INDY BITS

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: After trailing 3-0 early, the Indianapolis Indians recorded their fourth walk-off victory of the season and second against the Toledo Mud Hens with a towering, game-winning double off the bat of Matt Gorski in the 11th inning on Friday night at Victory Field. Ryder Ryan dazzled with 2.0 perfect innings and four strikeouts out of the bullpen, stranding the automatic runner at second base both times to set up the victory for Indianapolis. With Billy Cook in scoring position, Gorski launched the first pitch of Indy's half of the 11th inning into the right-center gap for the team's third consecutive win and second via walk-off in the last three days. Ryan capped a stellar performance by the Indians bullpen in relief of starter Mike Burrows. Yohan Ramirez, Tanner Rainey, Isaac Mattson and Ryan combined for 10 strikeouts across 6.2 one-run innings, with no free bases allowed in the final five frames.

LATE-INNING HEROICS: The Indians walked off for the fourth time in April last night, tying a Victory Field high for most walk-off wins in the month. They earned their sixth comeback win of the season by taking down the Mud Hens in 11 innings. Four of the team's five home wins this season came via extra-inning walk-off plate appearances. The squad improved to 5-0 in extra innings this season, with one road win in 10 innings on April 13 at Louisville. Indy improved to 6-1 in one-run games on the campaign.

SOLAK ECLIPSE: Nick Solak extended his team-high hitting streak to 10 games yesterday, collecting a hit in each game he's played this season. Solak went 1-for-4 with one RBI in last night's contest. He is hitting .333 (13-for-39) with two doubles, two home runs, eight RBI, two walks, seven runs and three stolen bases this season. He has struck out just six times on the campaign and only twice in his past 26 plate appearances. On Wednesday, he posted his first multi-steal game since taking two bags June 18, 2022, with Round Rock vs. Sugar Land.

GALLANT GORSKI: Matt Gorski delivered the win with a walk-off double in yesterday's contest, going 2-for-4 with two RBI and one run. He has posted a hit in four of his past five games and has one-plus hit in 11 of his 15 games on the campaign. He has driven in one-plus run in four of his last five games and nine of 15 overall. Gorski is hitting .268 (15-for-56) with six doubles, one home run, 10 RBI, four walks, eight runs and two stolen bases this season.

DAR DEVIL: Darick Hall extended his on-base streak to eight games last night, going 0-for-2 with two walks. It marked his first multi-walk game of the campaign as his seven-game hitting streak came to an end. He is hitting .321 (9-for-28) in those eight games with two doubles, two RBI, five walks and just three strikeouts in this span. This, on the heels of going hitless (0-for-12) and striking out one-plus times in each of his first four games. From Game Two on Saturday through Sunday's contest at Louisville, he posted back-to-back multi-hit games for the first time since July 24 and 25, 2024, with Lehigh Valley at Rochester.

MIDNIGHT RYDER: Ryder Ryan tossed 2.0 perfect innings in extras last night, picking up his second win of the season and striking out four batters. He stranded the automatic runner in the 10th and 11th innings, setting up the walk-off win for the club. After allowing two earned runs in his first appearance of the season, Ryan has allowed just one earned run in his last five games, throwing 6.2 innings with 11 strikeouts in this span. The right-hander has a three-game winning streak dating back to Sept. 20, 2024, and has won four of his last five decisions dating back to Sept. 1, 2024.

BAEWATCH: Ji Hwan Bae extended his on-base streak to five games last night, going 0-for-4 with one walk, one run and one stolen base. He is hitting .227 (5-for-22) with two doubles, three walks, six runs and two stolen bases in this span. He collected one-plus stolen base in back-to-back games for the first time since July 21 and 23, 2024 with Indy. Bae scored a career-high tying four runs on Thursday night (3x, MR: 9/11/22 at OMA), finishing 3-for-4 with two doubles, one walk, and one stolen base. It marked his first three-hit game since July 21, 2024, at Omaha.

TONIGHT'S MATCHUP: The Indianapolis Indians seek their first series win of the season after reaching the .500 mark for the first time on the campaign last night at 8-8. Tonight's first pitch is scheduled for 6:35 PM with Pirates top prospect Bubba Chandler set to take the mound for the Indians. Chandler made his third start of the season on Sunday at Louisville, tossing 4.0 innings with two runs, two hits, no walks and six strikeouts. The lone two runs came after an infield single by Austin Hays and a two-run homer by Ivan Johnson. It marked the first two runs allowed by Chandler in 10.2 innings this season. In 10 career starts with Indianapolis, Chandler is 4-0 with a 1.80 ERA (10er/50.0ip) and 72 strikeouts. He has struck out eight-plus batters in five of those starts and six-plus in eight. Sunday marked his first Triple-A start without issuing a walk. Opposite Chandler is Mud Hens southpaw Lael Lockhart. Lockhart is 1-1 with a 4.86 ERA (9er/16.2ip) with 18 hits, 11 walks and 17 strikeouts in three career starts against Indianapolis.

ON THIS DATE IN 1956: In front of 669 fans at old Victory Field, Indians right-hander Dolan Nichols twirled a 9.0-inning shutout in a 3-0 win over Omaha. He scattered five hits and four walks, struck out one and finished off his complete-game effort in a tidy 2 hours and 11 minutes.
