ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Cedar Rapids Kernels beat the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers 4-1 at Rise 2 Greatness Field. Jorel Ortega and Carson McCusker hit solo homers to put the Kernels up 2-0. Cedar Rapids added runs on a fielder's choice in the fifth and a bases-loaded walk in the eighth. Wisconsin broke up the shutout bid when Hendry Mendez drove in a run with a two-out single in the top of the ninth.

DEBUT: Luis Lara, the #9 prospect in the Milwaukee Brewers system, made his first appearance with Wisconsin last night. Lara, who is 18, was the lead-off hitter and starting centerfielder for the Rattlers. He was 1-for-3 with a walk and two stolen bases. Lara has 24 steals in 33 attempts between Carolina and Wisconsin this season.

ON ASSIGNMENT: Jesse Winker went 1-for-3 with a single in the first game of his rehabilitation assignment for the Milwaukee Brewers. He was the starting first baseman in the game, his first appearance at first base in his 1,205 games as a professional.

NICK OF TIME: Wisconsin reliever Nick Merkel walked one and struck out four over two hitless, scoreless innings to keep the Rattlers within striking distance.

TOUGH FINISH: Mendez singled to right with two outs in the ninth with Mike Boeve at third and Joe Gray Jr at first. Boeve scored and Gray took third on the hit to bring the Rattlers to within 4-1. However, Mendez tried to stretch the single into a double and was thrown out by Kala'i Rosario at second for the final out of the game. Rosario has twelve outfield assists in 2023.

ABOUT CEDAR RAPIDS: The current franchise began its existence as the Cedar Rapids Braves, an affiliate of the Milwaukee Braves in the Three-I League, in 1958. That was the same year and league the current Timber Rattlers franchise joined the Three-I League as the Fox Cities Foxes. Both teams moved to the Midwest League when the Three-I League ended after the 1961 season. Cedar Rapids has been called the Braves, Red Raiders, Cardinals, Astros, Giants, and Reds until they became the Kernels in 1993. That was the same year the California Angels became the parent club of the Kernels. That affiliation remained through the 2012 season. Cedar Rapids has been affiliated with the Minnesota Twins since 2013. The Kernels have made the Midwest League playoffs every year they have been affiliated with the Twins, including this year. Notable alumni include Mike Trout, Byron Buxton, Trevor Hoffman, Brewers Pitching Coach Chris Hook, and Ted Simmons.

ABOUT THE TWINS: Minnesota has a long history of in the Midwest League. They started out with Wisconsin Rapids (1964-1983) and moved to Kenosha (1984-1992) and to Fort Wayne (1993-1998) as the franchise moved. Minnesota has also been with Quad Cities (1999-2004) and Beloit (2005-2012) before their current affiliation with Cedar Rapids Kernels started in 2013.

PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES: MLB Pipeline places seven active Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Brock Wilken (#8), Luis Lara (#9), Robert Moore (#17), Mike Boeve (#18), Bradley Blalock (#19), Matthew Wood (#25), and Hendry Mendez (#29). Eric Brown Jr (#12) is currently on Wisconsin's IL. MLB Pipeline has ten active Kernels on their list of Minnesota prospects: Emmanuel Rodriguez (#3), Cory Lewis (#13), CJ Culpepper (#14), Jose Salas (#17), Kala'i Rosario (#19), Noah Miller (#24), Zebby Matthews (#25), Ben Ross (#26), Alejandro Hidalgo (#28), and Noah Cardenas (#30). Connor Prelipp (#6) is currently on the IL.

PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP CAMERON WAGONER: Selected by Milwaukee in the eleventh round of the 2022 draft out of Eastern Michigan University.

EASTERN NOTES: Wagoner did not pitch collegiately in 2022. He made six relief appearances during the abbreviated 2020 season and 18 appearances – three starts – in 2021. He was 2-4 with a 4.42 ERA and 67 strikeouts over 57 innings during his two college seasons.

HOW DID YOU SPEND YOUR SUMMERS? Wagoner played for Greeneville in the Appalachian League in 2021 and was with both Wareham and Cotuit in the Cape Cod League in 2022. He was 2-3 with a 4.97 ERA in nineteen games – two starts – and 57 strikeouts over 38 innings pitched in those summer leagues.

AS A PRO: Wagoner made four appearances – two starts – for the ACL Brewers Gold after signing with Milwaukee. He was 1-0 and had eight strikeouts in eight innings in the ACL.

DOWN UNDER: Wagoner pitched for the Brisbane Bandits of the Australian Baseball League during the Winter of 2022-23. He made ten starts during the regular season of the ABL and was 3-1 with a 3.26 ERA and 43 strikeouts in 47 innings pitched.

LAST APPEARANCE: Wagoner picked up the win in relief against Dayton at home on <u>August 9</u>. He allowed a run on five hits with two walks and five strikeouts over 3-2/3 innings.

LAST START: Wagoner won at South Bend on <u>August 2</u>. He allowed a run on three hits with a walk and seven strikeouts over six innings. Wagoner set a new single-game high as a pro for innings pitched in the game at South Bend

VS. CEDAR RAPIDS: Wagoner is 0-1 in two starts against the Kernels this season. He lost at Cedar Rapids on May 26 and had a no decision at home on July 26. Wagoner has allowed eight runs – seven earned – on eleven hits with four walks and five strikeouts over 4-1/3 innings in his two starts against Cedar Rapids in 2023.

CEDAR RAPIDS SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP CHRISTIAN MACLEOD: The Twins selected MacLeod in the fifth round of the 2021 draft out of Mississippi State. .

TWO YEARS IN STARKVILLE: MacLeod was 4-0 in four starts with a 0.86 ERA during the abbreviated 2020 season with the Bulldogs. He went 6-6 in nineteen starts in 2021. In his time at Mississippi State, MacLeod had 148 strikeouts over 103-2/3 innings pitched.

THOSE TWO TIMES IN OMAHA: MacLeod was the starting pitcher twice in the 2021 College World Series. He allowed four runs on five hits in 1-1/3 innings against Virginia on June 22, 2021 and six runs on two hits in 2/3 of an inning against Vanderbilt on June 28, 2021.

THERE CAN BE ONLY ONE: MacLeod made one appearance in the Florida Complex League after signing with the Twins. He allowed one hit, walked two, and struck out five over 1-2/3 innings. He would undergo Tommy John Surgery in March of 2022 and missed the entire 2022 season.

BACK AT IT: MacLeod has made two starts for Fort Myers in the Florida State League before joining the Kernels today. He had no record and allowed two runs on one hit with six walks and eight strikeouts in 5-1/3 innings pitched with the Mighty Mussels.

LAST START: MacLeod won at Quad Cities on <u>August 10</u>. He allowed three runs on five hits with three walks, a hit batsman, and four strikeouts over five innings. MacLeod also allowed two homers in the game but won his third straight start.

VS. WISCONSIN: MacLeod is 1-0 in two starts against Wisconsin This season. He had a no decision against the Timber Rattlers in Cedar Rapids on May 28 and beat the Rattlers in Wisconsin on July 29. He has allowed six runs on eight hits with two walks and four strikeouts over six innings against Wisconsin. Joe Gray Jr hit a three-run homer off MacLeod in the first inning on May 28 and a two-run homer off MacLeod on July 29.
