ABOUT LAST NIGHT: [The Great Lakes Loons beat the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers 7-3 at Neuroscience Group Field.](#) Kyle Nevin hit a two-out, two-run home run in the top of the first inning to give the Loons a 2-0 lead. Great Lakes added two runs in the fifth and two more in the sixth to go up 6-0. The Loons have a 3-1 lead in the series.

ON A ROLL: Wisconsin's Ryan Fitzpatrick made his first start of the season in last night's game. He retired ten batters in a row and struck out four after the home run by Nevin in the first inning. The Loons put the first three batters of the fifth inning on base against Fitzpatrick to end his night.

NEVER GIVE UP, NEVER SURRENDER: Dylan O'Rae and Luis Lara singled to start the Wisconsin eighth inning to put runners at the corners. The Rattlers scored a run when Gregory Barrios grounded into a double play. The Rattlers loaded the bases on three straight walks to start the ninth and scored two runs.

IT HASN'T HAPPENED YET: The Rattlers avoided the shutout with their late runs. Wisconsin has not been shutout through the first 25 games of the season. This is the longest the Rattlers have gone without being shutout to start the season since the 2018 team was shutout in the 45th game of the season.

LOOK OUT! Luke Adams was hit by a pitch in the second inning last night. Adams has been hit by a pitch eight times this season. He leads the Midwest League in that category. Adams is third in Minor League Baseball in being hit by a pitch. Tim Locastro of El Paso and Braiden Ward of Spokane are tied for the Minor League lead in hit batsmen with nine.

JUST PUTTING IT OUT THERE: The Timber Rattlers record for hit batsmen in a season for a hitter was set by Darrien Miller in 2022. Miller was hit 24 times in 89 games that season to break the previous record that was set by Brandon Macias when he was hit by 21 pitches in 127 games during the 2012 season.

ABOUT GREAT LAKES: The Great Lakes Loons came into existence in 2007 after the Midwest League team left Battle Creek, Michigan at the end of the 2006 season. The team in Battle Creek had been known as the Michigan Battle Cats, Battle Creek Yankees, and the Southwest Michigan Devil Rays. The Loons have been affiliated with the Los Angeles Dodgers since 2007. They have made the Midwest League playoffs nine times since 2007. The Loons won the Midwest League title in 2016 and lost to Cedar Rapids in the Midwest League Championship Series in 2023. Notable Great Lakes alumni include Clayton Kershaw, Kenley Jansen, Nathan Eovaldi, Joc Peterson, Julio Urias, Walker Buehler, and Gavin Lux. Jair Fernandez, who played in 52 games with the Timber Rattlers in 2007, is the manager of the Loons in 2024.

ABOUT THE DODGERS: The Los Angeles Dodgers were only in the Midwest League for a few seasons prior to affiliating with the Loons. They were in Dubuque in 1967 and in Clinton from 1977 to 1979. Orel Hershiser and Steve Sax were notable Dodgers to play in Clinton.

PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES: [MLB Pipeline](#) places five active Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Luis Lara (#8), Luke Adams (#15), Dylan O'Rae (#20), Jadhav Areinamo (#22), and Patricio Aquino (#28). [MLB Pipeline](#) has five Great Lakes players on their list of Top 30 Dodgers prospects: Jackson Ferris (#7), Thayron Liranzo (#9), Maddux Bruns (#14), Noah Miller (#26), and Peter Heubeck (#30).

THE SEASON SO FAR: The Loons completed a six-game sweep at Fort Wayne on April 28. They are 16-8 and are the top team in the East Division. Great Lakes had an eight-game winning streak before losing last night.

PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

RHP ALEXANDER CORNIELLE: Milwaukee signed Cornielle as an International Free Agent out of the Dominican Republic on June 15, 2019.

FAST DEBUT: Cornielle made his professional debut with one inning of relief against the Cubs #2 affiliate in the Dominican Summer League on August 2, 2019. He allowed one run on no hits with two walks in one inning. Cornielle made three appearances in the DSL in 2019 with no record and one run allowed over four innings.

HIT PLAY: Cornielle started the 2021 season with the Brewers Blue affiliate in the Arizona Complex League and was 4-2 in nine games – four starts – with a 4.64 ERA and 50 strikeouts over 33 innings pitched. He was called up to Carolina at the end of the season and was 0-1 in two starts with ten strikeouts in eight innings.

WEEKLY AWARDS: Cornielle was named the ACL's Pitcher of the Week on September 6, 2021. He also won the Midwest League Pitcher of the Week Award on September 11, 2023.

BACK IN 2022: Cornielle was 9-7 in 22 games – 19 starts – with a 3.19 ERA and 124 strikeouts over 101-2/3 innings pitched for the Carolina Mudcats this season before joining the Timber Rattlers on August 23. He was second in the Carolina League in strikeouts and third in the Carolina League in ERA before his promotion to Wisconsin. Cornielle was 1-0 in three starts with 21 strikeouts over 17-1/3 innings pitched.

LAST SEASON: Cornielle was 1-3 in twenty games – eighteen starts – for Wisconsin. He walked 34, struck out 92, and compiled a 4.55 ERA in 89 innings pitched for the Rattlers.

LAST START: Cornielle had a no decision at Peoria on [April 27](#). He allowed three runs on six hits and two walks with three strikeouts over 4-2/3 innings. The Timber Rattlers won the game 5-4.

VS. GREAT LAKES: Cornielle has never pitched against the Loons prior to this afternoon. Today is also the first time he will face an affiliate of the Los Angeles Dodgers.

GREAT LAKES SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP JACOB MEADOR: The Dodgers selected Meador out of Dallas Baptist University in the twelfth round of the 2022 draft.

DBU: Meador went 7-3 with a 5.24 ERA and 91 strikeouts over 68-2/3 innings pitched in his one season at Dallas Baptist University. He made fifteen appearances – with fourteen starts.

A BASEBALL BIOGRAPHY: Meador started his college career at Texas Christian University with two seasons (2020 and 2021) before transferring to Dallas Baptist. Meador also pitched summer baseball for Frisco in the Texas Collegiate League in 2020 and Yarmouth-Dennis in the Cape Cod League in 2021.

FEELING 2022: Meador began his pro career with two brief appearances in the Arizona Complex League before moving up to pitch five games – two starts – for the Rancho Cucamonga Quakes late in the season. He was 0-1 with a combined 4.15 ERA and fourteen strikeouts over 8-2/3 innings in his two stops in the Dodgers system at the start of his career.

MISSING TIME: Meador did not pitch during the 2023 season. He was placed on Rancho Cucamonga's 60-Day Injured List on April 11, 2023. Meador got back on the mound on [April 10, 2024](#) with a relief appearance at Lansing.

LAST START: Meador had a no decision at Fort Wayne on [April 28](#). He allowed four hits, walked two, and struck out two over four scoreless innings.

VS. WISCONSIN: Meador has never pitched against the Timber Rattlers before this afternoon. Today is also the first time he will face an affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers.
