**Sunday: Curve 7, RubberDucks 2:** Altoona snapped a seven-game losing streak and 30-inning scoreless streak in Sunday's series finale. The Curve scored in the second, third and fourth innings off **Thomas Ponticelli** and added three runs in the seventh inning. Akron never led in the finale, after trailing for only a half-inning over the first five games of the series.

**Adam Scott named Pitcher of the Week:** Adam Scott was named the Double-A Northeast MiLB Pitcher of the Week for Aug. 30-Sept. 5. Scott picked up his third win of the season on Friday, Sept. 3, tossing six hitless, scoreless innings allowing two walks and striking out eight batters to help the RubberDucks to a 3-0 win over the Altoona Curve. Scott combined with two RubberDucks relievers to no-hit Altoona for 8 2/3 innings and pitch a combined one-hit shutout, the second of three straight shutouts by Akron's pitching staff. Scott is the first RubberDuck to be named MiLB Pitcher or Player of the Week this season. In 10 starts with Akron this season, he is 3-2 with a 2.72 ERA and 57 strikeouts in 46 1/3 innings. In six starts since the beginning of August, Scott is 3-0 with a 1.65 ERA, 0.83 WHIP and 40 strikeouts in 32 2/3 innings, while holding opponents to a .158 batting average. A fourth-round pick by the Cleveland Indians out of Wofford University in 2018, the 25-year-old Scott is in his second season appearing for Akron, for which he is 7-8 with a 3.48 ERA in 24 starts, along with 131 strikeouts in 121 2/3 innings.

**New-look RubberDucks:** Since July 30, four lineup regulars have joined Akron from High-A Lake County – infielders **Brayan Rocchio** and **Victor Nova** and outfielders **Will Brennan** and **George Valera**. Rocchio had a nine-game hitting streak Aug. 10-19 and four homers in six games Aug. 12-17. He is hitting .275, 6 HR, 25 RBIs in 32 games. Nova has a six-game hitting streak and is hitting .294 in 11 games. Brennan is hitting .272, 2 HR, 18 RBI in 28 games. Valera has 10 hits, a home run and nine RBIs in 11 games. Valera (#2), Rocchio (#7) and Brennan (#29) are all Top-30 Indians prospects (MLB.com).

**Playoff race:** Akron has the best record in the Double-A Northeast with 12 games to play. Somerset is four games back and would play Akron in a best-of-five championship if the season ended today. Bowie (14 to play) is 5.5 games back. Portland is six back. Akron has six games with Somerset Sept. 14-19. **Akron's magic number (combination of Akron wins and losses by the third-place club needed) to clinch a playoff berth is eight.**

**Limited experience:** Among 26 active RubberDucks, two played as high as Double-A before this season. Both are left-handed pitchers: **Adam Scott** (4-6, 3.94 ERA in 14 Akron starts in 2019), and **Ben Krauth** (1-3, 4.66 ERA in 56 relief IP in 2019).

**RubberDucks visit Flying Squirrels:** Akron is playing the last of two scheduled series this season with Richmonds and now leads the season series, 5-1. Akron won five of six games at Canal Park July 20-25. According to MLB.com, top prospects in this series include: **Indians (MLB.com):** #2 OF **George Valera**, #6 C **Bo Naylor**, #7 IF **Brayan Rocchio**, #10 LHP **Logan T. Allen**, #17 RHP **Peyton Battenfield**, #29 OF **Will Brennan**  
**Giants (MLB.com):** #15 IF **Will Wilson**

**Ducks fall short of sweeping Curve:** In their last of four series in 2021, Akron won five of six over Altoona to take the season series, 13-11. The RubberDucks lineup had at least one Cleveland Indian for every game of the series. **Roberto Pérez** caught the beginning of games Tuesday, Thursday, Friday and Sunday. He had three hits in an 11-2 win Tuesday. **Aaron Civale** pitched five innings for a win in Wednesday's 9-5 victory. **Peyton Battenfield** went the first six innings of a combined 5-0 shutout Thursday. **Adam Scott** tossed the first six innings Friday, when Akron was one strike away from a combined no-hitter in a 3-0 win. **Konnor Pilkington** pitched a season-long 5.2 innings in Saturday's 2-0 win. The Curve ended a 30-inning scoring drought to win Sunday's finale, 7-2. **Brayan Rocchio** had nine hits, including four doubles and a homer, in the series.

**Tough competition:** Akron has played 72 of its 107 games against teams .500 or better (41-31 in those games). Only Harrisburg (83), Erie (72) and Reading (72) have played as many such games in the league. By comparison, Somerset has played 66 such games, Bowie has played 65, and Portland has played 12 against a winning team.

