ABOUT LAST NIGHT: [The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers beat the Quad Cities River Bandits 5-4 at Modern Woodmen Park.](#) Wisconsin erased a 3-2 deficit with three runs in the top of the seventh inning and held off the River Bandits.

ANOTHER FAST START: Gregory Barrios and Luke Adams had consecutive doubles with two outs in the top of the first to score a run for the Rattlers, who have outscored opponents 34-15 in the first inning this season. Wisconsin has scored in the first inning in fifteen of their first 29 games in 2024.

FALLING BEHIND: The River Bandits trailed 2-0 before scoring a run in the fourth. Brett Squires hit a two-run homer in the fifth to give the Bandits a 3-2 lead.

ANATOMY OF A RALLY: Brandon Johnson entered the game from the Quad Cities bullpen in the top of the seventh to protect their lead. He had pitched twelve scoreless innings with three walks and 25 strikeouts before last night. Wisconsin loaded the bases with no outs on a single, a walk, and another single. Terence Doston tied the game with a sacrifice fly. Luis Lara put the Rattlers back in the lead with a two-run double.

SIX PACK: Lara's double extended his current hitting streak to six games. This is his third six-game hitting streak of the season.

NEVER IN DOUBT: Squires homered to lead-off the eighth inning off Mark Manfredi to cut the lead to one run. Aaron Rund entered the game and preserved the lead by retiring all three batters he faced on ten pitches. Yerlin Rodriguez gave up a hit in the bottom of the ninth but converted his fifth save of the season.

ONE STREAK ENDS; TWO STREAKS CONTINUE: Adams was not hit by a pitch last night ending his streak of games with an HBP at six. Wisconsin pitchers have allowed a home run in five straight games. Wisconsin's defense played their sixth consecutive errorless game last night. The Rattlers have committed two errors in their last twelve games. Both errors occurred in the loss to Great Lakes on May 1.

ABOUT QUAD CITIES: The River Bandits are the Midwest League affiliate of the Kansas City Royals. The current version of Davenport Professional Baseball club started in 1960 as the Midwest League affiliate of the Milwaukee Braves. Quad Cities has affiliated with several MLB teams: The California Angels (1962-1978 and 1985-1992), the Chicago Cubs (1979-1984), the Houston Astros (1993-1998 and 2013-2019), the Minnesota Twins (1999-2004), and the St. Louis Cardinals (2005-2012). The team became the Quad City River Bandits in 1992. They changed their name to the Swing of the Quad Cities from 2004 through 2007 before changing to Quad Cities River Bandits in 2008. Quad Cities won Midwest League pennants in 1968, 1971, 1979, 1990, 2011, 2013, and 2017. They were the High-A Central League champions in 2021. Notable alumni of Quad Cities: Carlos Correa, Joe Mauer, Josh Hader, Billy Wagner, Shawon Dunston, Justin Morneau, and Brett Phillips.

ABOUT THE ROYALS: The Kansas City Royals have been Quad Cities' parent club since 2021. They left the Midwest league and an affiliation with Kane County at the end of the 2012 season. The Royals had previously been in the Midwest League with Waterloo (1969-1976), Appleton (1987-1992), Rockford (1993-94), Springfield (1995), Lansing (1996-1998), Burlington (2001-2010), and Kane County (2011-2012).

PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

RHP WILL RUDY: The Milwaukee Brewers selected Rudy in the 5th round of the 2022 draft out of the California Polytechnic State University, Pomona.

WHAT A SEASON: Rudy was at Cal Poly Pomona for three seasons but had just one full season due to COVID-19 abbreviating 2020 and canceling the 2021 season for the Broncos. In 2022, which was still his freshman season, Rudy went 8-1 with a 3.10 ERA over thirteen starts. He walked fifteen and struck out 96 in 87 innings pitched during that season.

TROPHY ROOM: Rudy was a three-time Pitcher of the Week in the California Collegiate Athletic Association, two-time National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association West Region Pitcher of the Week, a First Team All-CCAA selection, and the CCAA's Most Valuable pitcher last season.

OUR OLD FRIEND FROM POMONA: Rudy was the highest draft selection of a Poly Pomona player since Cody Ponce was picked 55th overall in the 2015 draft. The Brewers also picked Ponce, who pitched for the Timber Rattlers right after the 2015 draft.

THE CAPE: Rudy made one start for Yarmouth-Dennis in the Cape Cod League in 2022 before the draft. He did not pitch in the Brewers system until 2023.

THE MUDCAT: Rudy was 5-3 in eighteen starts for Carolina in 2023 for his professional debut. Rudy had a 3.46 ERA, 26 walks, and 69 strikeouts over 80-2/3 innings.

LAST START: Rudy beat Great Lakes at home on [May 2](#). He allowed one run on two hits with no walks and five strikeouts over six innings. Rudy retired the first sixteen batters he faced before giving up a one-out single in the sixth. The Loons scored their run off Rudy on a two-out triple in the sixth.

VS. QUAD CITIES: Rudy has never faced the River Bandits prior to this evening. He pitched against Columbia, the Carolina League affiliate of the Kansas City Royals on [July 28, 2023](#). Rudy earned the win in that game and allowed two runs on six hits with two walks and five strikeouts over five innings.

QUAD CITIES STARTING PITCHER:

RHP STEVEN ZOBAC: The Kansas City Royals selected Zobac out of the University of California in the fourth round of the 2022 draft. MLB Pipeline ranks Zobac as the #24 prospect in the Royals system. *Baseball America* has him as the #28 Kansas City prospect.

BERKELEY BEAR: Zobac was 7-8 with four saves and a 4.48 ERA in 39 games – eleven starts – over three seasons at Cal. He had 100 strikeouts in 86-1/3 innings pitched during his career. Zobac was a two-way player for his first two seasons before moving almost exclusively to the mound in 2022. In his final season of college baseball, Zobac was 4-4 with a 4.09 ERA with 72 strikeouts over 61-2/3 innings over twenty games – ten starts.

DELAYED DEBUT: Zobac did not pitch professionally in 2022. He made his professional debut with the Columbia Fireflies in the Carolina League in 2023. Zobac was 1-2 with a 2.09 ERA in fourteen games – ten starts – with 61 strikeouts over 51-2/3 innings pitched before his promotion to Quad Cities on July 18, 2023.

AWARD SEASON: Zobac was named the Carolina League pitcher of the month in April 2023. He allowed one hit, walked one, and struck out eighteen in eight innings over three relief appearances. Zobac was 1-0 for the Fireflies in April.

THE GREAT MIDWEST: Zobac made eight starts with Quad Cities after his promotion in 2023. He was 1-4 with a 5.31 ERA with twelve walks and 37 strikeouts over 39 innings pitched.

LAST START: Zobac had a no decision at Beloit on [May 2](#). He allowed three runs – one earned – on four hits with no walks and four strikeouts over three innings.

VS. WISCONSIN: Zobac made the start and took the loss at Wisconsin on [August 26, 2023](#). He gave up six runs on seven hits with two walks and two strikeouts over three innings.
