ABOUT LAST NIGHT: [The West Michigan Whitecaps beat the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers 4-1 at LMCU Ballpark.](#)

The Rattlers took the lead in the top of the first inning on an RBI single by Eduardo Garcia. The Whitecaps tied the game in the bottom of the first on an RBI single by Josue Briceño. Peyton Graham gave West Michigan the lead on an infield, two-out, RBI single in the fourth. The Whitecaps added a single run in the fifth and one more run in the seventh. Joe Miller pitched six scoreless innings of relief, allowed three hits, and struck out seven for the win. The Whitecaps clinched a series victory with their win last night.

Wisconsin had won four straight series coming into this set with the first half East Division Champions

YEOMAN'S WORK: Jesús Broca pitched two scoreless innings out of the Wisconsin bullpen. He has pitched in five of the first ten games of the Rattlers current road trip. Broca has allowed one run on four hits with three walks and four strikeouts over 8-1/3 innings in his last five games. Starting with his appearance at South Bend on May 23, Broca has appeared in nine games and has allowed one run with eighteen strikeouts over seventeen innings.

ON THE ROAD: Today is the final game of a two-week road trip to Michigan for the Timber Rattlers. They were 4-2 at Great Lakes and are 1-3 with a rainout here at LMCU Ballpark. A win today will give the Rattlers a .500 road trip and their first win of the second half. The Timber Rattlers are 18-16 on the road heading into this game.

WE'RE COMING HOME! Wisconsin returns home to face the Quad Cities River Bandits on Tuesday night for their first home game since June 8. After today, Wisconsin will play fifteen of their next eighteen games at home. The Rattlers are 16-17 at Neuroscience Group Field so far in 2025.

ABOUT WEST MICHIGAN: The West Michigan Whitecaps joined the Midwest League in 1994 when the Madison Muskies moved to Comstock Park, Michigan following the 1993 season. The Whitecaps started play in the league as an affiliate of the Oakland Athletics. They became Low-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers for the 1997 season. The Whitecaps have won six Midwest League Pennants – 1996, 1998, 2004, 2006, 2007, and 2015. Notable former Whitecaps include Nick Castellanos, Joel Zumaya, Fernando Rodney, Francisco Cordero, Brandon Inge, Cameron Maybin, Alex Avila, and Willy Adames. The Whitecaps clinched the first half East Division Championship on June 13 and are in the Midwest League playoffs for the first time since 2018.

ABOUT THE TIGERS: Detroit has been affiliated with the Whitecaps since 1997. The Tigers had just one other stint in the Midwest League prior to their current partnership. They were with the Clinton Pilots from 1971 through 1975.

PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

RHP JARON DeBERRY: The Milwaukee Brewers selected DeBerry in the third round of the 2024 draft out of Dallas Baptist University.

JC: DeBerry pitched the 2021 season at Northern Oklahoma-Enid and was 5-1 with a 4.10 ERA in fourteen games – twelve starts. In 2022, he was at Grayson College with a 4-0 record, a 3.27 ERA, and 60 strikeouts in 41.1IP.

SUMMER JOBS: DeBerry was with Duluth in the Northwoods League in 2022 and Cowlitz in the West Coast League in 2023. He combined to go 4-0 with a 1.85 ERA and 37 strikeouts over 39 innings playing in the Summer Leagues.

DBU: DeBerry was 10-2 with a 4.11 ERA in two seasons with Dallas Baptist. He had 124 strikeouts in 124-1/3 innings. He was a First Team All-Conference USA selection in his final season. In his last start with the Patriots, DeBerry shutout Arizona over six innings as Dallas Baptist beat the Wildcats in the Tucson Regional of the 2024 NCAA Tournament.

BEFORE WISCONSIN: DeBerry made his pro debut with three starts for the Carolina Mudcats before joining Wisconsin on May 20. He had no record, allowed one run, walked one, and struck out thirteen in 8-2/3 innings with the Mudcats.

LAST START: DeBerry won game one of this series against West Michigan on [June 17](#). He allowed two runs on three hits with a walk and six strikeouts over five innings.

VS. WEST MICHIGAN: DeBerry's only appearance against West Michigan prior to this afternoon was on June 17. That was also his first appearance against an affiliate of the Detroit Tigers.

WEST MICHIGAN STARTING PITCHER:

RHP HAYDEN MINTON: The Detroit Tigers selected Minton in the ninth round of the 2023 draft out of the Missouri State University.

MSU: Minton pitched three seasons (2020, 2021, and 2023) at Missouri State. He was 7-9 with a 4.02 ERA with 150 strikeouts and 65 walks over 147-2/3 innings in 28 games – 27 starts – for the Bears.

GAP YEAR: Minton at Johnson County Community College and with Mahoning Valley of the MLB Draft League in 2022 before returning to Missouri State.

HEADING TO FLORIDA: Minton made his pro debut with two brief relief appearances in the Florida Complex League in 2023. In 2024, Minton was 4-5 with a 4.65 ERA for the Lakeland Flying Tigers of the Florida State League. Minton started the 2025 season with Lakeland and as 1-1 with a 3.18 ERA in four starts before his promotion to West Michigan on May 27.

LAST START: Minton had a no decision at Lansing on [June 15](#). He allowed three hits, walked one, and struck out three while allowing one unearned run over four innings.

VS. WISCONSIN: Minton has never pitched against the Timber Rattlers before this afternoon. Today is also his first appearance against an affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers.
