Series Record:

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers beat the South Bend Cubs 5-1 at Neuroscience Group Field. Eduardo García, Jose Acosta, and Jackson Chourio homered for Wisconsin. Brady Schanuel, Ryan Middendorf, and Robbie Baker covered nine innings and allowed one run on four hits in a "bullpen game" for the Partitors.

FIRST! Schanuel made his first professional start last night. He had made 99 consecutive relief appearances as a pro prior to last night. He allowed one hit, walked two, and struck out two over three innings as the first man up in the bullpen relay against the Cubs.

BACK-TO-BACK: García hit a two-out, two-run home run in the bottom of the second inning. Acosta followed two pitches later with a homer.

SECOND! Middendorf allowed a run over 3-2/3 innings with three strikeouts as the second leg of the bullpen relay. He would pick up his second win with Wisconsin.

BAKER'S TREATS: Baker entered the game with two one and one out in the seventh inning and stranded both runners. He retired all seven batters he faced to close out the game for his third save. Baker has retired nineteen batters in a row in his last three appearances. In August, Baker has appeared in four games with no hits, no walks, and seven strikeouts over 9-1/3 scoreless, hitless innings. The only base runner Baker has allowed this month was a hit batsman on August 6, He has retired 28 of the 29 batters this month.

GOING DEEP: Chourio homered in the third inning. It was his second homer of the series and third homer since joining the Timber Rattlers. Chourio also walked in the eighth inning and scored on a Jeferson Quero double.

WHAT'S AT STAKE: Today's game is the final meeting of the season between Wisconsin and South Bend. If the Rattlers win, Wisconsin claims the season series and the tiebreaker from South Bend in case of a tie in the standings at the end of the season. If the Cubs win, the season series is tied, and the tiebreaker is best record in the last twenty games of the season.

ABOUT SOUTH BEND: The South Bend Cubs started as the South Bend White Sox when the Midwest League added them as an expansion team in 1988. They changed their name to the Silver Hawks for the 1994 season and became an affiliate of the Arizona Diamondbacks in 1997. South Bend became an affiliate of the Chicago Cubs in 2015. South Bend won Midwest League pennants in 1989, 1993, 2005, and 2019. Notable alumni for the South Bend franchise include Mike Cameron, Jose Valverde, Chris Capuano, Mark Reynolds, Justin Upton, Wade Miley, Chase Anderson, Keon Broxton, Gleyber Torres, Ian Happ, and Carlos Gonzalez. Terry Francona was the manager of the South Bend White Sox in 1982.

ABOUT THE CUBS: The Chicago Cubs had several different Midwest League affiliates before settling in South Bend in 2015. They were affiliated with Quincy from 1965 through 1973 before leaving the Midwest League. The Cubs returned to the MWL with an affiliation with Quad Cities from 1979 through 1984, Peoria from 1985 through 1994 and again from 2005 through 2012, Rockford from 1995 through 1998, Lansing from 1999 through 2004, Kane County in 2013 and 2014.

SEASON SO FAR: South Bend finished the first half 34-32. They stumbled to the line as they dropped nine out of twelve games to start June. The Cubs put together a tengame winning streak as they won the final two games of the first half and the first eight games of the second half and they have ridden that the Western Division lead in the second half standings heading into this series with Wisconsin.

PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES: MLB Pipeline puts six active Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Jackson Chourio (#1), Jeferson Quero (#6), Eduardo García (#14), Joe Gray Jr. (#15), Zavier Warren (#18), and Taylor Floyd (#24). Tyler Black (#7), Russell Smith (#17), and Carlos Rodríguez (#22) are on the Wisconsin injured list. MLB Pipeline has eight current South Bend players on their Top 30 list of Chicago Cubs prospects: Peter Crow-Armstrong (#3), Owen Cassie (#9), Kohl Franklin (#14), Kevin Made (#17), Yohendrick Pinango (#21), Pablo Aliendo (#22), Jordan Nwogu (#24), and Daniel Palencia (#26)

PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP ISRAEL PUELLO: Acquired by Milwaukee as a player to be named later from in a trade that sent David Phelps to the Philadelphia Phillies on August 31, 2020. Puello, Juan Geraldo, and Brandon Ramey were announced at the PTBNL on September 18, 2020.

ORIGIN STORY: Puello was signed by the Phillies out of the Dominican Republic on July 2, 2017.

FIGHTIN' PHIL: Puello pitched two seasons (2018 and 2019) for the Phillies White affiliate in the Dominican Summer League. He went 4-6 with a 4.52 ERA in fourteen starts in 2018 and 2-1 with a 1.92 ERA in fifteen starts in 2019. Puello had 143 strikeouts over 131-1/3 innings pitched. Puello was named a DSL All-Star in 2019.

WHAT'S BREWING? Puello was 1-4 with a 4.94 ERA in ten starts for the Brewers Gold affiliate in the Arizona Complex League in 2021. He walked nine and struck out 37 over 27-1/3 innings pitched.

SWEET CAROLINA: Puello was 3-7 in thirteen games – six starts – with a 5.51 ERA and 61 strikeouts over 49 innings pitched for the Carolina Mudcats before joining the Timber Rattlers on June 28. Puello was 0-2 in four games – two starts in June...BUT, he had a 3.38 ERA, opponents were hitting just .192 against him, and he had sixteen strikeouts over sixteen innings in June.

LAST START: Puello <u>lost to the South Bend at home on August 9</u>. He allowed seven runs on seven hits, including three home runs, over 3-2/3 innings. Puello walked one, hit one, and struck out three.

VS. SOUTH BEND (2022): Puello is 0-2 in two starts against the Cubs this season. He als lost at South Bend on July 6. Puello allowed a run on three hits with a walk and four strikeouts over seven innings.

SOUTH BEND STARTING PITCHER:

RHP DANIEL PALENCIA: The Cubs acquired Palencia from the Oakland Athletics on July 26, 2021 in a trade that sent Andrew Chafin to the A's in exchange for Palencia and Greg Deichmann.

ORIGIN STORY: Oakland signed Palencia as an International Free Agent out of Venezuela on February 13, 2020.

CALIFORNIA DREAMING: Palencia made his professional debut with the Stockton Ports in the Low-A West in 2021 and went 0-2 with a 6.91 ERA in six starts before the trade. The Cubs assigned Palencia to Myrtle Beach in the Low-A East after the trade.

PELI-CAN: Palencia was 1-0 with a 3.67 ERA in seven starts at Myrtle Beach. He walked eighteen and struck out 38 over 27 innings pitched for the Pelicans.

LAST START: Palencia had a <u>no decision at Fort Wayne on August 7</u>. He pitched three scoreless, hitless innings with no walks and seven strikeouts.

VS. WISCONSIN: Palencia has made three appearances – two starts – against Wisconsin this season. He has allowed eight runs on seven hits with four walks and fourteen strikeouts over 9-2/3 innings versus the Timber Rattlers
