**ABOUT LAST NIGHT:** [The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers beat the Quad Cities River Bandits 4-1 at Neuroscience Group Field.](#) Carlos Luna, Evan Reifert, and Harold Chirino held the River Bandits to one run on two hits. LG Castillo broke a 1-1 tie with a two-run double in the bottom of the fourth.

**PHASES OF THE MOON:** Luna allowed one hit, a solo home run by Logan Porter, last night. He pitched 5-2/3 innings, walked three, and struck out five in the game to pick up his second win. Luna's ERA went up from 0.76 to 0.92 last night. Luna has allowed three earned runs over 29-1/3 innings pitched over seven appearances three starts with Wisconsin. He has walked five and struck out 33 with the Rattlers.

**ONE BAKER'S DOZEN:** Castillo's hitting streak has reached thirteen games. 18-for-53 (.340) during the streak.

**KEEP ON WALKING:** Hayden Cantrelle drew three walks last night. He has coaxed seven walks from Quad Cities pitchers in this series. Cantrelle has 59 walks in 51 games this season. The only player in the minors with more walks than Cantrelle is Edouard Julien, who has 60 walks in 56 games between Fort Myers and Cedar Rapids this season.

**KING OF TRIOS:** Korry Howell had three hits last night. Howell has 14 multi-hit games this season. He is tied with David Hamilton for the most multi-hit games on the Timber Rattlers this season.

**SHUTDOWN MODE:** Reifert and Chirino closed out the victory for the Rattlers last night. Reifert walked a batter, allowed a hit, and had four strikeouts over 2-1/3 innings. Reifert has not allowed a run in his last four outings and has eleven strikeouts over six innings in those four appearances. Chirino pitched a scoreless ninth for his third save.

**ABOUT QUAD CITIES:** The River Bandits are the High-A Central League affiliate of the Kansas City Royals. The current version of Davenport Professional Baseball club started in 1960 as the Midwest League affiliate of the Milwaukee Braves. Quad Cities has affiliated with several MLB teams over the years: The California Angels (1962-1978 and 1985-1992), the Chicago Cubs (1979-1984), the Houston Astros (1993-1998 and 2013-2019), the Minnesota Twins (1999-2004), and the St. Louis Cardinals (2005-2012). The team became the Quad City River Bandits in 1992. They changed their name to the Swing of the Quad Cities from 2004 through 2007 before changing to Quad Cities River Bandits in 2008. Quad Cities won Midwest League pennants in 1968, 1971, 1979, 1990, 2011, 2013, and 2017. Notable alumni of Quad Cities: Carlos Correa, Joe Mauer, Josh Hader, Lance Lynn, Carlos Martinez, Billy Wagner, Shawon Dunston, Justin Morneau, and Brett Phillips. Modern Woodmen Park, which opened as Municipal Stadium on May 26, 1931. The stadium was renamed as John O'Donnell Stadium in 1971. The stadium was remodeled after the 2003 season and was renamed Modern Woodmen Park for the 2007.

**ABOUT THE ROYALS:** The Kansas City Royals return to what used of to be the Midwest League after leaving Kane County at the end of the 2012 season. They had previously been in the Midwest League with Waterloo from 1969-1976. Other Midwest League teams the Royals had as an affiliate: Appleton (1987-1992), Rockford (1993-94), Springfield (1995), Lansing (1996-1998), Burlington (2001-2010), and Kane County (2011-2012). The Royals had worked with Lexington in the South Atlantic League as the Low-A affiliate from 2013-2019. Wilmington had been the High-A affiliate of the Royals from 2007-2019.

# PITCHING MATCHUP

## WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

**RHP JUSTIN BULLOCK:** Selected by the Brewers in the 16<sup>th</sup> round of the 2017 draft out of South Granville (NC) High School.

**HE'S A PLAYER:** Bullock was named the North Carolina Baseball Coaches Association 2A Player of the Year in 2017. He was 11-1 with a 0.55ERA and 124 strikeouts in 63-2/3 innings pitched on the mound. Bullock also hit .476 with eleven homers and 46RBI.

**LET'S GO PRO:** Bullock signed with the Brewers over a commitment to North Carolina State University.

**IN ARIZONA:** Bullock went 1-0 with a 3.09ERA in six games – one start – for the AZL Brewers after signing with Milwaukee in 2017. He walked three and struck out eleven in 11-2/3 innings pitched in his debut season.

**A SEASON IN MONTANA:** Bullock made 13 starts for Helena in 2018. He was 2-5 with 66 strikeouts in 58-2/3 innings pitched. Bullock finished fourth in the Pioneer League in strikeouts.

**TIME WITH THE TIMBER RATTLERS:** Bullock was 2-2 with a 7.78 ERA, 14 walks and 20 strikeouts over 19-2/3 innings in seven games – three starts – for Wisconsin in 2019.

**CAROLINA ON MY MIND:** Bullock started this season with the Carolina Mudcats in the Low-A East. He was 1-1 in four starts with a 1.42 ERA. He walked five and struck out 27 over 19 innings pitched with the Mudcats this season. He finished on a 15-2/3 inning scoreless streak.

**AWARD WINNING:** Bullock was the High-A Central League's pitcher of the month for June. He was 3-1 with a 3.00 ERA in four starts with Wisconsin. Bullock walked one and struck out 23 over 24 innings during the month. One of his wins was the first five innings of a combined no-hitter [at South Bend on June 10](#).

**LAST START:** Bullock won [at Beloit on July 3](#). He allowed three unearned runs on three hits with two walks and seven strikeouts over six innings.

**VS. QUAD CITIES:** Bullock lost [at Quad Cities on June 16](#). He allowed five runs on seven hits over six innings.

## QUAD CITIES STARTING PITCHER:

**RHP NOAH MURDOCK:** The Royals selected Murdock in the 7<sup>th</sup> round of the 2019 draft out of the University of Virginia.

**BEING CAVALIER:** Murdock pitched three seasons at Virginia. He was 8-9 with a 5.30 ERA in 30 appearances – 25 starts – with the Cavaliers. Murdock walked 57 and struck out 103 in 125-2/3 innings pitched in his collegiate career.

**APPALACHIAN TRAIL:** Murdock went to the Burlington Royals in the Appalachian League after signing with Kansas City. He was 3-1 with a 2.89 ERA in eleven games – six starts – during the regular season. He made two appearances – one start – during Burlington's playoff run during the 2019 Appalachian League postseason. Murdock was 0-1 with a save in those two playoff appearances.

**NO....IT'S IOWA:** Murdock joined the River Bandits on June 15 to start his 2021 season. He is 0-1 with a 5.06 ERA in four games – three starts – since joining Quad Cities.

**LAST START:** Murdock had a no decision [against Cedar Rapids on July 4 at home](#). He pitched three scoreless, hitless innings with two walks and three strikeouts.

**VS. WISCONSIN:** Murdock made his High-A Central League debut with a relief appearance against [the Timber Rattlers at Modern Woodmen Park on June 17](#). He allowed three runs – two earned – on one hit, two hit batsmen, three walks, and three strikeouts in 1-1/3 innings pitched for a no decision.
