was 8-4 in seventeen games – thirteen starts – with a 1.47 ERA with 102 strikeouts over 92 innings to help the Rams to an A-10 Tournament Championship and an appearance in the NCAA Tournament at the Morgantown Regional.

IN THE ARENA: Stankiewicz made one start in the Florida Complex League and seven appearances – four starts – for Fort Myers in 2021. He was 1-0 with a 2.84 ERA, nine walks, and 30 strikeouts over 25-1/3 innings pitched in his first professional season.

HOLDING DOWN THE FORT: Stankiewicz started the 2022 season with Fort Myers in the Florida State League before earning a promotion to Cedar Rapids on April 30. Stankiewicz was 3-0 with 31 strikeouts and only two earned runs allowed over 21-2/3 innings pitched for the Mighty Mussels before the move to the Midwest League.

LAST START: Stankiewicz had a [no decision against West Michigan at home on June 26](#). He allowed one run on three hits with two walks and three strikeouts over six innings.

VS. WISCONSIN: Stankiewicz [lost to the Timber Rattlers at Cedar Rapids on May 27](#). He allowed five runs on seven hits with a walk and three strikeouts over 4-2/3 innings. Micah Bello hit a home against Stankiewicz.
