SUNDAY IN THE PARK: The Cedar Rapids Kernels beat the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers 8-1 at Veterans Memorial Stadium. Kaelen Culpepper hit a three-run home run in the fifth inning to break a 1-1 tie. Culpepper added a two-run single in the bottom of the eighth for five RBI on the afternoon.

SCAPING FOR A RUN: Wisconsin trailed 1-0 after Danny De Andrade hit a solo home run in the bottom of the second off Manuel Rodriguez. Hedbert Pérez drew a walk and stole second in the top of the fifth. He moved to third on a bloop single to center by Jheremy Vargas. Daniel Guilarte drove in Pérez with a sacrifice fly to tie the game.

COULDN'T GET OUT OF IT: Dikember Sánchez walked the lead-off batter in the bottom of the fifth and followed that with a 6-4-3 double play. However, a single and a walk brough Culpepper to the plate to hit the go-ahead homer moments later.

MAN, WELL! Manuel Rodriguez allowed one run on two hits with no walks in four innings on Sunday for a no decision. In five starts this season, Rodriguez has allowed more than one run once. He is tied for the Midwest League lead in innings (25) and tied for fourth in the league in strikeouts (25).

NICE SERIES: Pérez was 6-for-21 with a double, a triple, two homers, three walks, five RBI, and six runs scored in Cedar Rapids last week.

STARTING TO HEAT UP: Blake Burke was 2-for-4 on Sunday with a single and a double. In his last four games, Burke went 7-for-16 with two doubles and two walks to raise his average from .226 to .275

SPLITSVILLE: Wisconsin had a chance to win their first series of the season with a victory on Sunday. The loss allowed them to get out of Cedar Rapids with a split. The Rattlers are 0-2 with two splits in their first four series of 2025.

ABOUT WEST MICHIGAN: The West Michigan Whitecaps joined the Midwest League in 1994 when the Madison Muskies moved to Comstock Park, Michigan following the 1993 season. The Whitecaps started play in the league as an affiliate of the Oakland Athletics. They became Low-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers for the 1997 season. The Whitecaps have won six Midwest League Pennants - 1996, 1998, 2004, 2006, 2007, and 2015. Notable former Whitecaps include Nick Castellanos, Joel Zumaya, Fernando Rodney, Francisco Cordero, Brandon Inge, Cameron Maybin, Alex Avila, and Willy Adames.

ABOUT THE TIGERS: Detroit has been affiliated with the Whitecaps since 1997. The Tigers had just one other stint in the Midwest League prior to their current partnership. They were with the Clinton Pilots from 1971 through 1975.

PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES: MLB Pipeline places five active Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Bishop Letson (#14), Blake Burke (#16), Jadher Areinamo (#23), Juan Baez (#26), and Manuel Rodriguez (#29). ## PITCHING MATCHUP

#### WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

RHP RYAN BIRCHARD: The Milwaukee Brewers selected Birchard in the 5<sup>th</sup> round of the 2023 draft out of the Niagara County Community College.

PLAYER OF THE YEAR: Birchard was name the Western New York Athletic Conference Player of the Year in 2023. He was 8-0 in ten games – nine starts – with a 1.08 ERA and 95 strikeouts over fifty innings pitched. Birchard was also named a First Team All-NJCAA Division III All-American in 2023.

**QUICK TRIP TO TRENTON:** Birchard made four appearances – two starts – for Trenton in the MLB Draft League after the end of his college season. He allowed one run, walked one, and struck out sixteen over nine innings before signing with Milwaukee.

**DELAYED START:** Birchard did not pitch professionally in 2023. He made a start for the Carolina Mudcats on April 6, 2024 (4.0IP, H, R, 0ER, 2BB, 6K) but was placed on the IL after that game. He next pitched with the ACL Brewers on July 16 and July 22. Birchard rejoined Carolina for appearances on July 28 and August 3 before being sent to Wisconsin on August 13.

AS A RATTLER (2024): Birchard made five regular season starts for Wisconsin last season. He was 0-3 with an 8.71 ERA. He walked fourteen and struck out thirteen in 10-1/3 innings with the Timber Rattlers

**LAST START:** Birchard lost at Cedar Rapids on April 23. He allowed a run on three hits with a walk and five strikeouts over five innings.

**VS. WEST MICHIGAN:** Birchard has never pitched against the Whitecaps prior to this evening. Tonight is also the first time he will face an affiliate of the Detroit Tigers.

#### WEST MICHIGAN STARTING PITCHER:

RHP MAX ALBA: The Tigers signed Alba as a non-drafted free agent out of Liberty University on July 26, 2022.

**COMING HOME:** Alba is a Wisconsin native. He graduated from Franklin High School in 2018 and was drafted by the Los Angeles Angels in the 39<sup>th</sup> round of that year's draft.

**THE LONG WAY AROUND:** Alba pitched at the University of North Carolina in 2020 and 2021. He also pitched for Wilmington in the Coastal Plain League (2021), Liberty University (2022), Wilmington again (2022), and West Virginia of the MLB Draft League (2022).

WITH THE CAPS: Alba was a member of the Whitecaps in 2024. He was 3-4 with four saves and a 3.61 ERA in 39 games – four starts. Alba walked eight and struck out 63 over 57-1/3 innings with West Michigan.

**LAST START:** Alba had a no decision against South Bend at home on April 17. He allowed a run on a hit with a walk and two strikeouts over four innings.

VS. WISCONSIN: Alba made five relief appearances against the Timber Rattlers in 2024. He had no record with a save. Alba allowed two hits, struck out three, and allowed two hits over 5-1/3 scoreless innings against Wisconsin last year.
