ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers beat the South Bend Cubs 5-2 at Neuroscience Group Field. Carlos Rodríguez allowed one run on four hits over six innings as Wisconsin's starting pitcher and picked up the win. James Meeker got the final three outs for his tenth save of the season.

QUALITY IS JOB ONE...AGAIN: Rodríguez followed Justin Jarvis's quality start on Wednesday with his own quality start last night. Rodríguez picked up a win in his home debut as he pitched around three walks and a hit batsman over his six innings. Wisconsin pitchers have four quality starts in nine games this month.

MY SACRIFICE: The Timber Rattlers scored three runs on sacrifice flies on Thursday. Jose Acosta tied the game with a sacrifice fly in the bottom of the fourth. Wisconsin added insurance runs to go ahead 4-1 on back-to-back sacrifice flies by Jackson Chourio and Zavier Warren in the seventh inning. The Timber Rattlers have 36 sacrifice flies this season. They are second in the Midwest League in that category. West Michigan leads the league with 37 sacrifice flies.

**LEADING OFF:** Darrien Miller reached base on a walk, a hit batsman, and a double in four plate appearances last night. He has been on base seven times in nine plate appearances in two games as Wisconsin's lead-off hitter in the lineup.

PAIN DON'T HURT: Miller has been hit by pitches 17 times this season. He is third in the Midwest League in that category. Ben Malgeri (West Michigan – 20) and Eddys Leonard (Great Lakes – 19) are the top two in the Midwest League in getting hit by pitches this

ABOUT SOUTH BEND: The South Bend Cubs started as the South Bend White Sox when the Midwest League added them as an expansion team in 1988. They changed their name to the Silver Hawks for the 1994 season and became an affiliate of the Arizona Diamondbacks in 1997. South Bend became an affiliate of the Chicago Cubs in 2015. South Bend won Midwest League pennants in 1989, 1993, 2005, and 2019. Notable alumni for the South Bend franchise include Mike Cameron, Jose Valverde, Chris Capuano, Mark Reynolds, Justin Upton, Wade Miley, Chase Anderson, Keon Broxton, Gleyber Torres, Ian Happ, and Carlos Gonzalez. Terry Francona was the manager of the South Bend White Sox in 1982.

ABOUT THE CUBS: The Chicago Cubs had several different Midwest League affiliates before settling in South Bend in 2015. They were affiliated with Quincy from 1965 through 1973 before leaving the Midwest League. The Cubs returned to the MWL with an affiliation with Quad Cities from 1979 through 1984, Peoria from 1985 through 1994 and again from 2005 through 2012, Rockford from 1995 through 1998, Lansing from 1999 through 2004, Kane County in 2013 and 2014.

SEASON SO FAR: South Bend finished the first half 34-32. They stumbled to the line as they dropped nine out of twelve games to start June. The Cubs put together a tengame winning streak as they won the final two games of the first half and the first eight games of the second half and they have ridden that the Western Division lead in the second half standings heading into this series with Wisconsin

PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES: <u>MLB Pipeline</u> puts six active Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Jackson Chourio (#1), Jeferson Quero (#6), Eduardo García (#14), Joe Gray Jr. (#15), Zavier Warren (#18), and Taylor Floyd (#24). Tyler Black (#7), Russell Smith (#17), and Carlos Rodríguez (#22) are on the Wisconsin injured list. <u>MLB Pipeline</u> has eight current South Bend players on their Top 30 list of Chicago Cubs prospects: Peter Crow-Armstrong (#3), Owen Cassie (#9), Kohl Franklin (#14), Kevin Made (#17), Yohendrick Pinango (#21), Pablo Aliendo (#22), Jordan Nwogu (#24), and Daniel Palencia (#26).

# PITCHING MATCHUP

#### WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP ZACH MORT: Signed with Milwaukee as a Minor League Free Agent on January 14, 2021.

ORIGIN STORY: Mort was drafted by the Chicago Cubs in the 8th round of the 2018 draft out of George Mason University.

PATRIOTIC DUTY: Mort appeared in 57 games - 28 starts - over three seasons at George Mason. He went 12-12 with nine saves and a 3.72 ERA and 205 strikeouts over 227-1/3 innings pitched during his collegiate career.

IN THE CUBS DEN: Mort spent two seasons (2018 and 2019) in the Cubs organization after signing with them. He made ten relief appearances (0-4, 5.79) with the Eugene Emeralds in 2018. In 2019, Mort was 3-3 with a 3.72 ERA in Eugene and 6-2 with a 3.13 ERA for South Bend.

POSTSEASON: Mort was the winning pitcher in Game One of the Midwest League Championship Series against the Clinton LumberKings on September 11, 2019. Mort went three scoreless innings, allowed one hit and two walks with four strikeouts as a reliever. The South Bend Cubs went on to sweep the best-of-five series from Clinton.

LAST SEASON: Mort started 2021 with the Timber Rattlers and was 1-4 in sixteen games – thirteen starts. He was moved to Carolina in August and was 4-1 in six starts for the Mudcats. Mort had a 6.22 ERA and 101 strikeouts over 97 innings pitched between the two levels last year.

LAST START: Mort picked up the win at Quad Cities on August 6. He allowed two runs on four hits with no walks and five strikeouts over six

VS. SOUTH BEND (2022): Mort has made two appearances - one start against the Cubs this season. He is 1-0 with a save and has allowed two runs on eight hits with a walk and six strikeouts over eight innings versus South Bend. Mort earned a three-inning save on May 21 at home and pitched five shutout innings in a start at South Bend on July 9.

#### SOUTH BEND STARTING PITCHER:

RHP KOHL FRANKLIN: The Chicago Cubs selected Franklin in the sixth round of the 2018 draft out of Broken Arrow (OK) High School. MLB Pipeline ranks Franklin as the #12 prospect in the Cubs system. Baseball America rates Franklin at #21 in their in-season update of Cubs prospects.

SOONER GO PRO: Franklin turned down college baseball for the University of Oklahoma to sign with the Cubs. He was the only high school player from Oklahoma to be picked in the 2018 draft.

IT'S ALL RELATIVE: Former Major League pitcher Ryan Franklin is Kohl Franklin's uncle. Ryan Franklin pitched for the Appleton Foxes in 1994.

STARTING OUT: Franklin started his professional career in the Arizona League with the Cubs #2 affiliate in 2018. In 2019, he made ten starts for the Eugene Emeralds of the Northwoods League and one start with South Bend in the Midwest League.

MISSING OUT: Franklin did not pitch in 2020 due to the shutdown. He also missed the 2021 season due to oblique and shoulder issues.

LAST START: Franklin had a no decision at Fort Wayne on August 6. He allowed three runs on two hits and five walks with three strikeouts over three

VS. WISCONSIN: Franklin has two no decisions in two starts - May 22 and July 7 – against the Timber Rattlers this season. He has allowed seven runs - five earned - on seven hits with three walks and eight strikeouts over 6-1/3 innings versus Wisconsin this season.
