DURHAM BULLS [35-17] AT GWINNETT STRIPERS [23-29]

RHP JOE RYAN [3-3, 3.73] vs. RHP JASSEEL DE LA CRUZ [0-2, 6.16]

TODAY'S GAME

After clinching a series victory with last night's walk-off win, Durham looks to earn their 5th triumph of the series in this evening's series finale. RHP Joe Ryan (3-3, 3.73) is expected to toe the rubber for the Bulls, while RHP Jasseel De La Cruz (0-2, 6.16) is anticipated to get the nod for the Stripers.

LAST TIME OUT

The Bulls walked off with a 6-5 extra-inning win over the Stripers last night thanks to 3B Kevin Padlo's game-winning RBI single in the 10th. 1B Dalton Kelly & DH Mike Ford also bashed back-to-back home runs in the 2nd frame, with Kelly (2-4, R, HR, RBI) joined by 2B Vidal Brujan (2-4, BB) & CF Josh Lowe (2-4, R, 2 RBI, BB) in posting multi-hit efforts. Durham starter Shane Baz (5.0 IP, 2 H, R, ER, 3 BB, 8 K) fanned 8 batters, though he did not factor in the final decisions. Reliever Joey Krehbiel (1.0 IP, H, R, 0 ER, K) earned the victory while Gwinnett reliever Jacob Webb (1.2 IP, 2 H, 2 R, ER, BB, 3 K) suffered the defeat.

BULLS vs. STRIPERS

Durham & Gwinnett meet for the 1st time in 2021 at Durham Bulls Athletic Park. The 2 teams last faced off at the end of the 2019 regular season between 8/30-9/2, resulting in a 2-2 series split. Overall the Bulls recorded a 14-13 mark versus Gwinnett in the 2019 season series, including an 8-7 clip at home. INF Kevin Padlo is the other Durham player on the active roster to have faced the Stripers last season with the Bulls, batting .200 (5-25) with 1 homer & 4 RBI in 7 games, while RHP Phoenix Sanders is the only pitcher, appearing in 1 game versus Gwinnett, firing a scoreless inning.

FIRST PLACE BULLS

The Bulls have been alone or tied at the top of the divisional standings for 34 of 61 days this season. Durham's 35 victories are also the most of any Triple-A squad this season entering play today. The Bulls also have more wins than 5 MLB teams, including Minnesota (33-48), Texas (33-50), Pittsburgh (29-53), Baltimore (27-56) & Arizona (23-62).

BULL-ET POINTS

- OF Nathan Lukes has hit .444 (16-36) when batting with runners in scoring position this year.
INF/OF Vidal Brujan's 14 steals this year rank T-1st among all Triple-A players.
OF Josh Lowe enters play today T-4th among Triple-A East hitters in hits (51) & extra-base hits (24), as well as 5th in doubles (14), T-8th in steals (11) & 9th in total bases (94).
Bulls pitchers have struck out 10 or more batters in 39 of their 52 games this season.
Durham owns a 4-9 mark when scoring 3 or fewer runs, compared to a 31-8 clip when scoring 4 or more runs.
7 different Bulls pitchers have combined to record Durham's 12 saves this year.
Durham has homered in 41 of their 52 games this season, including 12 of their last 15 tilts.
16 different Bulls batters have gone deep this year.

IT'S A WALK-OFF!

Last night's walk-off win marked the 4th time this year the Bulls have won in walk-off fashion, and 1st occasion against a team other than Charlotte. Durham's last walk-off win prior to last night came via OF Josh Lowe's game-winning home run in the 9th inning of a 3-2 win on 6/10 versus Charlotte. The Bulls' last walk-off win in extra innings was on 5/19 versus Charlotte courtesy of Lowe's 10th-inning game-winning sacrifice fly.

CLOSE CONTESTS

Following last night's victory, the Bulls improved to 11-8 in 1-run ballgames, including a 7-5 clip at Durham Bulls Athletic Park. 5 of Durham's last 9 contests have been decided by just 1 run dating back to 6/24, with the Bulls posting a 2-3 mark in those tilts. Nashville (13-7) is the only Triple-A squad with more 1-run victories in 2021 than Durham.

BACK JACK, DO IT AGAIN

INFs Dalton Kelly & Mike Ford bashed back-to-back home runs last night, marking the 1st time the Bulls have hit big flies in consecutive at-bats since the 2019 campaign. The last time Durham accomplished that feat was on 8/1/19 at Charlotte, when C Michael Perez & INF Kevin Padlo hit back-to-back jacks. The last time the Bulls hit home runs in consecutive at-bats at home was on 7/12/19 vs. Norfolk.

