ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Cedar Rapids Kernels beat the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers 4-2 in ten innings. Alex Isola, who had three hits and three RBI in the game, hit a two-run, walk-off homer in the bottom of the tenth. INTO THE LEAD: Cedar Rapids had a 1-0 lead after an RBI single by Isola in the third inning. Wisconsin took a 2-1 lead in the top of the fourth inning. Felix Valerio drove in the tying run with a bases-loaded walk. Carlos Rodríguez followed with an RBI single.

SOUNDS OF SILENCE: Wisconsin did not have another hit in the game after the single by Rodríguez in the fourth. They were held to two hits last night. Joey Wiemer's lead-off single in the fourth was the only other hit for Wisconsin.

SIX-PACK: Wiemer is on a six-game hitting streak. He was held hitless in his first game with Wisconsin and has gone 10-for-22 in his last six games.

WHAT IS HEARTBREAK? The Timber Rattlers are 1-6 in extra innings this season. Last night was the sixth time Wisconsin has lost on a walkoff this season. Tuesday's game was the twelfth time Wisconsin has lost to the Kernels on a walkoff since 1995 and the third time they have lost on a walkoff homer to the Kernels.

ABOUT CEDAR RAPIDS: The Cedar Rapids Kernels are charter members of the High-A Central League. The current franchise began its existence as the Cedar Rapids Braves, an affiliate of the Milwaukee Braves in the Three-I League in 1958. That was the same year and league the current Timber Rattlers franchise joined the Three-I League as the Fox Cities Foxes. Both teams moved to the Midwest League when the Three-I League ended after the 1961 season. Cedar Rapids has been called the Braves, Red Raiders, Cardinals, Astros, Giants, and Reds until they became the Kernels in 1993. That was the same year the California Angels became the parent club of the Kernels. That affiliation remained through the 2012 season. Cedar Rapids has been affiliated with the Minnesota Twins since 2013. The Kernels made the Midwest League playoffs every year they were affiliated with the Twins. Notable alumni include Mike Trout, Byron Buxton, Trevor Hoffman, and Ted Simmons.

ABOUT THE TWINS: Minnesota's former High-A Affiliate was the Fort Myers Miracle in the Florida State League. From 1995 through 2019, the Twins were affiliated with four teams in the Midwest League. They were with the Fort Wayne Wizards (1995-1998), Quad City River Bandits (1999-2005), Beloit Snappers (2006-2012), and Cedar Rapids Kernels (2013-2019)

PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES: MLB Pipeline puts four Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Zavier Warren (#11), Carlos Rodríguez (#14), Nick Kahle (#19), and Joe Gray Jr. (#30). MLB Pipeline has six Kernels on their list of Twins prospects: Matt Canterino (#7), Matt Wallner (#12), Wander Javier (#21), Seth Gray (#24), and Yunior Severino (#28), and Louie Varland (#30). Blayne Enlow (#11) and Luis Rijo (#25) are currently on the Kernels injured list.

PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP VICTOR CASTAÑEDA: The Brewers signed Castañeda as a Minor League Free Agent off the reserve list of Toros de Tijuana from the Mexican League on July 4, 2017.

TORO! TORO! Castañeda was 3-1 with a 3.00 ERA over nine games – four starts – for Tijuana in 2017 as an 18-year-old.

FROM MEXICO TO MONTANA: Castañeda was 2-6 with a 5.13 ERA in fourteen games – eight starts for Helena in the Pioneer League in 2018. He walked fifteen and struck out 40 in 47-1/3 innings pitched last season.

WELCOME TO WISCONSIN: Castañeda was 4-2 with six saves in 32 appearance – one start – with Wisconsin in 2019. Castañeda walked 14 and struck out 53 in 44 innings pitched during that season.

THE SEASON WAS NOT OVER: Castañeda was assigned to the Glendale Desert Dogs for the 2019 Arizona Fall League by the Brewers at the end of the Wisconsin season. He was 3-1 with a 1.99 ERA, six walks, and 29 strikeouts over 22-2/3 innings pitched in six games – five starts – for the Desert Dogs. Castañeda was named the AFL Pitcher of the Wek on September 25, 2019.

AWARD WINNING: Castañeda was named the High-A Central League Pitcher of the Week on May 31 for his performance at Cedar Rapids on May 28. He allowed two hits, walked one, and struck out eight over 6-2/3 scoreless innings in the game. He was also named he Milwaukee Brewers Minor League Pitcher of the Month for July. Castañeda was 2-2 with a 2.45 ERA and 36 strikeouts in 25-2/3 innings over five starts in July.

LAST START: Castañeda lost to <u>Great Lakes at home on August 12</u>. He allowed five runs on five hits with two walks and seven strikeouts over five innings.

VS. CEDAR RAPIDS (2021): Castañeda has made two starts against the Kernels this season. He has allowed three runs on eight hits with three walks and sixteen strikeouts over 12-1/3 innings. Castañeda does not have a decision in either start against Cedar Rapids this year.

CEDAR RAPIDS SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP LOUIE VARLAND: The Minnesota Twins selected Varland in the 15th round of the 2019 draft out of Concordia-St. Paul University.

THE PITCHER WAS A SAINT: Varland pitched three year at Concordia-St. Paul. He was 10-6 with a save and a 2.73 ERA in 26 games – 15 starts – and had 131 strikeouts over 115-1/3 innings during his career. In his final collegiate season, Varland was 4-5 with a 3.58 ERA and 68 strikeouts over 55-1/3 innings in nine starts

ALL IN THE FAMILY: Gus Varland, Louie's brother, is in the Los Angeles Dodgers system. Gus Varland was originally in the Oakland system and pitched for the Beloit Snappers in 2018. He is currently with the Tulsa Drillers, the Double-A affiliate of the Dodgers

WHERE'S WILLMAR? Louie Varland pitched two seasons (2017 & 2018) for the Willmar Stingers in the Northwoods League pitched as a freshman at the University of Maryland-Baltimore County and went to Chesapeake College for his sophomore season before transferring to Georgia Southern.

E-TOWN: Varland pitched three times – once as a starter – for the Elizabethton Twins, Minnesota's Appalachian League affiliate, after signing in 2019. He was 0-1 with a 2.08 ERA with four walks and ten strikeouts over 8-2/3 innings pitched.

SHOW SOME MUSSEL: Varland started the 2021 season with the Fort Myers Mighty Mussels and was 4-2 with a 2.09 ERA and 76 strikeouts over 47-1/3 innings in ten games – eight starts.

LAST START: Varland won <u>at Peoria on August 12</u>. He allowed three runs on three hits with a walk and seven strikeouts over five innings.

VS. WISCONSIN: Varland was the winning pitcher <u>at Wisconsin on July 27</u>. He allowed three hits, walked three, and struck out three over five scoreless innings.
