ABOUT LAST NIGHT: <u>The Cedar Rapids Kernels beat</u> the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers 6-2 at Rise 2 Greatness Field. Je'Von Ward gave the Timber Rattlers a 2-1 lead with a solo home run in the top of the fifth inning. The Kernels scored four runs in the bottom of the fifth inning to take a 5-2 lead. Kala'i Rosario capped the inning with a two-run homer for Cedar Rapids. Three Kernels pitchers combined for one walk and fourteen strikeouts. **EARLY TRADING:** Wisconsin grabbed a 1-0 lead in the top of the first inning as Mike Boeve's two-out, infield single knocked in Luis Lara from second base. Cedar Rapids tied the game in the bottom of the first on a two-out, RBI double by Jorel Ortega. **MAKING THEM COUNT:** Ward's homer was his eighth

of the season. Last night's blast was the fourth of his homers to give the Timber Rattlers the lead in a game this season. Two of Ward's homers tied the score. **STREAKING:** Boeve is on a five-game hitting streak. He is 7-for-20 with four runs scored and five RBI during the streak. Lara is on a three-game hitting streak (4-for-

12) since joining the Rattlers on Tuesday. WALKING IN WISCONSIN: Brock Wilken drew a walk

in the eighth inning last night. It was his fourteenth walk in thirteen games with the Timber Rattlers. Wilken is on a six-game on-base streak. He is 6-for-21 with five walks for a .444 OBP during the streak.

ONE-PITCH KNOCKOUT: Tanner Shears entered last night's game with the bases loaded and one out in the bottom of the sixth. He threw one pitch and got Mikey Perez to hit into an inning-ending 6-4-3 double play. **SNAPSHOT:** There are 21 games remaining in the season. ABOUT CEDAR RAPIDS: The current franchise began its existence as the Cedar Rapids Braves, an affiliate of the Milwaukee Braves in the Three-I League, in 1958. That was the same year and league the current Timber Rattlers franchise joined the Three-I League as the Fox Cities Foxes. Both teams moved to the Midwest League when the Three-I League ended after the 1961 season. Cedar Rapids has been called the Braves, Red Raiders, Cardinals, Astros, Giants, and Reds until they became the Kernels in 1993. That was the same year the California Angels became the parent club of the Kernels. That affiliation remained through the 2012 season. Cedar Rapids has been affiliated with the Minnesota Twins since 2013. The Kernels have made the Midwest League playoffs every year they have been affiliated with the Twins, including this year. Notable alumni include Mike Trout, Byron Buxton, Trevor Hoffman, Brewers Pitching Coach Chris Hook, and Ted Simmons.

ABOUT THE TWINS: Minnesota has a long history of in the Midwest League. They started out with Wisconsin Rapids (1964-1983) and moved to Kenosha (1984-1992) and to Fort Wayne (1993-1998) as the franchise moved. Minnesota has also been with Quad Cities (1999-2004) and Beloit (2005-2012) before their current affiliation with Cedar Rapids Kernels started in 2013.

PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES: <u>MLB Pipeline</u> places seven active Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Brock Wilken (#8), Luis Lara (#9), Robert Moore (#17), Mike Boeve (#18), Bradley Blalock (#19), Matthew Wood (#25), and Hendry Mendez (#29). Eric Brown Jr (#12) is currently on Wisconsin's IL. <u>MLB</u> <u>Pipeline</u> has ten active Kernels on their list of Minnesota prospects: Emmanuel Rodriguez (#3), Cory Lewis (#13), CJ Culpepper (#14), Jose Salas (#17), Kala'i Rosario (#19), Noah Miller (#24), Zebby Matthews (#25), Ben Ross (#26), Alejandro Hidalgo (#28), and Noah Cardenas (#30). PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP TYLER WOESSNER: Drafted by the Milwaukee Brewers in the sixth round of the 2022 draft out of Central Arizona College.

WHAT A SEASON: Woessner went 11-2 with a 3.55 ERA in nineteen games – eighteen starts – during his final season at CAC. He walked 34 and struck out 122 in 96-1/3 innings pitched for the Vaqueros.

PITCHING INTO THE FINALS: Central Arizona College advanced to the 2022 NJCAA College World Series in Grand Junction, Colorado. Woessner was the winning pitcher in the game that got CAC into the Championship game as he allowed three runs and struck out eight over seven innings in the Vaqueros' 7-4 win over Walters State Community College on June 3. 2022. Central Arizona College won the National Title the next day with a 4-2 win over Cowley County Community College

NORTH TO ALASKA: Woessner pitched in three games – one start – for the Mat-Su Miners of the Alaska Baseball League in 2021. He had no record, walked three, and struck out four over seven innings.

FIRST YEAR AS A BREWER: Woessner started his pro career with the Brewers Gold affiliate in the Arizona Complex League and made three appearances – two starts – with eleven strikeouts over six scoreless innings. Woessner also made one start for the Carolina Mudcats at the end of the 2022 Carolina League season.

LAST START: Woessner had a no decision against Dayton at home on <u>August 11</u>. He allowed two runs on nine hits with a walk and six strikeouts over five innings. The Timber Rattlers lost the game 8-6 in ten innings.

VS. CEDAR RAPIDS: Woessner is 1-0 in three starts against the Kernels this season. He has allowed seven runs – five earned – on six hits with ten walks and fifteen strikeouts over 13-2/3 innings pitched. Woessner won at Cedar Rapids on May 23 and had no decisions on May 28 and July 28. Emmanuel Rodriguez has a solo homer against Woessner this season.

CEDAR RAPIDS SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP CORY LEWIS: The Minnesota Twins selected Lewis in the ninth round of the 2022 draft out of UC-Santa Barbara. Lewis is the #13 prospect in the Minnesota organization according to MLB Pipeline.

GAUCHO MARKS: Lewis pitched two seasons at UC-Santa Barbara and was 16-5 in 31 games – 26 starts – with a 3.48 ERA and 193 strikeouts over 168-1/3 innings pitched. That includes a 9-1 record in sixteen starts in 2022. Lewis had 107 strikeouts in 88-1/3 innings during his final season at UCSB.

KNUCKLE SANDWICH: Lewis pitching arsenal includes a fastball, curve, slider, changeup, and a knuckleball.

SUNSHINE STATE: Lewis did not pitch professionally in 2022. He made his pro debut with Fort Myers in the Florida State League where he was 4-3 with a 2.75 ERA in nine starts. Lewis walked fifteen and struck out 55 over 39-1/3 innings for Fort Myers before his promotion to Cedar Rapids on June 5.

PART OF A NO-NO: Lewis and three Fort Myers relievers combined on a no-hitter of the Tampa Tarpons on <u>May 14, 2023</u>. Lewis pitched 5-2/3 perfect innings with seven strikeouts before turning the game over to the bullpen. Lewis threw 73 pitches – 51 strikes – and picked up the win in the game.

LAST START: Lewis had a no decision at Quad Cities on <u>August 12</u>. He allowed four runs – one earned – on four hits with two walks and six strikeouts over 4-1/3 innings. Shervyen Newton hit a three-run homer against Lewis in the game. The River Bandits would win 12-10 in ten innings.

VS. WISCONSIN: Lewis beat the Timber Rattlers at Wisconsin on <u>July 25</u>. He allowed one run on one hit with a walk and three strikeouts over five innings.
