LAST ACTION: [The Cedar Rapids Kernels beat the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers 7-6 at Veterans Memorial Stadium on Saturday night.](#)

Wisconsin hit four home runs in the game – Braylon Payne, Andrew Fischer, Eric Bitonti, and Luis Castillo all went deep for the Rattlers. Cedar Rapids scored six of their seven runs with two outs. Sunday's game was rained out.

FAST START: Payne's homer was a lead-off home run to start the game. It was his second lead-off home run of the season. Payne had not homered since May 16 against South Bend at home.

PUT IT IN CONTEXT: Fischer's home run was his eighteenth of the season. He has hit the most homers by a Rattler in a single season since the team moved to the High-A classification in 2021. The all-time Timber Rattlers record for homers in a season is 22 held by Khris Davis (2010), Victor Roache (2013), and Clint Coulter (2014). Only two other Rattlers in team history have reached 20 homers in a season – Juan Silvestre (21 in 1999) and Isan Diaz (20 in 2016).

HE GETS ON BASE: Fischer is on a 25-game on-base streak with twelve homers, 26 walks, and a 1.295 OPS. Fischer also extended his hitting streak to ten games. He is 12-for-35 during this streak.

GETTING CLOSE: Bitonti's homer was a three-run shot in the top of the sixth inning to pull the Rattlers to within 6-5. Bitonti has eight homers and 27 RBI this season.

STATE OF THE RACE: The South Bend Cubs are in first place in the West Division (34-19) with a five-game lead on the Wisconsin. The Cubs magic number over the Timber Rattlers is five. South Bend has nine games remaining while Wisconsin has ten games left in the half.

ABOUT GREAT LAKES: The Great Lakes Loons came into existence in 2007 after the Midwest League team left Battle Creek, Michigan at the end of the 2006 season. The team in Battle Creek had been known as the Michigan Battle Cats, Battle Creek Yankees, and the Southwest Michigan Devil Rays. The Loons have been affiliated with the Los Angeles Dodgers since 2007. They have made the Midwest League playoffs nine times since 2007. The Loons won the Midwest League title in 2016 and lost to Cedar Rapids in the Midwest League Championship Series in 2023. Notable Great Lakes alumni include Clayton Kershaw, Kenley Jansen, Nathan Eovaldi, Joc Peterson, Julio Urias, Walker Buehler, Will Smith, and Gavin Lux. Jair Fernandez, who played in 52 games with the Timber Rattlers in 2007, is in his third season as the manager of the Loons.

ABOUT THE DODGERS: The Los Angeles Dodgers were only in the Midwest League for a few seasons prior to affiliating with the Loons. They were in Dubuque in 1967 and in Clinton from 1977 to 1979. Orel Hershiser and Steve Sax were notable Dodgers to play in Clinton.

STARTING PITCHERS

WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

RHP BRAYLON OWENS: The Milwaukee Brewers selected Owens in the tenth round of the 2025 draft out of the University of Texas-San Antonio.

FOUR SEASONS AS A ROADRUNNER: Owens spent all four seasons of his college career at UTSA. He was 14-7 with four saves and a 4.76 ERA in 63 games – 22 starts – in college. Owens had 196 strikeouts in 181-2/3 innings at Texas-San Antonio.

VICTORIAN AGE: Owens pitched three summers for the Victoria Generals of the Texas Collegiate League and went 10-1 with a 2.76 ERA in eighteen games – fourteen starts with the Generals.

NO PRO: Owens did not pitch professionally after signing with the Brewers. He was 7-2 with three saves in 21 games – fourteen starts – as he helped the Roadrunners make the NCAA tournament and advance to a Super Regional against the UCLA Bruins in his final season.

NAILED IT DOWN: Owens earned the save against Texas in the Austin Regional on [May 31, 2025](#). He allowed a run on a hit with seven strikeouts over the final four innings to lock down a 9-7 win over the Longhorns. Owens was named to the All-Regional Team for his performance.

A MAJOR AWARD: The Brewers named Owens as their Minor League Pitcher of the Month for May.

LAST START: Owens won at Cedar Rapids on [June 3](#). He allowed a run on five hits with a walk and two strikeouts over five innings.

VS. GREAT LAKES: Owens had a no decision at Dow Diamond on [May 20](#). He allowed two runs on four hits with two walks and seven strikeouts over five innings. Charles Davalan hit a lead-off homer against Owens in the bottom of the first inning for the Loons.

GREAT LAKES STARTING PITCHER:

LHP ZACH ROOT: The Dodgers selected Root in the first round of the 2025 draft out of University of Arkansas with the fortieth overall pick. Root is rated as the #12 prospect in the Dodgers organization by MLB Pipeline.

I DON'T WANT TO BE A PIRATE: Root pitched his first two seasons of college baseball at East Carolina University. He was 3-3 with a save and a 5.53 ERA in twenty games – thirteen starts – as a freshman. Root went 6-2 with a 3.56 ERA in thirteen games – twelve starts – as a sophomore. He had 130 strikeouts in 122 innings at ECU before his transfer to Arkansas.

THE ROAD TO OMAHA: Root was 9-6 with a 3.62 ERA in nineteen starts at Arkansas. He had 126 strikeouts over 99-1/3 innings with the Razorbacks. Root was the starting pitcher and winner in the Fayetteville Regional against Creighton on May 31, 2025 and against Tennessee in game one of the Fayetteville Super Regional on June 7, 2025. Root went 1-1 as a starting pitcher in the College World Series with a loss to LSU on June 14, 2025 and a win over UCLA on June 17, 2025. Andrew Fischer was 0-for-3 against Root on June 7. Daniel Dickinson was 1-for-1 against Root on June 14.

LAST START: Root earned the win against Lansing at home on [June 2](#). He allowed one hit with no walks and nine strikeouts over seven scoreless innings.

VS. WISCONSIN: Root had a no decision against the Timber Rattlers at Dow Diamond on [May 20](#). He gave up a hit, walked three, and struck out six over 3-2/3 scoreless innings.
