WEDNESDAY AFTERNOON: [The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers beat the Beloit Sky Carp 3-1 at Neuroscience Group Field.](#)

The Timber Rattlers scored three times in the bottom of the third inning to come back from a 1-0 deficit. Mark Manfredi, Chase Costello, and Tate Kuehner combined for ten strikeouts. The win was the fourth straight for the Wisconsin.

COME ON BACK AGAIN, YA HEAR? Yesterday was the second straight time the Sky Carp scored first only to see the Rattlers take the lead in their next turn at the plate. On Tuesday, the Sky Carp scored a run in the first and the Rattlers scored four times in the bottom of the first. On Wednesday, Beloit scored a run on a two-out single by Johnny Olmstead in the top of the fourth. Wisconsin tied the game on an RBI double by Jadhver Areinamo. The Rattlers took the lead when two runs scored on an error later in the inning.

PUT IT IN PLAY: Wisconsin struck out just six times on Wednesday. The Rattlers have struck out 249 times in 35 games this season. Only two other Minor League teams have struck out less than Wisconsin this season: Spokane (Northwest League – 239 times in 30 games) and Frisco (Texas League – 243 times in 33 games). If you rank the teams by strikeouts per game, the Rattlers are the toughest team to strikeout in MiLB. Wisconsin: 7.11/game

GETTING UP THERE: The Timber Rattlers are eleven games over .500 for the first time since they were 49-38 on July 16, 2022.

SUNNY DAY: The Timber Rattlers are 11-4 in day games this season.

KEEPING THE CLOUDS AWAY: Dating back to last season, the Timber Rattlers have won nine straight games from the Sky Carp. Wisconsin won the final seven games against Beloit in 2023. The Rattlers have won the first two games of this year's series.

ABOUT BELOIT: The Beloit Sky Carp changed their name from Snappers after the 2021 season. This is Beloit's third season as an affiliate of the Miami Marlins. Beloit started as the Beloit Brewers in 1982 as the Midwest League affiliate of Milwaukee. They changed their name to the Beloit Snappers for the 1995 season. The Snappers affiliation with Milwaukee ended after the 2004 season. They were affiliated with the Minnesota Twins (2005-2012) and the Oakland Athletics (2013-2019) over their final seasons in the Midwest League. The Snappers said "Goodbye" to Pohlman Field on July 11, 2021 and moved into ABC Supply Stadium on August 3, 2021. Billy Gardner Jr is in his second season as the manager of the Sky Carp. Prince Fielder, Rickie Weeks, Chris Bosio, Greg Vaughn, Joey Meyer, BJ Surhoff, Tim Dillard, and Mitch Stetter played in Beloit.

ABOUT THE MARLINS: The Florida/Miami Marlins have lots of history in the Midwest League. The Marlins' first Low-A affiliate was the Kane County Cougars from 1993 through 2002. Josh Beckett, Adrian Gonzalez, Dontrelle Willis, Miguel Cabrera, and former Timber Rattlers manager Matt Erickson all played for the Cougars in that timespan. The Marlins returned to the Midwest League in 2019 to affiliate with the Clinton LumberKings. The Marlins landed in Beloit after MLB reset the affiliations for 2021.

PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

RHP WILL RUDY: The Milwaukee Brewers selected Rudy in the fifth round of the 2022 draft out of the California Polytechnic State University, Pomona.

WHAT A SEASON: Rudy was at Cal Poly Pomona for three seasons but had just one full season due to COVID-19 abbreviating 2020 and canceling the 2021 season for the Broncos. In 2022, which was still his freshman season, Rudy went 8-1 with a 3.10 ERA over thirteen starts. He walked fifteen and struck out 96 in 87 innings pitched during that season.

TROPHY ROOM: Rudy was a three-time Pitcher of the Week in the California Collegiate Athletic Association, two-time National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association West Region Pitcher of the Week, a First Team All-CCAA selection, and the CCAA's Most Valuable pitcher last season.

OUR OLD FRIEND FROM POMONA: Rudy was the highest draft selection of a Poly Pomona player since Cody Ponce was picked 55th overall in the 2015 draft. The Brewers also picked Ponce, who pitched for the Timber Rattlers right after the 2015 draft.

THE CAPE: Rudy made one start for Yarmouth-Dennis in the Cape Cod League in 2022 before the draft. He did not pitch in the Brewers system until 2023.

THE MUDCAT: Rudy was 5-3 in eighteen starts for Carolina in 2023 for his professional debut. Rudy had a 3.46 ERA, 26 walks, and 69 strikeouts over 80-2/3 innings.

LAST START: Rudy lost at Quad Cities on [May 9](#). He allowed four runs on six hits with three walks and a strikeout over 4-1/3 innings.

VS. БЕЛОIT: Rudy has never faced the Sky Carp prior to this evening. He has never pitched against an affiliate of the Miami Marlins before tonight.

BELOIT STARTING PITCHER:

LHP CADE GIBSON: Selected in the tenth round of the 2022 draft by the Marlins out of Louisiana Tech.

TECHNICALLY SPEAKING: Gibson was 10-8 with a 5.57 ERA in 42 games – 24 starts – in two seasons at Louisiana Tech. He struck out 159 over 156-2/3 innings pitched in his career. In his final season of college, Gibson went 6-5 with a save and a 4.87 ERA in nineteen games – thirteen starts. Gibson also had 93 strikeouts with nineteen walks in 85 innings in his final season at Louisiana Tech.

GETTING COMPLEX: Gibson started his pro career with the Florida Complex League affiliate of the Marlins in 2022 and allowed one run on four hits with ten strikeouts over seven innings in four games – one start – for no record. He moved up the Florida State League and Jupiter where he was 1-0 in four relief appearances with ten strikeouts over 7-2/3 scoreless innings.

JUPITER RISING: Gibson started the 2023 season in Jupiter and was 2-3 with a 3.12 ERA in seven games – six starts. He walked ten and struck out 33 in 34-2/3 innings pitched. Gibson was promoted to Beloit on May 20, 2023 and was 4-7 with a 5.18 ERA in sixteen games – thirteen starts – for the Sky Carp after the promotion.

LAST START: Gibson had no decision against the Peoria Chiefs at home on [May 9](#). He allowed three runs on seven hits and two walks with four strikeouts over six innings.

VS. WISCONSIN: Gibson made two starts against the Timber Rattlers – [July 9](#) and [September 1](#) – in 2023 with no record. He allowed five runs on twelve hits with seven walks and seven strikeouts over twelve innings in those starts.
