## INDY BITS

**ABOUT LAST NIGHT:** Jack Suwinski's first-inning, two-run homer propelled the offense as Thomas Harrington struck out ten batters in his third consecutive quality start in the Indianapolis Indians 4-2 win over the St. Paul Saints on Saturday night at Victory Field. With a 2-2 tie in the bottom of the third frame, Jack Suwinski cracked a one-out double. He advanced to third on a Nick Yorke single and came in to score on an RBI groundout by Liover Peguero to grant Indianapolis its game-winning advantage. St. Paul struck first in the contest when Carson McCusker drove in a run with a double in the first inning. Suwinski answered back for Indy in the bottom half of the first frame with a 412-foot, two-run blast to put the Indians ahead. Indy's first-inning lead was short-lived, however, as the Saints posted another run in the top of the second, spurred by an Anthony Prato triple, to knot the game at 2-2. Suwinski added Indy's final run, his third RBI of the day and his 35th on the season with a sacrifice fly in the fifth.

**HEY CAM, YOU MADE THE FRONT PAGE:** Last night, Thomas Harrington became the first Indians pitcher to toss three consecutive quality starts since Cam Alldred from June 16-29, 2023. Sean Sullivan was the first Indian to toss a 3.0-plus inning save since Alldred did so on Sept. 18, 2021 vs. St. Paul.

**HARRI STYLES:** Thomas Harrington tossed his third consecutive quality start last night, earning his fourth win of the season. He allowed just two runs across 6.0 innings, striking out a Triple-A best 10 batters. In his last three starts since June 3, Harrington is 2-1 with a 2.50 ERA (5er/18.0ip), 18 strikeouts, 1.00 WHIP and .159 opponent average (10-for-63). He has thrown 5.0-plus innings in seven of his 11 starts on the campaign.

**SULLIVAN FOR THE SAVE:** Sean Sullivan picked up his first save of the season last night, tossing 3.0 innings with one hit batter and a season high five strikeouts. It was the first save of 3.0-plus innings with no hits, no walks and no runs since Daniel McCutchen on Aug. 2, 2012, at Scranton-Wilkes Barre. It was just the 16th save of 3.0-plus innings with no hits or walks by an International League pitcher since 2015.

**VICTORS VALIANT:** The Indians 26-9 record at Victory Field this season is their highest win total at the venue through June 14 since starting the 2013 season 27-10 at home. Their .743 winning percentage at Victory Field this season is the second-best mark in the minors of teams with at least 20 home games played, only trailing Single-A Brooklyn's 25-7 (.781) home record. Since April 16, the Indians are 24-5 at Victory Field, posting a +42 run differential in this span (144-102). Their 24 home wins in this span are the most by any minor league team.

**CARDIAC KIDS:** The Indians secured their 19th comeback win of the season last night, rallying behind Jack Suwinski's first-inning, go-ahead homer. Their 19 comeback wins through June 14 are Indy's most through this date since at least 2018. Last season's team did not pick up their 18th comeback win until Aug. 1 vs. Toledo. On Friday night, Indianapolis improved to 16-6 in one-run games this season, 7-0 in extra innings, with all walk-off wins this season coming in extras.

**JACK ATTACK:** Jack Suwinski launched another first-inning home run, giving the Indians a 2-1 advantage in the first inning and helping fuel the eventual comeback win. He finished the contest 3-for-3 with one double, one home run, three RBI and two runs. He extended is on-base streak to 14 games, which is the longest active run on the team (active players all). In this span he is hitting .320 (16-for-50) with three doubles, one triple, four home runs, 15 RBI, six walks, 13 runs, two stolen bases and a 1.060 OPS. Since making his season debut on April 25 (1) at St. Paul, he leads the team in home runs (9), total bases (70), RBI (35) and runs (26).

**SOMEONE COOKED HERE:** Billy Cook went 1-for-3 with one run and one stolen base in last night's contest. He has hit safely in 16 of his last 19 games with an official at-bat since May 23 at Toledo. In that span, he is hitting .391 (27-for-69) with five doubles, seven RBI, 10 walks, 10 runs, five stolen bases and a .939 OPS. He has reached base safely two-plus times in nine of his last 12 games. Seven of those 12 games feature multi-hit performances.

**BUCCO BART:** Pirates catcher Joey Bart joined the Indianapolis Indians on a major league rehab assignment on Wednesday. Bart was placed on the 7-day injured list on May 28, sustaining a concussion after being hit in the mask on a backswing on May 27 at Arizona. In 44 games with Pittsburgh this season, the backstop is hitting .240 (35-for-146) with five doubles, one triple, one home run, 11 RBI, 21 walks and one stolen base. He led MLB primary catchers in April (min. 65 PA) in batting average (.310, 18-for-58) and ranked fifth in OPS (.877). He appeared in six games for the Indians last season on a rehab assignment, batting .353 (6-for-17) with one double, four RBI, three walks and two runs.

**DAZZLING DAURI:** The Indians roster features another major league rehabber, right-hander Dauri Moreta. Moreta was placed on the 60-day injured list on Feb. 16 after undergoing Tommy John surgery and being sidelined for the entire 2024 season. Nearly 14 months after his last professional appearance, the right-hander began a rehab assignment with High-A Bradenton on April 29 and tossed 2.0 scoreless innings in two games. He has since pitched to a 3.55 ERA (5er/12.2ip) with Indy, allowing eight hits while striking out 18 across his 15 appearances dating back to May 6.

**TONIGHT'S MATCHUP:** The Indianapolis Indians conclude their seven-game set against the St. Paul Saints this afternoon at 1:05 PM. The Indians will start Eddy Yean in a bullpen game while the Saints will counter with righty Cory Lewis. It is Yean's 29th career start and his first since June 3, 2023, while with High-A Greensboro. In his 29 career starts throughout the minor leagues, Yean has pitched to a 4-8 record with a 4.64 ERA (61er/118.1ip) while striking out 103 batters. Yean has made five appearances against St. Paul and has not allowed an earned run across his 6.2 innings of work against the Saints. Lewis has faced Indianapolis twice in his career and has earned a 1-2 record with a 5.19 ERA (5er/8.2ip) in those starts.

**DOMINATE THE SAINTS:** The Indians are 18-2 against the Saints at Victory Field since April 15, 2023. Last night's win pulled Indy ahead in the head-to-head series since 1938, with a 294-293 record over St. Paul. Friday night's win marked their third straight series win over the squad at the venue.

**ON THIS DATE IN 1978:** In the top of the first inning in an exhibition against the Cincinnati Reds at Bush Stadium, Ken Griffey tripped ahead of a two-run homer by Joe Morgan. The Indians grabbed a 5-3 lead through six frames, but the Reds plated five runs in the seventh en route to an 8-5 win over Indy. Ron Oester, Champ Summers, Lynn Jones and Tom Mutz each had two hits for Indianapolis.