**Top backstop:** **Bo Naylor** leads Double-A Northeast catchers with 51 assists and 19 runners caught stealing (57 attempts) while behind the plate. Naylor hit just .138 (13-for-94), 1 HR, 5 RBI through 26 Double-A games. But in 51 games since June 19, Naylor is 37-for-181 (.204) with eight doubles, nine homers, 38 RBIs, and a .694 OPS. He has reached base on a hit or walk in 17 of his last 23 games, with hits in 12 of those games. He has two of Akron's three grand slams in 2021.

**Leading the Southwest:** From June 1-Aug. 8, the RubberDucks exclusively played Southwest Division clubs for 10 consecutive series. Akron won six series and went 35-25 in that span (26-22 against winning teams, and 19-7 in July), to open a 1.5-game division lead. From June 29-Aug. 1, Akron had five straight series wins against each divisional opponent – Bowie, Altoona, Harrisburg, Richmond, Erie).

**Home cooking:** The RubberDucks won their first six home games and are 35-19 at Canal Park. In 2019, the RubberDucks were 30-40 at home – their first losing record at Canal Park since 2014 (32-39).

## #15 Logan Allen...LHP, 6-0, 190, Age 22 (9/5/98), Resides: Deltona, FL

### Last Outing: Tuesday, Aug. 31, vs. Altoona (W in 11-2 win)

After allowing a leadoff single, Allen retired the next seven batters in a row. He struck out the last four batters to face him, tossing six scoreless innings while striking out six batters. He worked the first five innings with rehabbing Cleveland Indians catcher Roberto Pérez, and Akron built an 8-0 lead within the first three innings.

### Season Highlights

- Made his first nine professional starts for High-A Lake County before joining Akron on July 2. At the time of his promotion, he led the High-A Central in ERA (1.58), was tied for the lead in wins (5), was second in strikeouts (67), opponents' average (.200) and WHIP (0.97), and third in innings (51.1).

### 2020:

- Cleveland selected Allen in the second round (56th overall) of the 2020 draft, which was shortened to five rounds. Allen was Cleveland's third selection, following SS Carson Tucker (1st Round - 23rd overall) and RHP Tanner Burns (CBA Round - 36th overall).
- Allen shares the same name as Cleveland's Triple-A/MLB left-hander **Logan Allen**. The younger Allen said last year, "he reached out to me after the draft, and we talked... It's really funny. Maybe there can be some marketing possibilities one day."

### Amateur

- Career at Florida International (2018-20): 11-12, 3.33 ERA, 31 G (30 GS), 183.2 IP, 246 K, 47 BB, 1.14 WHIP.
- Allen was a two-way player at Florida International, playing first base (50 career games) when he wasn't pitching. He was All-CUSA 2nd Team as a freshman and the All-CUSA 1st Team as a sophomore, both as a utility player. In three seasons at FIU, Allen batted .297/.362/.410 (.773 OPS) with six home runs, eight doubles and 23 RBI. As a freshman, when Allen played the most as a two-way player, he posted a career-best .390 OBP.
- In 2019, Allen became the first FIU Panther ever selected to the USA Baseball Collegiate National Team.
- Preseason All-American by several outlets ahead of the shortened 2020 season and was also the 2020 Conference USA Preseason Pitcher of the Year. He was a five-time C-USA Pitcher of the Week during his career, including in 2020 after pitching a seven-inning, one-hitter with 13 strikeouts against George Mason. He was named a Freshman All-American by three different outlets in 2018.
- Allen has known his college coach, Mervyl Melendez, since he was five years old. Allen played "Pony Baseball" and travel baseball with Melendez's oldest son. Melendez helped coach the boys from a young age. "We consider [Logan] very dear to our family and he's like another son to me," Melendez said. Logan's older brother, Hunter, also played college baseball for Melendez at Alabama State from 2014-16 (Hunter is now the assistant softball coach at FIU).
- Drafted by the Baltimore Orioles in the sixth round of the 2016 draft out of University High School (Orange City, FL).

### Scouting Reports:

- Allen's changeup - a circle change grip - is regarded as his best secondary pitch. According to his college coach, Mervyl Melendez, who also coached Allen in youth baseball, the development of that changeup goes back to Allen's youth. Melendez said he did not allow Allen to throw anything but a fastball and a changeup (no curveballs) until Allen was 12 years old. *MLB.com's* scouting report of Allen's changeup notes "his changeup is his bread and butter, a potentially future plus circle change he sells really well with good fade and sink that misses bats and elicits weak contact on the ground."
- Eric Longenhagen of *FanGraphs* notes Allen's athleticism as a two-way player has helped him maintain a "well-balanced, repeatable delivery." Allen's college coach, Mervyl Melendez, who also coached Allen in youth baseball (see "College Coach" note above), says of Allen's delivery "when [Logan] first started pitching at seven, you kind of saw the mechanical aspect of his pitching was a little bit more advanced than anybody else."

