### ABOUT LAST NIGHT: [The Peoria Chiefs beat the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers 10-1 at Neuroscience Group Field.](#)

Trey Paige hit a grand slam during a seven-run sixth inning. Paige added an RBI single in the eighth inning for a five-RBI night. Gerardo Salas and Darlin Saladin held Wisconsin's offense to one run on four hits.

**MEET ME HALFWAY:** Jadhre Areinamo had two of Wisconsin's four hits last night – a single in the first and a double in the sixth. Areinamo has thirteen multi-hit games this season.

**END OF THE LINE:** Wisconsin starting pitcher Tyson Hardin walked Paige on a 3-2 pitch in the third inning. That was the first walk issued by Hardin since a start at Cedar Rapids on April 26. He had gone 30-2/3 innings between walks.

**TRIPLE DECKER:** Marco Dinges tripled in the bottom of the fifth inning. He scored on a sacrifice fly by Juan Baez. Dinges has fourteen extra-base hits for a .980 OPS in 35 games between Wisconsin and Carolina this season.

**A LOADED QUESTION:** Wisconsin went 0-for-1 with the bases loaded last night. The Chiefs were 2-for-2 with two walks in four plate appearances with the bases loaded last night. On the season, Wisconsin is 9-for-45 with 39 RBI in 61 plate appearances (including eleven walks, two hit batsmen, and three sacrifice flies) for an average of .200 and an OPS of .717 with the sacks full. Opponents are 16-for-66 in 80 plate appearances (including nine walks, three hit batsmen, and two sacrifice flies) for an average of .242 and an OPS of .744.

**DOUBLE UP ON DEFENSE:** Wisconsin turned another double play last night, their 47<sup>th</sup> double play of the season. The Rattlers lead the Midwest League in double plays. Wisconsin is third in the High-A Classification of Minor League baseball with the Everett AquaSox (54) and Hillsboro Hops (45) of the Northwest League getting more twin killings in 2025.

**ABOUT PEORIA:** The Peoria Chiefs were in the Three-I League from 1953-1958 before the team folded. They were a St. Louis Cardinals affiliate from 1953-1957 and a New York Yankees affiliate in 1958. The Chiefs re-entered organized baseball when the Danville franchise moved to Peoria after the 1982 season. They were named the Peoria Suns and were affiliated with the California Angels for 1983 and 1984 with a change to the Chiefs nickname for 1984 followed by an affiliation switch to the Chicago Cubs for the 1985 season. Peoria became the Cardinals Midwest League affiliate for the first time in 1995, switched back to the Cubs in 2005, and went back to the Cardinals in 2013. The Chiefs won a Midwest League title in 2002. They made the Midwest League Championship Series in 2018 but lost to Bowling Green. Patrick Anderson is in his third year as Peoria's manager. Notable former Chiefs include Greg Maddux, Mark Grace, Albert Pujols, Yadier Molina, Nolan Gorman, and Victor Scott II.

**ABOUT THE CARDINALS:** St. Louis had several different Midwest League affiliates before settling back in Peoria in 2013. They were in Cedar Rapids from 1965-1972 before leaving the league until returning to the league to affiliate with the Springfield, Illinois team from 1982 through 1993. St. Louis spent one year with the Madison Hatters before their first affiliation with Peoria from 1995 through 2004. The Cardinals left Peoria for Quad Cities from 2005 through 2012.

**PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES:** [MLB Pipeline](#) places five Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Bishop Letson (#14), Blake Burke (#16), Jadhre Areinamo (#23), Juan Baez (#26), and Manuel Rodriguez (#29). [MLB Pipeline](#) has five active Peoria players on their list of Top 30 Cardinals prospects: Chen-Wei Lin (#13), Darlin Saladin (#17), Ryan Campos (#18), Travis Honeyman (#24), and Zach Levenson (#28). Zack Showalter (#19) is currently on Peoria's Developmental List.

## WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

**RHP TANNER GILLIS:** The Milwaukee Brewers signed Gillis as a non-drafted free agent on September 3, 2024.

**ON THE HORIZON:** Gillis was a First Team All-Horizon League selection in his one season at Northern Kentucky in 2024. He was 8-3 with a 5.00 ERA in fourteen starts. Gillis had pitched four seasons for Cedarville University, an NCAA Division II school from 2019-2023.

**HOW GREEN WAS THE VALLEY?** Gillis made five appearances – four starts – for Mahoning Valley in the MLB Draft League in 2024. He was 2-1 with a 1.80 ERA, struck out 24, and walked seven over 25 innings.

**CAROLINA ON MY MIND:** Gillis started the 2025 season with the Carolina Mudcats. He was 1-1 with a save in seven relief appearances. Gillis had a 1.32 ERA and 28 strikeouts in 27-1/3 innings for the Mudcats before he was assigned to Wisconsin on May 15.

**LAST START:** Gillis lost at South Bend on [May 24](#). He allowed three runs on seven hits with a walk and four strikeouts over six innings.

**VS. SOUTH BEND:** Gillis has never pitched against Peoria prior to this evening. Tonight is also the first time he will face an affiliate of the St. Louis Cardinals.

## PEORIA STARTING PITCHER:

**RHP CADE WINQUEST:** The St. Louis Cardinals selected Winquest in the eighth round of the 2022 draft out of University of Texas-Arlington.

**THE COLLEGE YEARS:** Winquest was 9-11 with a 5.77 ERA in 46 games – 32 starts – at Texas-Arlington. He had 155 strikeouts in 160-2/3 innings. Winquest also pitched for Tulsa in the Texas Collegiate League in 2020 and Chatham in the Cape Cod Baseball League in 2021.

**LIFE'S A BEACH:** Winquest's first professional season was with the Palm Beach Cardinals of the Florida State League in 2023. He was 3-7 with a 4.87 ERA in 24 games – thirteen starts – in 2023. Winquest had 81 strikeouts and 35 walks in 77-2/3 innings with Palm Beach.

**FALSE START:** Winquest started the 2024 season with Peoria and was 0-2 with a 3.10 ERA in nine games – two starts. He went on the Peoria IL on May 13, was activated on May 29, and went back on the IL on June 18 without making another appearance in a game last year.

**LAST START:** Winquest beat Dayton at home on [May 24](#). He allowed three hits, walked one, and struck out nine over five scoreless innings.

**VS. WISCONSIN:** Winquest had no record in two starts – [May 6](#) and [May 11](#) – against the Rattlers at Dozer Park earlier this season. He allowed five hits, walked three and struck out eight over 7-2/3 scoreless innings in those games. He also made two relief appearances against the Timber Rattlers in 2024 and allowed two runs on four hits with five walks and eleven strikeouts over 10-1/3 innings while picking up a save.
