ABOUT LAST NIGHT: [The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers lost 2-1 to the Quad Cities River Bandits at Modern Woodmen Park.](#)

Tayden Hall drove in Matt Wood with a two-out, RBI single in the top of the second inning to give Wisconsin a 1-0 lead. The Bandits tied the game in the sixth when Carson Roccaforte beat out a potential inning-ending double play to allow the tying run to score from third. Roccaforte tripled with one out in the eighth inning and scored the go-ahead on a single by Justin Johnson. Wood had two of Wisconsin's four hits last night.

FEAST OR FAMINE: In a doubleheader against South Bend on August 3, the Timber Rattlers scored two runs with a 4-1 loss and a 1-0 win. In the final game of the South Bend series on August 4, Wisconsin scored 15 runs in a 15-12 win. In the first two games of this series with the River Bandits, Wisconsin has scored one run.

LOOK OUT: Luke Adams was hit by a pitch in the eighth inning last night. He has been hit by a pitch 34 times this season. Since 2005, only two Midwest League players have been hit by pitches more: Nick Sanay of Lansing (38 times in 2017) and Jonathan Greene (36 times in 2008).

ABOUT QUAD CITIES: The River Bandits are the Midwest League affiliate of the Kansas City Royals. The current version of Davenport Professional Baseball club started in 1960 as the Midwest League affiliate of the Milwaukee Braves. Quad Cities has affiliated with several MLB teams: The California Angels (1962-1978 and 1985-1992), the Chicago Cubs (1979-1984), the Houston Astros (1993-1998 and 2013-2019), the Minnesota Twins (1999-2004), and the St. Louis Cardinals (2005-2012). The team became the Quad City River Bandits in 1992. They changed their name to the Swing of the Quad Cities from 2004 through 2007 before changing to Quad Cities River Bandits in 2008. Quad Cities won Midwest League pennants in 1968, 1971, 1979, 1990, 2011, 2013, and 2017. They were the High-A Central League champions in 2021. Notable alumni of Quad Cities: Carlos Correa, Joe Mauer, Josh Hader, Billy Wagner, Shawon Dunston, Justin Morneau, and Brett Phillips.

ABOUT THE ROYALS: The Kansas City Royals have been Quad Cities' parent club since 2021. They left the Midwest league and an affiliation with Kane County at the end of the 2012 season. The Royals had previously been in the Midwest League with Waterloo (1969-1976), Appleton (1987-1992), Rockford (1993-94), Springfield (1995), Lansing (1996-1998), Burlington (2001-2010), and Kane County (2011-2012).

PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

LHP BRIAN FITZPATRICK: The Milwaukee Brewers selected Fitzpatrick in the 10th round of the 2022 draft out of Rutgers.

SCARLET KNIGHT: Fitzpatrick went 7-3 with two saves and a 5.24 ERA in 23 games – seven starts – during his three seasons at Rutgers. He went 3-1 with a 3.91 ERA in six starts during his final season. In 46-1/3 innings during his collegiate career, Fitzpatrick had 59 strikeouts.

LET'S GET IT STARTED: Fitzpatrick pitched two games with one start for the Brewers Blue affiliate in the Arizona Complex League in 2022. He returned to the ACL at the start of the 2023 season and was 1-1 in five games – three starts before a promotion to Carolina.

OFF TO CAROLINA: Fitzpatrick had six appearances – four starts – with the Mudcats in the Carolina League regular season. He went 0-1 with a 4.15 ERA. Fitzpatrick also made a relief appearance at Down East in Game Three of the Carolina League playoff series with 1/3 of a scoreless inning.

DOWN UNDER: Fitzpatrick pitched this past off-season with the Brisbane Bandits of the Australian Baseball League. He was 3-3 in ten starts with a 3.74 ERA and 49 strikeouts in 43-1/3 innings.

LAST START: Fitzpatrick beat South Bend at home on [August 3](#). He allowed three hits, walked none, and struck out seven over five scoreless innings. Fitzpatrick matched his pro high for strikeouts in a game.

VS. QUAD CITIES: Fitzpatrick has made three appearances – one start – against the River Bandits this season. He has allowed one run on ten hits with three walks and thirteen strikeouts over twelve innings. Fitzpatrick does not have a start against Quad Cities this season.

QUAD CITIES STARTING PITCHER:

RHP ETHAN BOSACKER: The Kansas City Royals selected Bosacker in the 13th round of 2023 draft out of Xavier.

X MARKS THE SPOT: Bosacker was 4-3 with a 3.34 ERA in twelve games – ten starts – for the Musketeers in 2021. He missed the entire 2022 season due to injury and bounced back to go 8-3 with a 3.49 ERA in sixteen starts in 2023. In his final season at Xavier, Bosacker walked 29 and struck out 101 in 98 innings.

APPALACHIAN SUMMER: Bosacker made three starts for Johnson City in the Appalachian League in 2021. He was 0-1 with eleven strikeouts over 6-2/3 innings.

FIREFLIES: Bosacker's pro debut was two brief relief appearances in the ACL in 2023. He began 2024 for Columbia in the Carolina League and was 6-2 with a 2.78 ERA. The Royals promoted Bosacker to Quad Cities on July 9, 2024.

LAST START: Bosacker won at Peoria on [August 2](#). He allowed a run on seven hits with no walks and two strikeouts over six innings.

VS. WISCONSIN: Bosacker has never faced the Timber Rattlers before this evening. He was 1-0 in two games – one start – against the Carolina Mudcats, the Carolina League affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers, this season. Bosacker allowed two runs on seven hits with a walk and four strikeouts over ten innings.
