**ABOUT LAST NIGHT:** [The Quad Cities River Bandits beat the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers 11-1 at Modern Woodmen Park. The Timber Rattlers had a 1-0 lead after an RBI fielder's choice by Matt Wood in the third inning.](#) However, Juan Carlos Negret hit two homers – a three-run home run in the fourth and a two-run homer in the fifth – and added a two-run double in the eighth for seven RBI in the game. The teams split the six-game series, Wisconsin's third straight series split.

**TRIPLE DECKER:** Joe Gray Jr had three of Wisconsin's eight hits in the game. Gray leads the Timber Rattlers in three-hit games (4) and multi-hit games (16) this season.

**NUMBER NINE:** Ernesto Martinez Jr went 2-for-4 on Sunday to extend his hitting streak to nine games. Martinez is 11-for-31 (.355) during the streak, his longest of the season.

**BLACKJACK!** Robert Moore singled in the third inning on Sunday to extend his current on-base streak to 21 games. Moore is 22-for-76 (.289) with an OPS of .859 with fifteen walks, fifteen RBI, and twelve runs scored during the streak that started on June 8. Moore's streak is the sixth-longest in the Midwest League this season. Dalton Rushing of Great Lakes has the longest on-base streak in the league this season at 29 games from April 7 through May 14.

**MAKING MOVES:** The Milwaukee Brewers have announced the following moves for the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers. Reliever Ryan Brady was promoted to Biloxi prior to last night's game. Reliever Miguel Guerrero has joined the Timber Rattlers from Carolina prior to tonight's game.

**IN-STATE RIVALS:** The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers welcome the Beloit Sky Carp to the ballpark tonight to start a six-game series. The Rattlers haven't seen Beloit since April. The Wisconsin and Beloit franchises have played 452 games since 1995 and both teams have won 226.

**ABOUT BELOIT:** The Beloit Sky Carp changed their name from Snappers after the 2021 season. This is Beloit's third season as an affiliate of the Miami Marlins. Beloit started as the Beloit Brewers in 1982 as the Midwest League affiliate of Milwaukee. They changed their name to the Beloit Snappers for the 1995 season. The Snappers affiliation with Milwaukee ended after the 2004 season. They were affiliated with the Minnesota Twins (2005-2012) and the Oakland Athletics (2013-2019) over their final seasons in the Midwest League. The Snappers said "Goodbye" to Pohlman Field on July 11, 2021 and moved into ABC Supply Stadium on August 3, 2021. Billy Gardner Jr is in his first season as the manager of the Sky Carp.

**ABOUT THE MARLINS:** The Florida/Miami Marlins have lots of history in the Midwest League. The Marlins' first Low-A affiliate was the Kane County Cougars from 1993 through 2002. Josh Beckett, Adrian Gonzalez, Dontrelle Willis, Miguel Cabrera, and former Timber Rattlers manager Matt Erickson all played for the Cougars in that timespan. The Marlins returned to the Midwest League in 2019 to affiliate with the Clinton LumberKings. The Marlins landed in Beloit after MLB reset the affiliations for 2021.

**PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES:** [MLB Pipeline](#) places six active Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Jacob Misiorowski (#4), Eric Brown Jr (#6), Robert Moore (#8), Hendry Mendez (#13), Eduardo Garcia (#19), and Matthew Wood (#24). Joseph Hernandez (#25) is currently on Wisconsin's IL. [MLB Pipeline](#) has five Beloit players on their list of Marlins prospects: Jacob Berry (#2), Joe Mack (#5), Yiddi Cappe (#6), Kahlil Watson (#12), and Karson Milbrandt (#15).

## WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

**RHP ALEXANDER CORNIELLE:** Milwaukee signed Cornielle as an International Free Agent out of the Dominican Republic on June 15, 2019.

**FAST DEBUT:** Cornielle made his professional debut with one inning of relief against the Cubs #2 affiliate in the Dominican Summer League on August 2, 2019. He allowed one run on no hits with two walks in one inning. Cornielle made three appearances in the DSL in 2019 with no record and one run allowed over four innings.

**HIT PLAY:** Cornielle started the 2021 season with the Brewers Blue affiliate in the Arizona Complex League and was 4-2 in nine games – four starts – with a 4.64 ERA and 50 strikeouts over 33 innings pitched. He was called up to Carolina at the end of the season and was 0-1 in two starts with ten strikeouts in eight innings.

**WEEKLY AWARD:** Cornielle was named the ACL's Pitcher of the Week on September 6, 2021 after his performance against the White Sox on August 31, 2021. He allowed one run on one hit and two walks with six strikeouts over five innings in the game.

**FEELING 2022:** Cornielle was 9-7 in 22 games – 19 starts – with a 3.19 ERA and 124 strikeouts over 101-2/3 innings pitched for the Carolina Mudcats this season before joining the Timber Rattlers on August 23. He was second in the Carolina League in strikeouts and third in the Carolina League in ERA before his promotion to Wisconsin. Cornielle was 1-0 in three starts with Wisconsin and allowed four runs with six walks and 21 strikeouts over 17-1/3 innings pitched.

**LAST APPEARANCE:** Cornielle pitched 2-1/3 innings as a reliever at Quad Cities on [June 29](#). He allowed a run on a hit and two walks with a strikeout in 2-1/3 innings.

**LAST START:** Cornielle had a no decision against Peoria at home on [June 4](#). He allowed a run on three hits with no walks, a hit batsman, and four strikeouts over five innings.

**VS. БЕЛОИТ:** Cornielle made the start at home against the Sky Carp on [April 29](#). He allowed two runs on six hits with a walk and seven strikeouts over 5-1/3 innings.

## БЕЛОИТ SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

**RHP ALEX WILLIAMS:** The Marlins selected Williams in the eleventh round of the 2022 draft out of Stanford.

**THE CARDINAL:** Williams pitched four seasons at Stanford and was 23-8 with a 2.88 ERA in 47 games – 42 starts. He had 211 strikeouts in 237-2/3 innings pitched during his college career.

**TROPHY CASE:** Williams was the Pac-12 Pitcher of the Year and a First Team All-American for Collegiate Baseball and College Baseball Foundation after he went 8-4 with a 3.20 ERA in eighteen starts in helping Stanford win the Pac-12 regular season and tournament championships. Williams had 96 strikeouts over 101-1/3 innings pitched as a senior at Stanford.

**AT THE COMPLEX:** Williams signed with Miami and made two brief starts in for the Florida Complex Marlins without a decision. In five innings, he didn't allow a hit, a walk, or a run while striking out five.

**LAST START:** Williams had a no decision against South Bend at home on [June 28](#). He allowed a run on two hits with two walks and six strikeouts over six innings.

**VS. WISCONSIN:** Williams was the starting pitcher against the Rattlers at Beloit on [April 8](#) and picked up the win. He pitched six shutout innings, allowed three hits, walked two, and struck out seven.
