ABOUT LAST NIGHT: [The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers beat the Great Lakes Loons 4-3 at Neuroscience Group Field.](#) Luis Peña went 2-for-4 with a homer and three RBI for the Rattlers. Wisconsin trailed 2-1 heading into the bottom of the fifth inning before scoring three runs to take a 4-2 lead. The Loons scored a run in the top of the sixth, but the Rattlers held on for the win. Great Lakes pitchers combined to strike out fourteen Rattlers last night and became the first staff in the Midwest League to reach 1000 strikeouts on the season.

IT FEELS SO GOOD: Wisconsin has won two straight games for the first time since they swept a doubleheader from the Beloit Sky Carp on July 6.

WORLD TAG TEAM CHAMPIONS OF THE WORLD: Travis Smith allowed three runs – two earned – on five hits with two walks and no strikeouts over 5-2/3 innings as the Wisconsin starting pitcher. Smith earned his first Midwest League victory last night. Jesús Broca worked 3-1/3 scoreless innings in relief with one hit, three walks, and five strikeouts for his fifth save of the season.

WELCOME HOME: Smith, Peña, and Jesús Made all made their home debuts last night for the Rattlers. Made was 1-for-3 with a double, a walk, and a run scored and is on a four-game hitting streak (6-for-15). Peña hit his second home run as a Rattler when he cracked a solo shot in the third inning to tie the game 1-1. Peña broke a 2-2 tie with a two-run single in the bottom of the fifth.

RESETTING STANDARDS: Last night's crowd of 6,209 was the fourth time in the last seven home games Wisconsin has set a new single-game high in attendance. The top five home crowds of the season for Wisconsin are:

ABOUT GREAT LAKES: The Great Lakes Loons came into existence in 2007 after the Midwest League team left Battle Creek, Michigan at the end of the 2006 season. The team in Battle Creek had been known as the Michigan Battle Cats, Battle Creek Yankees, and the Southwest Michigan Devil Rays. The Loons have been affiliated with the Los Angeles Dodgers since 2007. They have made the Midwest League playoffs nine times since 2007. The Loons won the Midwest League title in 2016 and lost to Cedar Rapids in the Midwest League Championship Series in 2023. Notable Great Lakes alumni include Clayton Kershaw, Kenley Jansen, Nathan Eovaldi, Joc Peterson, Julio Urias, Walker Buehler, and Gavin Lux. Jair Fernandez, who played in 52 games with the Timber Rattlers in 2007, is in his second season as the manager of the Loons.

ABOUT THE DODGERS: The Los Angeles Dodgers were only in the Midwest League for a few seasons prior to affiliating with the Loons. They were in Dubuque in 1967 and in Clinton from 1977 to 1979. Orel Hershiser and Steve Sax were notable Dodgers to play in Clinton.

WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

RHP MANUEL RODRIGUEZ: The Milwaukee Brewers signed Rodriguez as an International Free Agent out of Mexico on April 5, 2022.

WHIRLWIND: Rodriguez had a very busy 2022. After signing with Milwaukee in April, he began his professional career in the Dominican Summer League in June and went 1-5 with a 4.54 ERA in twelve games – five starts. Later in the year he pitched for Mexico in the U-18 World Cup of Baseball. Rodriguez went 1-1 in the tournament with a win over Australia and a loss to the Netherlands.

PLAYOFF EXPERIENCE: Rodriguez has pitched in the postseason in each of the last two seasons. He made a relief appearance for the ACL Brewers in the Arizona Complex League Semifinal Game in 2023 and was the starter in Game Two of the Carolina League Playoffs for the Mudcats against Fredericksburg.

CHECK THE RATING: MLB Pipeline moved Rodriguez into their Top 30 list of Brewers Prospects at #30 after Yophery Rodriguez was traded to Boston on April 7, 2025 and up to #29 when Isaac Collins graduated from the list on April 19, 2025. In the July 25, 2025 update, Rodriguez was back at #30, but he dropped off the Top 30 after the most recent update. *Baseball America* listed Rodriguez as the #25 prospect in the Milwaukee System in their 2025 *Prospect Handbook*.

LAST START: Rodriguez lost at Peoria on [August 6](#). He allowed six runs on nine hits with a walk and six strikeouts over 5-2/3 innings. The Chiefs hit a pair of homers off Rodriguez in that game.

VS. GREAT LAKES: Rodriguez has never faced the Loons prior to this afternoon. Today is his first time facing an affiliate of the Los Angeles Dodgers.

GREAT LAKES STARTING PITCHER:

RHP PAYTON MARTIN: The Los Angeles Dodgers selected Martin in the seventeenth round of the 2022 draft out of West Forsyth High School in Clemmons, North Carolina. Martin is rated as the #28 prospect in the Dodgers system by MLB Pipeline. *Baseball America* ranks him as the #19 prospect in the Dodgers system.

MAKING SOME CHANGES: Martin was a shortstop committed to East Carolina University when he was drafted by the Dodgers. He elected to sign with Los Angeles and make a switch to pitching full time.

HEADING TO THE RANCH: Martin did not pitch professionally in 2022. His debut season was with the Rancho Cucamonga Quakes, the California League affiliate of the Dodgers, in 2023. He was 2-1 with a 2.04 ERA in fourteen games – twelve starts. Martin had fifteen walks and 48 strikeouts over 39-2/3 innings pitched.

IN RERUNS: Martin missed the first month of the 2024 season before being activated on the Rancho Cucamonga roster on May 1. He was 0-2 with a 4.82 ERA in six starts for the Quakes before his promotion to Great Lakes on June 6. He finished the season with the Loons and was 3-4 with a 3.38 ERA and 32 strikeouts over 53-1/3 innings pitched.

LAST START: Martin earned the win over Lansing at home on August 7. He allowed four runs on six hits with three walks and six strikeouts over 5-2/3 innings.

VS. WISCONSIN: Martin is 1-0 in two starts against the Rattlers in his career. He beat the Timber Rattlers at Dow Diamond on [August 24, 2024](#). Martin allowed one hit with a walk and two strikeouts over five shutout innings in that start. He had a no decision against Wisconsin on [June 13, 2025](#) at Dow Diamond as he allowed two runs on two hits with two walks and a strikeout over 2/3 of an inning.
