WEDNESDAY AFTERNOON: [The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers beat the Peoria Chiefs 5-1 at Neuroscience Group Field in a rain-shortened game.](#)

Brandon Woodruff pitched seven innings, allowed one unearned run, walked none, and struck out six for the win. The tarp went on the field after Woodruff recorded the final out of the top of the seventh inning and the game was called thirty minutes later.

ASSIGNMENT: WISCONSIN (PT III): Woodruff needed 74 pitches (with 52 strikes) to cover his seven innings yesterday. He gave up his first hit with one out in the top of the fourth inning and picked off that runner. In the sixth inning, he allowed a lead-off single but only needed four pitches to get his three outs in the frame. Woodruff went 2-1 in three rehab starts with Wisconsin.

BACK-AND-FORTH: Wisconsin took a 1-0 lead on a sacrifice fly by Marco Dinges in the bottom of the fourth. Peoria tied the game on a throwing error by Daniel Guilarte in the top of the fifth. Guilarte gave Wisconsin the lead back in the bottom of the fifth with an RBI single.

LIKE A GOOD NEIGHBOR: The Timber Rattlers extended their 2-1 lead with three insurance runs in the bottom of the sixth inning. Juan Baez had an RBI single, and Tayden Hall had a two-run double to give the Rattlers a 5-1 win.

DOUBLE UP ON OFFENSE: Hall had two doubles yesterday, scored a run, and drove in two. He has two games with two doubles this season.

DOUBLE UP ON DEFENSE: Wisconsin turned a double play in the top of the sixth inning. It was their 46th double play of the season. The Rattlers lead the Midwest League in double plays. Wisconsin is third in the High-A Classification of Minor League baseball with the Everett AquaSox (54) and Hillsboro Hops (45) of the Northwest League getting more twin killings in 2025.

GIVE ME FIVE: Wisconsin is 12-3 when scoring five or more runs in a game this season.

ABOUT PEORIA: The Peoria Chiefs were in the Three-I League from 1953-1958 before the team folded. They were a St. Louis Cardinals affiliate from 1953-1957 and a New York Yankees affiliate in 1958. The Chiefs re-entered organized baseball when the Danville franchise moved to Peoria after the 1982 season. They were named the Peoria Suns and were affiliated with the California Angels for 1983 and 1984 with a change to the Chiefs nickname for 1984 followed by an affiliation switch to the Chicago Cubs for the 1985 season. Peoria became the Cardinals Midwest League affiliate for the first time in 1995, switched back to the Cubs in 2005, and went back to the Cardinals in 2013. The Chiefs won a Midwest League title in 2002. They made the Midwest League Championship Series in 2018 but lost to Bowling Green. Patrick Anderson is in his third year as Peoria's manager. Notable former Chiefs include Greg Maddux, Mark Grace, Albert Pujols, Yadier Molina, Nolan Gorman, and Victor Scott II.

ABOUT THE CARDINALS: St. Louis had several different Midwest League affiliates before settling back in Peoria in 2013. They were in Cedar Rapids from 1965-1972 before leaving the league until returning to the league to affiliate with the Springfield, Illinois team from 1982 through 1993. St. Louis spent one year with the Madison Hatters before their first affiliation with Peoria from 1995 through 2004. The Cardinals left Peoria for Quad Cities from 2005 through 2012.

PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

RHP TYSON HARDIN: The Milwaukee Brewers selected Hardin in the 12th round of the 2024 draft out of Mississippi State University.

BULLDOG: Hardin was 3-3 and two saves with a 6.59 ERA and 61 strikeouts over 56 innings in forty games – two starts – at Mississippi State.

DAYTONA 500: Hardin pitched two seasons at Daytona State College (2021 and 2022). He was the team's pitcher of the year as a freshman and was 8-5 with two saves in 38 appearances – fifteen starts – at DSC.

BREAKING OUT: Hardin worked two innings in Milwaukee's 2025 Spring Breakout Game against the Cincinnati Reds on [March 16](#). He allowed one hit and struck out three without a walk in two scoreless innings.

AWARD WINNING APRIL: Hardin was named Milwaukee's Minor League Pitcher of the Month for April. He was 2-0 with a 0.96 ERA with four walks and 20 strikeouts over 18-2/3 innings.

WHAT A WEEK: Hardin was named the Midwest League's Pitcher of the Week on May 19 for his seven-inning, complete-game, two-hit shutout against Beloit on May 16.

LAST START: Hardin won at South Bend on [May 22](#). He allowed one run on six hits with no walks and eight strikeouts over six innings. Hardin has made four straight quality starts and extended his streak of not walking a batter to 28-1/3 innings

VS. PEORIA: Hardin lost to Peoria at Dozer Park on [May 9](#). He allowed four runs – three earned – on nine hits with no walks and five strikeouts over six innings.

PEORIA STARTING PITCHER:

RHP GERARDO SALAS: The St. Louis Cardinals signed Saladin as an International Free Agent out of Mexico on July 2, 2019.

LEVELING UP: Salas has pitched in the Dominican Summer League (2021 and 2022), Florida Complex League (2023), and Florida State League (2023 and 2024) before joining the Chiefs in 2025. He was 9-5 with a 2.62 ERA in 22 starts for the Palm Beach Cardinals last year. Salas walked 25 and struck out 119 in 113-1/3 innings pitched last year.

WINTER WORK: Salas has pitched for Sultanes de Monterrey of the Mexican Pacific League for the past three seasons. He is 1-8 with a 4.67 ERA over 17 games – 15 starts – for Monterrey.

LAST START: Salas had a no decision against Dayton at home on [May 23](#). He allowed three runs on four hits with two walks and six strikeouts over four innings.

VS. WISCONSIN: Salas beat Wisconsin at Dozer Park on [May 10](#). He allowed a run on three hits with two walks and four strikeouts over five innings.
