Joe Hernandez was the starter for Wisconsin and allowed two runs - one earned - on three hits with five strikeouts over five innings for the win. Edwin Jimenez and Kaleb Bowman combined to pitch the final four innings to close out the win. Wisconsin has won three games in a row.

LUCKY THIRTEEN ON THE THIRTEENTH: Eric Brown Jr had two singles, two stolen bases, two runs scored and a walk. He extended his on-base streak to

thirteen games. Brown was hitting .102 when the streak started on April 23. He has raised his average to .225 during the streak.

MEET THE METZ: Metzinger had an RBI single in the first inning and an RBI single in the second inning to give the Rattlers a 2-0 lead. Metzinger has sixteen RBI and leads Wisconsin in that category.

WAY TO GO, JOE! Hernandez earned his second win of the season with his performance on Saturday. South Bend tied the game 2-2 on a two-run single by Bryce Ball in the top of the fourth. He retired the final six batters he faced in the game.

MR. PERFECT: Wisconsin took the lead when Metzinger scored on a wild pitch in the bottom of the fifth inning. Then, Jimenez pitched three perfect innings to protect the one-run lead. Jimenez has retired 22 of the last 23 batters he has faced since May 2.

SIX-PACK: Bowman pitched a scoreless ninth inning on Saturday. He is six-for-six in save opportunities with the Rattlers this season.

FAMILIAR FINISH: Each of the last two games of the series have finished with the Rattlers turning a double play. Friday's game ended with Brown turning an unassisted twin killing on a line drive to short. Saturday's game ended on a 4-6-3 double play that started with a grounder to Brown at second base.

ABOUT SOUTH BEND: The South Bend Cubs started as the South Bend White Sox when the Midwest League added them as an expansion team in 1988. They changed their name to the Silver Hawks for the 1994 season and became an affiliate of the Arizona Diamondbacks in 1997. South Bend became an affiliate of the Chicago Cubs in 2015. They are the defending Midwest League Champions after finishing 73-58 last season, beating Cedar Rapids in the Western Division Finals, and Lake County in the Championship Series. South Bend also won Midwest League pennants in 1989, 1993, 2005, and 2019. Notable alumni for the South Bend franchise include Mike Cameron, Jose Valverde, Chris Capuano, Mark Reynolds, Justin Upton, Wade Miley, Chase Anderson, Keon Broxton, Gleyber Torres, Ian Happ, and Carlos Gonzalez. Terry Francona was the manager of the South Bend White Sox in 1982.

ABOUT THE CUBS: The Chicago Cubs had several different Midwest League affiliates before settling in South Bend in 2015. They were affiliated with Quincy from 1965 through 1973 before leaving the Midwest League. The Cubs returned to the MWL with an affiliation with Quad Cities from 1979 through 1984, Peoria from 1985 through 1994 and again from 2005 through 2012, Rockford from 1995 through 1998, Lansing from 1999 through 2004, and Kane County in 2013 and 2014.

SEASON SO FAR: South Bend are 15-12 on the season. They are tied with Peoria for second place in the Western Division. Both teams are 1-1/2 games behind first-place Beloit. In their most recent series, the Cubs went 2-4 at home against Cedar Rapids. South Bend starts a series at Beloit on May 16.

PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES: MLB Pipeline places five Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Eric Brown Jr (#8), Robert Moore (#10), Hendry Mendez (#15), Eduardo García (#21), and Joseph Hernandez (#28). MLB Pipeline has four active South Bend players on their list of Cubs prospects: Kevin Alcántara (#2), Cade Horton (#4), James Triantos (#11), and Kevin Made (#15). Ed Howard (#22) has not played this season and is on the South Bend Injured List.

PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP CAMERON WAGONER: Selected by Milwaukee in the eleventh round of the 2022 draft out of Eastern Michigan University.

EASTERN NOTES: Wagoner did not pitch collegiately in 2022. He made six relief appearances during the abbreviated 2020 season and 18 appearances – three starts – in 2021. He was 2-4 with a 4.42 ERA and 67 strikeouts over 57 innings during his two college seasons.

HOW DID YOU SPEND YOUR SUMMERS? Wagoner played for Greeneville in the Appalachian League in 2021 and was with both Wareham and Cotuit in the Cape Cod League in 2022. He was 2-3 with a 4.97 ERA in nineteen games – two starts – and 57 strikeouts over 38 innings pitched in those summer leagues.

AS A PRO: Wagoner made four appearances – two starts – for the ACL Brewers Gold after signing with Milwaukee. He was 1-0 and had eight strikeouts in eight innings in the ACL.

DOWN UNDER: Wagoner pitched for the Brisbane Bandits of the Australian Baseball League during the Winter of 2022-23. He made ten starts during the regular season of the ABL and was 3-1 with a 3.26 ERA and 43 strikeouts in 47 innings pitched.

LAST START: Wagoner <u>lost to the Cubs in game of this series on May 9</u>. He allowed seven runs on four hits, two hit batsmen, and a walk in 2/3 of an inning. All seven runs scored by South Bend scored after two outs in the first

VS. SOUTH BEND: Wagoner's only appearance against South Bend was the start on May 9. In his final appearance of 2022, Wagoner beat Myrtle Beach, the Carolina League affiliate of the Chicago Cubs on September 10. He allowed a run on four hits with no walks and six strikeouts over 4-2/3 innings as a reliever.

SOUTH BEND STARTING PITCHER:

RHP MANUEL ESPINOZA: The Cubs signed Espinoza as an International Free Agent on July 31, 2017 out of Mexico.

STARTING OUT: Espinoza made his professional debut with the Cubs #2 affiliate in the Arizona League in 2019. He was 5-2 in eleven games – seven starts – with nine walks, 37 strikeouts, and a 2.49 ERA in 47 innings pitched in the AZL.

TIME ON THE BEACH: Espinoza pitched for the Myrtle Beach Pelicans in the Low-A East in 2021. He was 4-9 with a 5.11 ERA in 22 starts. Espinoza walked 26 and struck out 92 over 98-2/3 innings pitched as a Pelican last season.

SOUTH OF THE BORDER: Espinoza has pitched for Tomateros de Culicán of the Mexican Pacific Winter League during the offseason between 2020 and 2021 and the offseason between 2021 and 2022. He made six appearances – four starts – with a 2-1 record and a 3.63 ERA over 22-1/3 innings pitched for his hometown team.

LAST SEASON: Espinoza was 3-5 with a 4.86 ERA in seventeen games – eleven starts – for the Cubs in 2022. He had 68 strikeouts over 66-2/3 innings before he was placed on the Injured List on July 26 and missed the rest of the season.

LAST START: Espinoza had <u>a no decision at Peoria on July 15, 2022</u>. He allowed one run on two hits with five walks and two strikeouts over four innings.

LAST APPEARANCE: Espinoza <u>beat the Timber Rattlers on May 9, 2023</u> in his first game since last July. He allowed one walk and one hit with one strikeout over two scoreless innings in that game.

VS. WISCONSIN (2022): Espinoza made three appearances – two starts – against the Timber Rattlers during the 2022 season. He pitched against the Timber Rattlers as a starter on May 17 and July 15 with a relief outing on May 22. Espinoza went 0-1 and allowed eight runs – five earned – on nine hits with four walks and seven strikeouts over eight innings versus Wisconsin last season.
