INDY BITS

ABOUT SUNDAY: The Indianapolis Indians defeated the Louisville Bats, 6-5, in 10 innings to split last week's six-game road series. A four-run Indianapolis rally in the eighth inning helped force extras and two runs in the 10th frame sealed the win. Llover Peguero went 3-for-5 with two doubles, one RBI, one run scored and one stolen base in the win. He reached base safely for the 10th consecutive game and has hits in seven straight contests. Darick Hall posted his second straight multi-hit game, going 2-for-4 with a walk, including a go-ahead RBI single in the 10th frame. He has hits in five straight games after failing to record a hit through his first four contests. The Indians plated a pair of runs in the extra frame. Hall's RBI blooper to center field gave them a 5-4 advantage and it was followed by a run-scoring double play hit into by Matt Gorski. Malcom Nuñez led off the top of the 10th inning with a double. After Louisville's Ivan Johnson switched from left field to right field with defensive changes following the ninth inning, he was immediately tested with Nuñez's fly ball to right field. Johnson lost the ball in the sun and the extra-base knock put runners at second and third with no outs to begin the frame, setting up Hall and Gorski's go-ahead plays.

PEGGY PROWESS: Llover Peguero went 3-for-5 with two doubles, one RBI, one run scored and one stolen base on Sunday. It marked his team-high 10th consecutive game on base, including a seven-game hitting streak. In this 10 game run he is hitting .342 (13-for-38) with four doubles, four RBI, three walks, six runs and two stolen bases. It was his first game with three hits since September 10, 2024, vs. Rochester. Peguero has one-plus hit in nine of the 10 games and has multiple hits in three of his last four games. It was his first game with three-plus hits, two-plus extra base hits, one-plus RBI, one-plus run and one-plus stolen base since Aug. 22, 2024, at Columbus when he went 3-for-5 with two home runs, one double, three RBI, three runs and one stolen base. In the six-game series against Louisville, Peguero hit .429 (9-for-21) with three doubles, four RBI, four runs, two stolen bases and a 1.000 OPS.

SOLAK ECLIPSE: Nick Solak extended his hitting streak to seven games on Sunday, matching Llover Peguero for the longest run on the team. He is hitting .296 (8-for-27) with two home runs, one double, four RBI, one walk and five runs in this span. He has struck out just five times this season and only once in his past 12 plate appearances. Solak deposited his second home run of the season in the third inning on Friday, extending the Indians lead, 2-0.

DARING TODAY, AREN'T WE?: Darick Hall extended his hitting streak to five games on Sunday, batting .412 (7-for-17) with one double, one RBI, two walks and just one strikeout in this span. This, on the heels of going hitless (0-for-12) and striking out one-plus times in each of his first four games. He has posted back-to-back multi-hit games for the first time since July 24 and 25, 2024, with Lehigh Valley at Rochester.

BUBBA ON THE BUMP: Pirates top prospect Bubba Chandler made his third start of the season on Sunday, tossing 4.0 innings with two runs, two hits, no walks and six strikeouts. The lone two runs came after an infield single by Austin Hays and a two-run homer by Ivan Johnson. It marked the first two runs allowed by Chandler in 10.2 innings this season. In 10 career starts with Indianapolis, Chandler is 4-0 with a 1.80 ERA (10er/50.0ip) and 72 strikeouts. He has struck out eight-plus batters in five of those starts and six-plus in eight. Sunday marked his first Triple-A start without issuing a walk.

THOMAS TIME: Right-hander Thomas Harrington made his Indians season debut on Sunday, tossing 2.0 shutout innings with two hits and three strikeouts. He began the season with Double-A Altoona, but did not make an appearance before having his contract selected by Pittsburgh on April 1, 2025. He made his major league debut that day in a start against the Tampa Bay Rays at George M. Steinbrenner field in Tampa, Fla. In his second career appearance, he earned his first MLB save on April 7, tossing the game's final 4.0 innings to seal a Pirates win. Harrington posted a 10.13 ERA (9er/8.0ip) with seven strikeouts in his first MLB stint. Harrington is set to start for the Indians on Thursday night. Last season with Indy, he went 5-1 in eight starts with a 3.33 ERA (17er/46.0ip) with 38 strikeouts opposed to just eight walks. He posted a 0.93 WHIP and held opponents to a .212 batting average (35-for-165).

TONIGHT'S MATCHUP: The Indianapolis Indians host a six-game series against the Toledo Mud Hens with tonight's first pitch set for 6:05 PM. Indy narrowly lost 2024's season series with an 11-13 record against the Mud Hens. The teams split the games at Victory Field, 6-6, while Toledo took home an extra victory with a 7-5 record at Fifth Third Field. Indians right-hander Braxton Ashcraft is set to make his fourth start of the season tonight after picking up his first win on Wednesday at Louisville, allowing one run across 5.0 innings with a season-high six strikeouts. Ashcraft is set to make his first career outing against Toledo. Opposite Ashcraft is Mud Hens right-hander Matt Manning. Manning is 0-1 with a 6.97 ERA (8er/10.1ip) in three games (two starts) this season, but is coming off a 3.0-inning scoreless outing on April 10 vs. Iowa. In four career starts taking on the Indians, Manning is 1-0 with a 4.11 ERA (7er/15.1ip). Five of the 15 hits he has allowed to Indianapolis were home runs. Tonight is his first start against Indy since July 27, 2022, at Toledo when he earned the win with 5.2 shutout innings.

ON THIS DATE IN 1955: Trailing 2-1 in the eighth inning at old Victory Field, the Indians erupted for eight runs en route to a 9-2 win over Minneapolis. Center fielder Rocky Colavito collected two doubles and three RBI in the triumph.

Braxton Ashcraft: The right-hander and Pittsburgh's No. 6 prospect according to MLB Pipeline.

Opening Day Starter: Ashcraft made his second career Opening Day start on March 28 at St. Paul, last doing so on June 14, 2019, with Class-A short season West Virginia.

Last Outing: Ashcraft earned his first win of the season on April 9 at Louisville, tossing 5.0 innings of one-run ball with six strikeouts.

Against the Mud Hens: Ashcraft is set to make his first career start against Toledo tonight.

Prospectus: Ashcraft entered the 2025 season rated as Pittsburgh's No. 6 prospect according to MLB Pipeline and No. 4 according to *Baseball America*. Since being drafted by the Pirates in 2018, No. 4 is his highest ranking according to *BA*, elevated from No. 10 last season.

Miscellaneous: Ashcraft was drafted by Pittsburgh in the second round (51st overall) of the 2018 First-Year Player Draft out of Robinson High School (Waco, Texas). He had his contract first selected by Pittsburgh on Nov. 14, 2023.