SEVEN FOR SULLY

C Brett Sullivan enters play today with a 7-game hit streak, batting .380 (10-24) with 5 runs, 2 doubles, 2 homers & 6 RBI dating back to 6/24. That 7-game hit streak is the longest active hit streak by a Bulls player. Sullivan has raised his batting average 36 points during his streak from .204 to .240.

CAN'T TOUCH THIS

Durham pitchers enter play today leading all Triple-A clubs in strikeouts (560) & WHIP (1.13). Fellow Rays affiliate Low-A Charleston (1.12) is the only full-season MiLB club with a lower WHIP than the Bulls, while Rays High-A affiliate Bowling Green (1.13) is tied with Durham for the 2nd-lowest WHIP among full-season MiLB teams.

OH WHAT A RELIEF IT IS

Durham relief pitchers this year have combined for a 3.01 ERA (86 ER/257.0 IP) & 1.13 WHIP, both of which rank 2nd among all Triple-A teams. The Bulls bullpen has also recorded 309 strikeouts in 2021, the 3rd-most at the Triple-A level.

WHAT A DIFFERENCE

Durham enters play today with a +110 run differential, which ranks 4th-highest overall among MiLB squads this year. Only High-A Everett (+145), Low-A Delmarva (+139), & Low-A Tampa (+134) have a larger run differential than the Bulls. Durham has finished with a run differential of more than 100 in 2 of their last 3 seasons in 2018 (+108) & 2017 (+119).

**LAST TIME OUT:** Ryan earned his 3rd victory of the year on 6/29 versus Gwinnett in the series opener, firing a season-high 5.1 frames while matching a season-high with 9 strikeouts, yielding 1 earned run on 2 hits. Ryan tied a season-high with 83 pitches (55 strikes) in the Bulls' 8-3 win over the Stripers.

**USA! USA!** Ryan on Friday was named to the U.S. Olympic Team roster as announced by USA Baseball, joining fellow Bulls RHP Shane Baz for the 2020 Olympic Games in Tokyo. Ryan also pitched for Team USA in the Olympic Qualifier Round in June. Team USA will also play a tune up game at the DBAP versus the Collegiate National Team on Monday, July 19 at 6:35pm. The U.S. Olympic Team begins the Olympic Games baseball tournament on Friday, July 30 versus Israel.

**2021 SEASON:** Earned the win in Triple-A debut on 5/5 at Memphis. Placed on Temporary Inactive List on 5/30 to pitch for Team USA Olympic Qualifying Team. Activated from Temporary Inactive List on 6/11.

**2020 SEASON:** Was part of the Rays 60-man player pool, spending the summer at the alternate training site in Port Charlotte. Ranked by Baseball America as the No. 12 prospect in the Rays system following the season.

**2019 SEASON:** Named Rays Minor League Pitcher of the Year by the Rays Baseball Operations department after combining for a 9-4 record and 1.96 ERA (123.2 IP) with 183 strikeouts in 24 appearances (22 starts) between Bowling Green (A), Charlotte (A+) and Montgomery (AA). Yielded 3 runs or fewer in all but 1 of his 24 appearances, 2 runs or fewer 19 times and 1 run or fewer 14 times. Finished 5th among Rays minor leaguers in ERA (min. 50 IP).

**K-TIME:** Ryan finished the 2019 season ranked 2nd among all minor league pitchers with 183 strikeouts. Only Royals prospect Kris Bubic (185) fanned more hitters than Ryan. Those 183 punchouts also ranked 3rd all-time for a Rays minor leaguer behind Matt Moore in 2011 (210) and 2010 (208). Ryan also finished T-6th in the Florida State League in strikeouts despite only throwing 82.2 innings.

**YOU'RE THE BEST! AROUND!** Ryan earned Rays Minor League Pitcher of the Year honors following the 2019 campaign. He also was named the organization's Pitcher of the Month for both July and August, going 2-0 with a 1.49 ERA (48.1 IP) and 75 strikeouts in 9 starts in that stretch. Ryan was also named an Organizational All-Star by MLB.com following the 2019 season, in addition to being tabbed the No. 10 prospect in the Florida State League by Baseball America.

**2018 SEASON:** Began his pro career with Hudson Valley (SS), posting a 2-1 record and 3.72 ERA (36.1 IP) in 12 outings (7 starts). Combined for 23 strikeouts in 13 innings over his final 3 starts of the year.

**COLLEGE:** Went 8-1 with a 1.65 ERA (98.1 IP) in 14 starts as a senior at California State University Stanislaus and led all of collegiate baseball with 127 strikeouts. Pitched 3 seasons at Cal State Northridge before transferring to Cal State Stanislaus.

**MISCELLANEOUS:** Previously selected by San Francisco in the 39th round of the 2014 MLB Draft out of Sir Francis Drake High School (CA) but did not sign.