# 2021 RUBBERDUCKS FIELD STAFF

**#24 Rouglas Odor, Manager (Second Season)** – Odor, 53, became the 18<sup>th</sup> manager in club history when he led the club in 2019. The RubberDucks posted a 61-79 record, good for fifth in the Eastern League Western Division following a 34-35 first half record. Odor has twelve seasons of managerial experience where he has compiled a career record of 422-442 (.488). When Odor was Akron's hitting coach in 2014, he became the first person to wear the uniforms of the Canton-Akron Indians, Akron Aeros, and Akron RubberDucks. He played 197 games for Canton-Akron during the 1991, 1993-94 seasons, and he was the hitting coach for the Aeros' 2012 Eastern League Championship squad.

The 2021 season is Odor's 34<sup>th</sup> in the Cleveland organization as a player or coach (21<sup>st</sup> as a coach). The former shortstop was a 32<sup>nd</sup>-round draft pick by the Indians in 1988 and played in the minor leagues for the Indians from 1988-94 and for the Milwaukee Brewers organization in 1995. The 2019 season was Odor's first as a manager since 2008. He managed San Felipe in the Venezuelan Summer League (1999-2000), the Burlington Indians (2001-2004), the Mahoning Valley Scrappers (2005-2006), Gulf Coast League Indians (2007-2008). In 2009, Odor began serving as hitting coach for the Kinston Indians (2009-2010), Double-A Akron Aeros (2011-2012), High-A Carolina Mudcats (2013), Double-A Akron RubberDucks (2014), and Triple-A Columbus Clippers (2015-2017).

The Maracaibo, Venezuela, native resides in Winter Haven, Florida, with his wife, Milagros. He has three sons and is the uncle of Texas Rangers infielder Rougned Odor.

**#35 Owen Dew, Pitching Coach (1<sup>st</sup> Season)** — Owen Dew, 32, makes his first visit to Akron after serving as the pitching coach for the Lake County Captains in the Class-A Midwest league in 2019. Dew began his baseball journey as a right-handed pitcher for Seminole State College of Florida (2008-2009), before moving to the University of Central Florida in 2010, when he was drafted in the 21<sup>st</sup> round of the 2010 amateur draft by the Cleveland Indians. That same year, Dew advanced through Mahoning Valley with a strong 2.64 ERA in nine starts for the Scrappers. At Class-A Lake County, Dew was converted to a relief pitcher where he appeared in 15 games over the 2010 and 2011 seasons. In Dew's final season as a player, the right hander appeared in 34 games, accruing 70 innings and posted a 3.86 ERA with 41 strikeouts.

Since his playing career, Dew served as an assistant coach at Seminole State College of Florida while also assisting the Cleveland Indians as an associate scout from 2014-2017. Dew was then appointed as a full-time minor league pitching coach within the organization, making stops with the Mahoning Valley (2017), Arizona League Indians 2 (2018), and Lake County Captains (2019). The 2019 Lake County Captains pitching staff posted a team ERA of 3.73 over 1191 innings, good for eighth in the Midwest League.

**#16 Junior Betances, Hitting Coach (First Season)** — Betances, 47, hits Akron for the first time in his 21-year coaching career with the Cleveland Indians organization. After posting a .289 batting average over 165 games in 1998-1999 with the Akron Aeros, Betances joined the coaching ranks in various roles for the Cleveland Indians Dominican Summer League team from 2000-2010. Betances then served as Arizona League Indians coach from 2010-2015, and moved to Lake County in 2017 as the Bench coach for Manager Larry Day. The native of La Vega, Dominican Republic, Betances has developed a wealth of experience in various player development roles within the Indians organization.

**#28 Mike Mergenthaler, Bench Coach (First Season)** — Mergenthaler, 32, moves up the Indians farm system to Akron in 2021, following his 2019 season serving as the Lynchburg Hillcats bench coach for Manager Jim Pankovits. In 2018 and 2019, Mergenthaler worked as a hitting coach for the Cleveland Indians' and Milwaukee Brewers' joint Dominican Super League team. The Thiells, NY, native was drafted as a player in the 32<sup>nd</sup> round of the 2011 amateur draft by the San Francisco Giants, playing in their system for parts of 2011 and 2012.

**Jacob Legan, Athletic Trainer (First Season)** — Legan heads to Akron for the first time in his six-year career with the Cleveland Indians. Legan previously served as the Lynchburg Hillcats' athletic trainer in 2019.

**Scott Nealon, Strength and Conditioning Coach (Second Season, not consecutive)** — Nealon enters his eighth season in the Cleveland Indians organization, returning to the same position he held in 2016 for the RubberDucks Eastern League Championship season. Nealon was the Triple-A Columbus strength and conditioning coach the last three seasons (2017-2019), including the Clippers' 2019 Governor's Cup championship season. Previously, Nealon served as strength and conditioning coach for the Carolina Mudcats (2013-2014), Lynchburg Hillcats (2015), before he made his way to Double-A Akron. Nealon earned his master's degree in exercise science from Baldwin Wallace University in Berea, Ohio.
